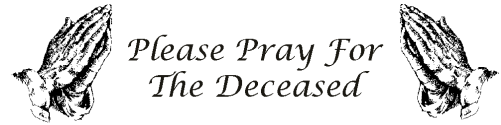

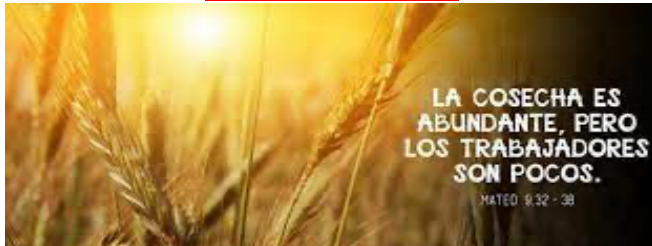

One word, PEACE, recurs in today's readings. In Isaiah, peace flows like a river through the ideal future landscape that he predicts. Then St Paul prays for peace for all who follow Christ. And when sending out his disciples, Jesus says their first message must be: "Peace to this house." But while most people agree that peace must be sought, many seem to want peace only on their own rigid terms. Even many Catholics, parishioners as well as clergy, hardly give it more than lip service. Bitter divisions are obvious in the epistle to the Galatians. A radically conservative Jewish-Christian group want the Church to keep the Jewish rite of circumcision, while others like Paul considered that ritual as now obsolete, replaced by baptism. Such arguments and misunderstandings are probably unavoidable. Every age in the Church has its own controversies and sectarian divisions, often based on arrogant refusal to hear competing visions of what God requires of us. Notice how, when the first disciples returned to Jesus, flushed with joy from their success, they were very proud of the people's response to their preaching. They were in danger of arrogance and needed his words of guidance. Pride is far from the poverty of spirit taught by Jesus. It leaves us less compassionate towards a world which needs to know the compassion of Christ Let's ask ourselves the challenging question attributed to G. K. Chesterton: "If you were accused of being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict you?"

XIV DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 10. 1-12.17-20

En aquel tiempo, Jesús designó a otro setenta y dos discípulos y los mandó por delante, de dos en dos, a todos los pueblos y lugares a donde pensaba ir, y le dijo: *“La cosecha es mucha y los trabajadores pocos. Rueguen, por tanto, al dueño de la mies que envíe trabajadodres a sus campos. Pónganse en caminho; yo los envío como cordeiros en médio de lobos. No lleven ni dinero, ni morral, ni sandálias; y no se detengan a saludar a nadie por el caminho. Cuando entren en una casa, digan: Que la paz reine en esta casa. Y si allí hay gente amante de la paz, el deseo de paz de ustedes, se cumplirá; si no, no se cumplirá. Quédense en esa casa. Coman y beban de lo que tengan, porque el trabajador tiene derecho a un salario. No anden de caa en casa. En cualquier ciudad donde entren y los reciban, coman lo que le den. Curen a los enfermos que haya y dígaes: Ya se acerca a ustedes el Reino de Dios”*.

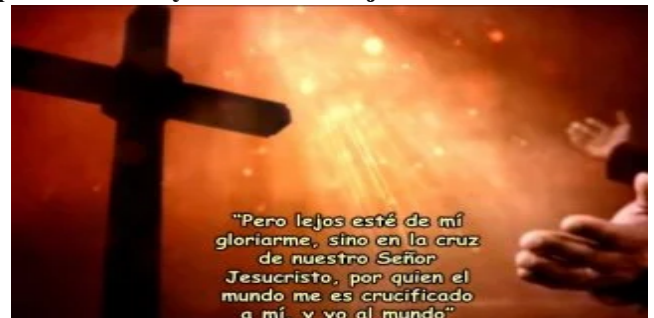


El evangelio de hoy narra la misión de los 70 o 72 discípulos. Se trata de un número más redondo que histórico, indicando los 70 o 72 pueblos que se creían que conformaban la tierra, es decir, toda la humanidad. Más allá de esto, nos da a entender que la predicación misionera no es un privilegio o competencia exclusiva de los 12 apóstoles. La única misión de predicar el evangelio compete a todos los cristianos, aunque sea de manera diversa. Es decir, todos somos misioneros, cada uno en su puesto y desde sus circunstancias. Jesús invita a los discípulos a la tarea de anunciar y predicar la

llegada del Reino. Esa tarea requiere continuar la acción salvífica que Jesús ha introducido con su palabra y con su vida. Evangelizar es anunciar que el Reino de Dios es realidad salvífica para el hombre. No es solo anunciar una doctrina. Esa es la principal tarea de Jesús tal como aparece en los Evangelios. Jesús llama a los suyos para que anuncien el Reino de Dios, para que realicen la obra admirable de introducir la paz en la tierra. Esto entraña muchas dificultades porque con frecuencia la paz y el bienestar que el hombre desea no coincide con la paz del Reino de Dios. Sin embargo la evangelización sólo tiene sentido desde una actitud optimista, pues anunciar el evangelio es afirmar que el Reino de Dios está sobre nosotros, que es ya una realidad.



La primera lectura del profeta Isaías es un oráculo sobre Jerusalén, para nosotros imagen de la Iglesia. A los tristes les realiza un llamado a la alegría. El motivo de tal esperanza es que Dios llevará a Jerusalén la paz, compendio de todos los bienes. El profeta utiliza la imagen de una madre que alimenta y cuida a su hijo.



La segunda lectura cierra la carta de San Pablo a los Gálatas. Es un escrito polémico cuyo único tema es la validez de la ley judaica como instancia salvífica. Los adversarios frente a los que escribe Pablo son cristianos que van predicando por esas comunidades diciendo que para salvarse en Cristo antes hay que pertenecer al Pueblo de Israel, aceptando la Ley y la circuncisión.

DOMINGO XIV DO TEMPO COMUM



EVANGELHO DE SAN LUCAS 10. 1-12.17-20

Naquele tempo, designou o Senhor setenta e dois discípulos e enviou-os dois a dois à sua frente, a todas as cidades e lugares aonde ele havia de ir. E dizia-lhes: A seara é grande, mas os trabalhadores são poucos. Pedi ao dono da seara que mande trabalhadores para a sua seara. Ide: Eu vos envio como cordeiros para o meio de lobos. Não leveis bolsa nem alforge nem sandália, nem vos demoreis a saudar alguém pelo caminho. Quando entrares nalguma casa, dizei primeiro: Paz a esta casa, e se lá houver gente de paz, a vossa paz repousará sobre eles; senão ficará convosco. Ficai nessa casa, comei e bebei do que tiverem em casa. Quando entrardes nalguma cidade e vos receberem, comei do que vos servirem, curai os enfermos que nela houver e dizei-lhes: Está perto de vós o reino de Deus. Mas quando entrardes nalguma cidade e não vos receberem, saí à praça pública e dizei: Até o pó da vossa cidade que se pegou aos nossos pés sacudimos para vós. No entanto, ficai sabendo: Está perto o reino de Deus. Eu vos digo: Haverá mais tolerância naquele dia, para Sodoma do que para essa cidade. Os setenta e dois discípulos voltaram cheios de alegria, dizendo: Senhor, até os demónios nos obedeciam em teu nome. Jesus respondeu-lhes: Eu via Satanás cair do céu como um relâmpago. Dei-vos o poder de pisar serpentes e escorpiões e dominar toda a força do inimigo; nada poderá causar-vos dano. Contudo, não vos alegreis porque os espíritos vos obedecem; alegrai-vos antes porque os vossos nomes estão escritos nos Céus.



O relato evangélico deste domingo é dirigido aos evangelizadores: bispos, sacerdotes, catequistas, líderes das comunidades cristãs e também a todos nós. São estes os discípulos designados por Jesus para evangelizar, e o seu discurso para os setenta e dois vale hoje para nós. Lucas ensina que o cristão tem de continuar no mundo a missão de Jesus, tornando-se testemunha, para todos os homens, dessa proposta de salvação libertação que Cristo veio trazer. Há um aviso acerca da dificuldade da missão: o discípulos são enviados como cordeiros para o meio dos lobos. Trata-se de uma imagem que, no Antigo Testamento, descreve a situação do justo, perdido no meio dos pagãos. Para nós significa a hostilidade do mundo. Há também uma exigência de pobreza e simplicidade para os discípulos em missão. Não levar nada consigo e não deter-se em coisas sociais. Os discípulos devem anunciar a paz e o Reino de Deus.



Paulo chegou ao fim da sua Carta e, em poucas palavras, resume o tema que tratou. Diz ele: *“os meus adversários, aqueles que estão apegados às tradições dos antigos, gloriaram-se de ter na própria carne o sinal da circuncisão e, quando conseguem convencer alguém a imitá-los, não param de vangloriar. Eu – continua Paulo – não me vanglorio senão da cruz do Senhor Jesus”.*
