Pastor's Notes

Trinity Sunday on 12 June always follows after the Solemnity of Pentecost. The profound mystery of one God in three distinct persons is an eternal reality which we hope and pray to embrace in heaven; the Beatific Vision in all its glory. And yet as glorious as the Triune God truly is above; this mystery dwells within the living earthly souls of Christians baptized in the holy name of Father, Son and Spirit. That is why for Catholics, making the “Sign of the Cross” is the simplest/deepest prayer that we possess as individual believers. It is a constant reminder that the Lord is ever-close in our lives, as we journey through life to our ultimate destiny together with God!!!

Tuesday 24 May will always be sadly remembered as a horrific day for the people of Uvalde, Texas. Nineteen innocent angelic souls along with their two teachers were violently taken from their families and from our world, in a cruel act of madness and terror. We can never stop praying for God's peace to reign supremely over these tragic incidents of evil. And we can never stop working for our country to pass and enforce laws that protect our precious children; born and unborn. As the Bishops of the United States wrote recently: “There has been too many school shootings, too much killing of the innocent. Our Catholic faith calls us to pray for those who have died and to bind the wounds of others. As we do so, each of us also needs to search our souls for ways that we can do more to understand this epidemic of evil and violence, and implore our elected officials to help us take action.” As sad as it sounds, this weekend I will be addressing the Masses concerning the actions we should take in the “hopeful-never-event” of an active shooter in Church.

Corpus Christi Sunday on 19 June is also Fathers' Day this year throughout our nation. As we see in the following page, Bishop Anjay will be celebrating the 11:30 AM Mass for our joyful feast day, along with blessing our dads, grand-fathers and Communion Ministers. The Eucharistic Procession will culminate with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament; and we encourage everyone to wear summer white. Please come to celebrate with all of our cultural/liturgical communities, as one Body of Christ united in the love of Jesus, Mary and Joseph!!!

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL 2022-2025



With the celebration of **The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, on June 19, 2022**, the Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The initiative is an expression of desire to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with the Lord in the Eucharist. It is so very much needed, especially after the challenging times of pandemic and forced disconnection.

Over the next three years, dioceses will receive support and be encouraged to revive their sacramental spirituality by organizing Eucharistic Congresses and processions. Parishes will also be urged to increase or begin Eucharistic Adorations and Holy Hours. There will be a revival of faithful adherence to the liturgical norms in all their richness – the *ars celebrandi*. Families and friends will be invited to gather in small groups to learn and pray together. Filled with the flame of charity from the reception of Jesus in the Eucharist, missionary disciples will go to the margins, recognizing the mystery of Jesus' presence in the poor. All of this will culminate in the first **National Eucharistic Congress** in the United States in almost fifty years. From **July 17-21, 2024**, thousands of Catholics will journey on pilgrimage to Indianapolis to personally encounter Jesus in the Eucharist and be sent back out into their parishes and communities.

All parishioners from all languages are invited to celebrate with our own **Bishop Anjay** on **Sunday 19 June** at the **11:30AM Mass**. We will recommission all our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, followed by a short **Procession of the Blessed Sacraments** through the streets of Mineola. Let us rejoice as the only diocesan parish of Corpus Christi: **You Together Are My Body!!!**

He went to his Parish Outreach, where his family received food that allowed them to make it through the month. James and his family received the help they so desperately needed.

Today, James is back to work and the family is doing well. *"I am so thankful that I know there is somewhere I can turn, where there are people that care, people I can talk to, if I am ever in such a situation again,"* shared James.

Corpus Christi's 2022 **"Continuing the Educational Mission"** **Scholarship Award**



We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi "***Continuing the Educational Mission***" ***Scholarship*** award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for several months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the success from past years, we will continue to offer three scholarships this year:

- One for a student parishioner attending a Catholic grammar or middle school.
- One for a student parishioner attending a Catholic High School
- One for a student parishioner attending, full time, a college or university.

Now three young people from our parish will each be awarded a scholarship toward their education.

A scholarship award of \$4,000 will be given to a student in grades 6, 7 or 8 who will be attending starting September 2022 a local Catholic school for the academic school year 2022/2023.

A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to a student who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2022 for the academic school year 2022/2023.

A scholarship award of \$6,000 will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a full time course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending starting September 2022, a 2-4-year college or university for the academic school year 2022/2023.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester.

The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and **not** from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer on or around July 31. The scholarship is for one year. Applications must be submitted to the rectory by July 1, 2022.

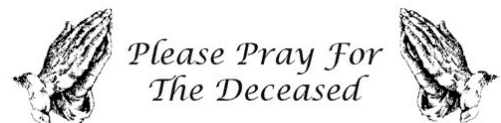

SANTÍSIMA TRINDAD



EVANGELIO SEGUN SAN JUAN 16, 12-15

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: *“Aún tengo muchas cosas que decirles, pero todavía no las pueden comprender. Pero cuando venga el Espíritu de verdad, el los irá guiando hasta la verdad plena, porque no hablará por su cuenta, sino que dirá lo que haya oído y les anunciará las cosas que van a suceder. Él me glorificará, porque primero recibirá de mí lo que les vaya comunicando. Todo lo que tiene el Padre es mío. Por eso he dicho que tomará de lo mío y se lo comunicará a ustedes”*.



Acabado el tiempo de Pascua nos encontramos con la solemnidad de la Trinidad el domingo posterior a Pentecostés, fecha fijada e el siglo XIV. Alguno se preguntará el motivo de un día para esto: Acaso no está la Trinidad presente en todas y cada una de las celebraciones? No la celebramos de continuo? Mencionándola iniciamos las celebraciones, la bendición la nombra explícitamente; en cada Gloria alabamos a las tres personas divinas, en el credo professamos la fe en ella. Especialmente hoy, en las oraciones y el prefacio, proclamamos la fe en la Trinidad, tres personas divinas y un solo Dios verdadero.

Conocemos este misterio a través de la Revelación, que llega a su punto culminante en Cristo, que nos revela la relación trinitaria del Amor del Padre, que engendra al Hijo, por cuyo Amor al Padre se hace historia viva y encarnada y también nos envía su Amor en la persona del Espíritu Santo. El misterio de la Trinidad no es algo ajeno a nuestra vida, ni siquiera a nuestro desarrollo personal ya que hemis sido concebidos a imagen y semejanza de Dios que por Amor se manifiesta en permanente relación personal.



Dios es sabiduría creadora, ya que sin ella no podemos ni admirar a Dios, ni admirarnos de nosotros mismos. La sabiduría es vida; es decir, el misterio de Dios es vida para el hombre, no muerte. La sabiduría de Dios se ha acercado a los hombres en Jesucristo. Toda la creación, toda la inteligencia humana, todos los descubrimientos del mundo, son la manifestación de esta sabiduría. Pero si la ofendemos, creyendo que podemos construir un mundo al margen de la sabiduría de Dios, y desde nuestras propias posibilidades humanas, vamos camino de la destrucción, de la muerte.

*y la esperanza no desilusiona,
porque el amor de Dios ha sido
derramado en nuestros
corazones por medio del
Espíritu Santo que nos fue
dado.*

En la segunda lectura de este domingo Pablo comienza en su carta a los Romanos a poner de manifiesto lo que ha significado el acontecimiento de gracia revelado en Jesucristo y al cual accedemos por la fe. *“Dios ha infundido su amor en nuestros corazones por medio del Espíritu Santo, que él mismo nos ha dado”*

SANTÍSSIMA TRINDADE



EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 16, 12-15

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos discípulos: *“Tenho ainda muitas coisas para vos dizer, mas não a podeis compreender agora. Quando vier o Espírito de verdade, ele vos guiará para a verdade plena; porque não falará de si mesmo, mas dirá tudo o que tiver ouvido e vos anunciará o que está para vir. Ele me glorificará, porque receberá do que é meu e vo-lo anunciará. Tudo o que o Pai tem é meu. Por isso vos disse que ele receberá do que é meu e vo-lo anunciará”*.



É difícil para os cristãos entender o sentido desta festa, porque a Santíssima Trindade é um mistério, impossível de se explicar ou imaginar (três Pessoas num só Deus). Em princípio a Santíssima Trindade não existe propriamente. É uma abstração. Nem Jesus nem os apóstolos falaram alguma vez da Santíssima Trindade como noção abstrata, e sim, concretamente, do Pai, de Cristo e do Espírito Santo. A mensagem transmitida pela festa de hoje é, em primeiro lugar, que Deus é nosso Pai. O Deus cristão não é uma “idéia”, um “princípio motor”, um “criador distante”, um “ser supremo”. Ele é,

antes de tudo, nosso Pai. O Pai nos envia seu Filho, que é Jesus, Deus feito homem, a encarnação real, visível, da bondade do Pai. Mas ninguém viu o Pai. E Jesus já não está conosco. Como reconhecer e seguir seus ensinamentos? Para isso temos o Espírito Santo, que trabalha os homens para que possamos descobrir Jesus e seus ensinamentos. A festa da Santíssima Trindade é a festa do amor de Deus pelo seu povo, amor através do qual ele nos transmite e comunica sua felicidade.



A primeira leitura deste domingo introduz o tema da Trindade falando-nos do Pai, criador do universo. Antes de tudo, Deus fez a Sabedoria. O autor dos Provérbios imagina-a como uma rapariga encantadora que o Senhor quer, desde sempre, ao seu lado, para que contemple e siga toda a sua actividade. É na sua presença que Ele cria o universo. A leitura garante: a criação saiu das mãos de um Pai providente e sábio; durante toda a sua actividade Ele foi sempre assistido pela sua Sabedoria; a criação responde a um projecto de amor, mesmo se a inteligência do homem nem sempre o consegue entender. Ter fé em Deus Pai – é a mensagem da leitura – significa acreditar que ele fez tudo com sabedoria e amor.

Rom. 5:5

“e a esperança não desaponta, porquanto o **amor** de Deus está derramado em nossos corações pelo **Espírito Santo** que nos foi dado.”
