## Pastor's Notes

Starting this month of September, you may see a new priest in residence here at Corpus Christi. His name is Fr. Jerome Madumelu, and he comes to us from Nigeria, Africa. Fr. Jerome has been assigned by the diocese to live with us at the rectory, with his principle work being a Chaplain for NYU-Langone Winthrop Hospital. By living right here in Mineola, Fr. Jerome will be better situated to serve the pastoral needs of the patients and staff in the hospital, especially for those late night emergency calls. For fifteen years he served in Good Samaritan Hospital out in Suffolk County, so he is well-experienced. When you encounter Fr. Jerome around the parish or on the Altar celebrating Mass for us, please welcome him here to our family of faith.



As you can see from some of the scaffolding still surrounding part of our building, we are still working to complete the exterior roof project. The good news is that the shingles and flashing are all done, with no signs of leaking into the attic when we've had rain. The not so good news is that we are waiting to finish the work on the gutters and drain pipes (victims of supply chain slowdowns). Once that is accomplished, we will be moving inside the church itself, to work on repairing and painting the ceiling and soffits that have been damaged over the years by water, fire, smoke and soot. Please pray for the completion and success of this effort.

Finally and most importantly, the United States National Eucharistic Revival began on our feast day of Corpus Christi; 19 June 2022. For the next three years, every Catholic Church in our country will be focusing on the power, the presence and the peace of Jesus Christ in the most Blessed Sacrament. Eucharistic holy hours, processions, retreats, seminars, sermons, adoration and benediction will be at the center of this revival; with the Mass being the source and summit of all that we are and all that we do as Roman Catholics. Let us together make our parish of Corpus Christi a place of deepest devotion and prayer in the name of the Sacred Body and Blood of Our Lord.

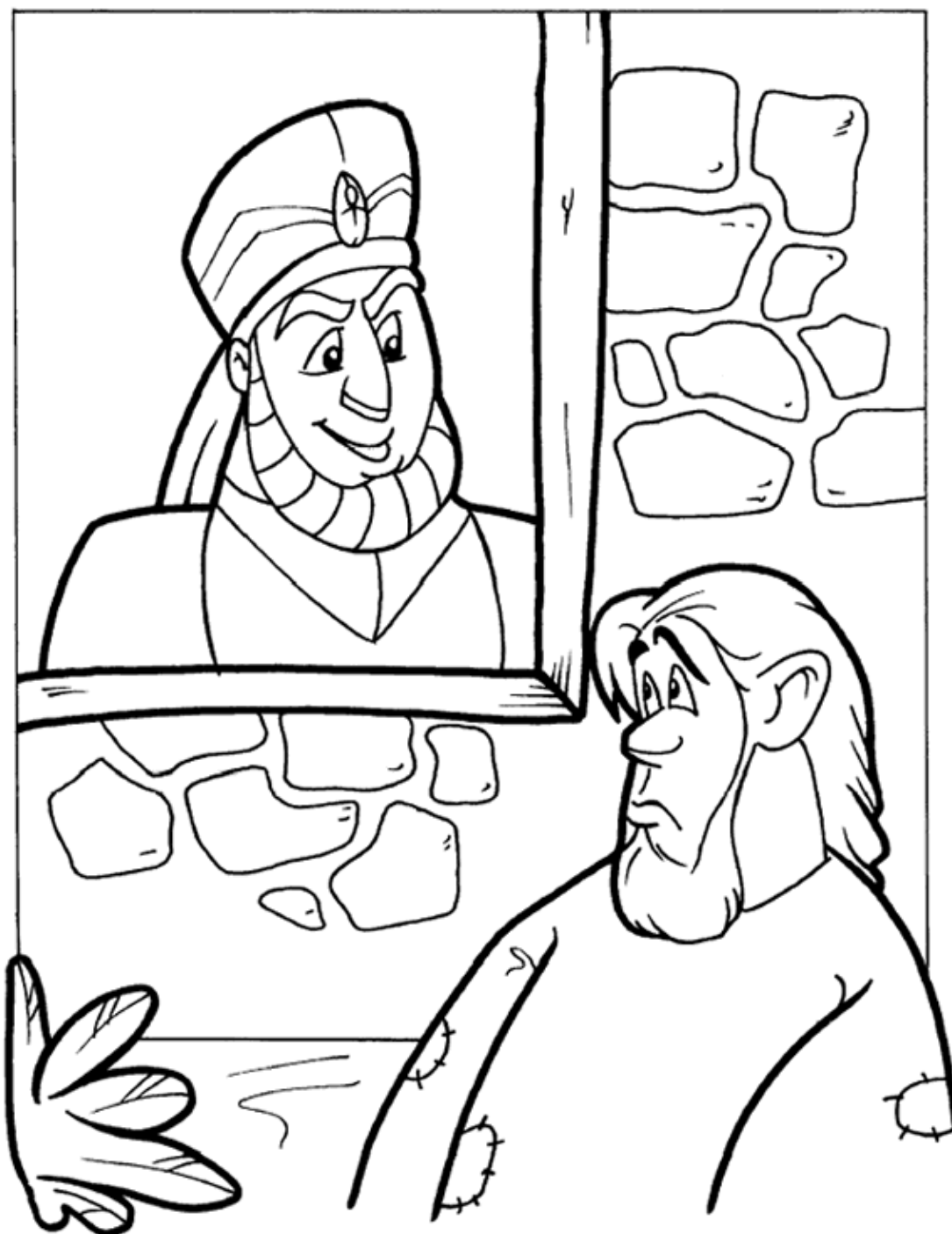

## The Society of St. Vincent DePaul

A little History:

St. Vincent de Paul (1581-1660) is called "the Father of the Poor" because of his lifetime of charitable works. He is the founder of: the Ladies of Charity-lay women working for the poor, the Congregation of the Mission-to preach the gospel to the poor, and in 1633 with co-founder Louise de Marillac, the Daughters of Charity. Louise was a wife, widow, mother and teacher. She gathered a small group of women and trained them to read, write and to love and serve the poor in health care, social ministry and education. Together they addressed the needs of the poor. They invited and made welcome everyone: cleric and lay, men and women, young and old, rich and poor into their service.

Blessed Frederic Ozanam (1813-1853) when France was reeling from the Revolution & Napoleonic Wars, which destroyed the fabric of the country. Materialism and secularism were rampant. People distancing themselves God and the Church. Individualism was becoming ingrained and the poor were being neglected and ignored (sound familiar?). As a student at the Sorbonne, he and six other students in 1833 formed the Conference of St. Vincent de Paul whose lifestyle they wanted to imitate.

Sr. Rosalie taught and mentored these men. She taught them to respect the dignity and personal worth of God's poor. She guided them to go two by two to visit the poor in their home, to imitate Jesus sending His disciples two by two. Today, The Society continues this work: to bring the good news to the poor, to bring hope where there is little hope, to bring food and clothing and counseling where there is a need.

Lord, give us the grace to hear the cries of the poor.

# Español

## XXVI DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



### EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 16. 19-31

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a los fariseos: *“Había un hombre rico, que se vestía de púrpura y telas finas y banqueteara esplendidamente cada día. Y un mendigo, llamado Lázaro, yacía a la entrada de su casa, cubierto de llagas y ansiando llenarse con las sobras que caían de la mesa del rico. Y hasta los perros se acercaban a lamerle las llagas. Sucedió, pues, que murió el mendigo y los ángeles lo llevaron al seno de Abraham. Murió también el rico y lo enterraron. Estaba éste en el lugar de castigo, en medio de tormentos, cuando levantó los ojos y vio a los lejos Abraham y a Lázaro junto a él. Entonces gritó: Padre Abraham, ten piedad de mí. Manda a Lázaro que moje en agua la punta de su dedo y me refresque la lengua, porque me torturan estas llamas. Pero Abraham le contestó: Hijo, recuerda que en tu vida recibiste bienes y Lázaro, en cambio, males. Por eso él goza ahora de consuelo, mientras que tú sufres tormentos. Además, entre ustedes y nosotros se abre un abismo inmenso, que nadie puede cruzar, ni hacia allá ni hacia acá. El rico insistió: Te ruego, entonces, padre Abraham, que mandes a Lázaro a mi casa, pues me quedan allá cinco hermanos, para que les advierta y no acaben también ellos en este lugar de tormentos. Abraham le dijo: Tienen a Moisés y a los profetas; que los escuchen. Pero el rico replicó: No, padre Abraham. Si un muerto va a decírselo, entonces sí se arrepentirán. Abraham repuso: Si no escuchan a Moisés y a los profetas, no harán caso, ni aunque resucite un muerto”.*



La Palabra de Dios insiste que tanto el rico como el pobre son igualmente criaturas de Dios, lo que les separa de Él es su conducta. El rico no puede darse la gran vida sin preocuparse de los necesitados. La parábola enseña que el destino del ser humano está más allá de esta vida terrena. La parábola contrapone las dos figuras del rico y del pobre cambiando su posición en el mundo futuro. Una riqueza que no se ajusta al criterio de Dios, corre el riesgo de encontrarse definitivamente con una sentencia contraria en el juicio final. Vivir las realidades terrenas como si fueran las definitivas y no hacer caso a la Escritura es lo que define la postura del rico comilón que no escuchó a Moisés ni a los profetas. La parábola nos pone de relieve que la filosofía de la vida del rico y poderoso, que se despreocupa del necesitado, olvida que Dios le está reclamando a través de su Palabra que preste atención a las necesidades del pobre. Hasta que los hombres no sean capaces de valorar en su justa medida todos los bienes, incluso las riquezas materiales, como un auténtico don de Dios y no como una propiedad exclusiva.

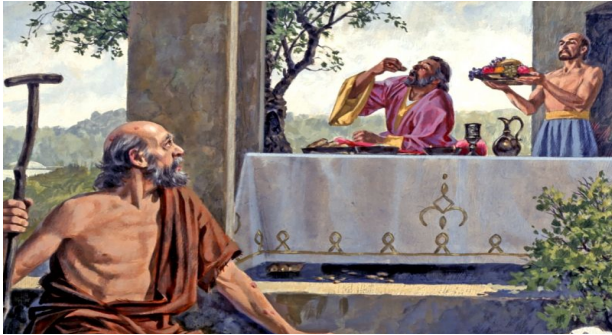


Estamos a mediados del siglo VII antes de Cristo, en el reino del Norte (Israel). Las conquistas del rei Jeroboán II crearon bienestar, riqueza, prosperidad, sin embargo, la situación de desahogo no beneficia tanto a toda la nación, cuanto a un grupo privilegiado. Nace, así, una clase dirigente poderosa, cada vez más rica, que vive instalada en el lujo, que explota a los pobres y que apoyada por jueces corruptos, comete ilegalidades y abusos. De otro lado, están los pobres, víctimas inocentes y silenciosas de un sistema que genera injusticia, miseria, sufrimiento, opresión. Es en este contexto que Amós, el profeta de la justicia social, va a hacer oír su denuncia profética.

## DOMINGO XXVI DO TEMPO COMUM



### EVANGELHO DE SAN LUCAS 16. 19-31

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos fariseus: *“Havia um homem rico, que se vestia de púrpura e linho fino e se banqueteara esplendidamente todos os dias. Um pobre, chamado Lázaro, jazia junto do seu portão, coberto de chagas. Bem desejava saciar-se do que caía da mesa do rico, mas até os cães vinham lambe-lhe as chagas. Ora sucedeu que o pobre morreu e foi colocado pelos Anjos ao lado de Abraão. Morreu também o rico e foi sepultado Na mansão dos mortos, estando em tormentos, levantou os olhos e viu Abraão com Lázaro a seu lado. Então ergueu a voz e disse: Pai Abraão, tem compaixão de mim. Envia Lázaro, para que molhe em água a ponta do dedo e me refresque a face. Abraão respondeu-lhe: Filho, lembra-te que recebestes os teus bens em vida e Lázaro apenas os males. Por isso, agora ele encontra-se aqui consolado, enquanto tu és atormentado. Além disso, há entre nós e vós um grande abismo, de modo que se alguém quisesse passar daqui para junto de vós, ou daí para junto de nós, não poderia fazê-lo. O rico insistiu: então peço-te, ó pai, que mandes Lázaro à minha casa paterna- pois tenho cinco irmãos – para que os previna, a fim de que não venham também para este lugar de tormento. Disse-lhe Abraão: Eles têm Moisés e os Profetas; que os ouçam. Mas ele insistiu: Não, pai Abraão. Se alguém dos mortos for ter com eles, arrepender-se-ão. Abraão respondeu-lhe: Se não dão ouvidos a Moisés nem aos Profetas, também não se deixarão convencer, se alguém ressuscitar dos mortos”.*



A mensagem central da história diz respeito ao juízo de Deus sobre a distribuição da riqueza no mundo. O grande abismo quer somente recordar ao discípulo uma verdade fundamental, que é esta: o destino da pessoa joga-se totalmente nesta nossa única vida. Jesus nos adverte da relação que existe entre o uso das riquezas e a salvação ou condenação. Na parábola do rico e Lázaro, Jesus ilustra as bem-aventuras: Bem-aventurados vós, os pobres, porque vosso é o Reino de Deus... Mas, aí de vós, ricos, porque já tendes a vossa consolação... (Marcos 6, 20ss). O homem rico da parábola se condena. Não pelo simples fato de ser rico, pois, como vimos no ensinamento do domingo passado, o dinheiro pode se transformar em instrumento de salvação. O rico teve a oportunidade de fazer isto, de colocar sua riqueza a serviço da libertação do pobre: esta oportunidade se chamava Lázaro. Mas o rico se fechou em sua riqueza e se condenou.

### **Profeta Amós**

- Amós era **pastor de ovelhas, plantador de sicômoros, boieiro** em Tecoá (10 km ao sul de Belém);
- O nome significa “carregador de Fardo”;
- Foi chamado por Deus para profetizar em **Judá e Israel**, denunciando as injustiças sociais e anunciando o castigo vindouro, pois Deus é um Deus justo.



No tempo do profeta Amós havia bem-estar, paz, prosperidade, mas também muitas injustiças. O profeta tinha levantado a voz contra os mercadores que extorquiam e enganavam os pobres. A leitura de hoje é um ataque dirigido aos chefes políticos e aos aristocratas que moram em palácios luxuosos na cidade da Samaria. A leitura conclui com uma ameaça terrível: mais alguns anos e virão os inimigos que hão-de queimar os palácios e destruir a cidade.
