

Dear Friends and Family of Corpus Christi Church,

This year of 2025 culminates the ongoing “National Eucharistic Revival” in every Roman Catholic Church throughout our country. The front facade of Corpus Christi Church is finally finished with the beautiful mosaic of the “monstrance” holding the Most Blessed Sacrament. But more importantly inside the church, the real presence of our Risen Lord Jesus in the Eucharist is the source and summit of everything we are and all that we do as Catholics. As your Pastor, I pray that our weekly hours of Adoration (Mondays, 8:00-9:00 AM; Wednesdays, 1:00-2:00 PM; Thursday, 7:00-8:00 PM) will continue to grow with your personal prayers & presence in worship of Christ Jesus.

Autumn is always the traditional time for our once-a-year parish fundraiser, by way of the four raffle tickets we are sending to each home. They are \$25 each, which will go toward the cost of purchasing two new doors leading into the Rectory offices. The current doors are wooden, and have been in place for more than 40 years. So clearly, they are deteriorating. Any additional funds that we raise will go towards needed improvements in the two large bathrooms in the lower hall of the Church. There will be three cash prizes (\$1,500, \$1,000, \$500) to be drawn on Sunday 23 November at the end of the 11:30 AM Mass, celebrating the Solemnity of Christ the King!

But also we are thankful for your weekly support of Corpus Christi, and the financial assistance we need to operate on a balanced budget as best as possible. 



DEDICACIÓN DE LA BASÍLICA DE LETRÁN



EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 2, 13-22

Cuando se acercaba la Pascua de los judíos, Jesús llegó a Jerusalén y encontró en el templo a los vendedores de bueyes, ovejas y palomas, y a los cambistas con sus mesas. Entonces hizo un látigo de cordeles y los echó del templo, con todo y sus ovejas y bueyes; a los cambistas les volcó las mesas y les tiró al suelo las monedas; y a los que vendían palomas les dijo: *"Quiten todo de aquí y no conviertan en un mercado la casa de mi Padre"*. En ese momento, sus discípulos se acordaron de lo que estaba escrito: *El celo de tu casa me devora*. Después intervinieron los judíos para preguntarle: *"¿Qué señal nos das de que tienes autoridad para actuar así?"* Jesús les respondió: *"Destruyan este templo y en tres días lo reconstruiré"*. Replicaron los judíos: *"Cuarenta y seis años se ha llevado la construcción del templo, ¿y tú lo vas a levantar en tres días?"* Pero él hablaba del templo de su cuerpo. Por eso, cuando resucitó Jesús de entre los muertos, se acordaron sus discípulos de que había dicho aquello y creyeron en la Escritura y en las palabras que Jesús había dicho.




Jesús expulsa propiamente a los animales del culto. No debemos pensar que Jesús la emprende a latigazos con las personas, sino con los animales; Juan es el que subraya más este aspecto. Los animales eran los sustitutos de los sacrificios a Dios. Por tanto, sin animales, el sentido del texto es más claro: Jesús quiere anunciar, proféticamente, una religión nueva, personal, sin necesidad de

"sustituciones". Por eso dice: "Quita esto de aquí". El evangelio de Juan, pues, nos presenta esa escena de Jesús que cautiva a mentes proféticas y renovadoras. Desde luego, es un acto profético y no podemos menos de valorarlo de esa forma. En el marco de la Pascua, la gran fiesta religiosa y de peregrinación por parte de los judíos piadosos a Jerusalén. Está ahí, en el corazón del evangelio, para ser una crítica de nuestra "religión" sin corazón con la que muchas veces queremos comprar a Dios. Es la condena de ese tipo de religión sin fe y sin espiritualidad, que se ha dado siempre y se sigue dando frecuentemente.



Ezequiel es un profeta de visiones extraordinarias que mira al Templo, la casa de Dios, como fuente de aguas que han de llegar hasta el abismo de la Arabá, del Mar Muerto, para que vuelva a nacer un nuevo paraíso. El manantial del templo que el profeta posexilico nos describe en este c. 47 ha encendido una inspiración sublime. El desierto rodea al pueblo de la Biblia y las aguas del paraíso (Gn 2,10-14) han sido siempre una nostalgia en la teología profética del Antiguo Testamento. El agua que mana, al lado del altar, se hace un río hacia Oriente, hacia el desierto de Judea porque es agua divina, regalo de Dios para el desierto y el destierro de su pueblo. La imagen de que esta agua ha de llegar a las aguas fétidas y mortíferas del Mar Muerto es todo un canto y una inspiración de los dones divinos. Donde no hay vida, Dios donará vida; donde no hay Espíritu, Dios suscitará Algo realmente nuevo.



La Primera Carta a los Corintios, 3:9-11, describe a los creyentes como colaboradores con Dios y la iglesia como un edificio o templo. Pablo explica que Jesús es el único fundamento sobre el cual se construye la iglesia. Declara que los creyentes son el templo de Dios donde el Espíritu Santo mora, y si alguien destruye este templo, Dios lo destruirá a él.

DEDICAÇÃO DA BASÍLICA DE LATRÃO



EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 2, 13-22

Estava próxima a Páscoa dos judeus e Jesus subiu a Jerusalém. Encontrou no templo os vendedores de bois, de ovelhas e de pombas e os cambistas sentados às bancas. Fez então um chicote de cordas e expulsou-os a todos do templo, com as ovelhas e os bois; deitou por terra o dinheiro dos cambistas e derrubou-lhes as mesas; e disse aos que vendiam pombas: «Tirai tudo isto daqui; não façais da casa de meu Pai casa de comércio». Os discípulos recordaram-se do que estava escrito: «Devora-me o zelo pela tua casa». Então os judeus tomaram a palavra e perguntaram-Lhe: «Que sinal nos dás de que podes proceder deste modo?». Jesus respondeu-lhes: «Destruí este templo e em três dias o levantarei». Disseram os judeus: «Foram precisos quarenta e seis anos para construir este templo e Tu vais levantá-lo em três dias?». Jesus, porém, falava do templo do seu Corpo. Por isso, quando Ele ressuscitou dos mortos, os discípulos lembraram-se do que tinha dito e acreditaram na Escritura e na palavra de Jesus.



Celebra-se neste dia o aniversário da dedicação da basílica de Latrão, construída pelo imperador Constantino, no tempo do papa Silvestre I (314-335), em honra de Cristo Salvador, e catedral da Igreja de Roma. Inicialmente foi uma festa da cidade de Roma. Mais tarde, estendeu-se à Igreja de Rito Romano, com o fim de honrar a basílica que é chamada «a igreja

mãe” de todas as igrejas do mundo. No evangelho, diante da reação de Jesus com os vendedores e cambistas que comerciavam dentro do templo de Jerusalém, precisamos fazer uma reflexão sobre a nossa postura em relação ao nosso serviço dentro da Igreja ou da Comunidade em que vivemos. Precisamos ter cuidado para não fazer das coisas de Deus cabide para dar suporte aos nossos interesses, respeitando a casa de Deus como um lugar sagrado, de recolhimento e oração. Assim como Jesus expulsou os vendilhões do templo, nós também com toda determinação necessitamos expulsar do nosso coração tudo o que possa estar fazendo do nosso interior uma casa de comércio, onde parem os pensamentos maus, interesseiros e as más intenções. Considerando que somos templo do Espírito Santo, nós também precisamos fazer do nosso interior um templo sagrado onde Deus habita.



O profeta Ezequiel exerce sua atividade entre os anos 593 e 571 antes de Cristo. Sacerdote exilado na Babilônia com uma parte do seu povo, ele anuncia as sentenças de Deus. O tema central desses versículos passa pelas palavras templo e água. Ezequiel percebe que sai água do templo em direção ao oriente. O volume de água vai crescendo sempre mais. A rota das águas é marcada pela vida. Ao entrar no mar, a água do templo torna-se potável. Por isso, por todo lugar por onde passar a torrente, os seres vivos que a povoam terão vida. “Haverá abundância de peixes, pois, aonde quer que essa água chegue, ela levará vida, de modo que haverá vida em todo lugar que a torrente atingir” (vv. 8-9). E essa água sai do templo onde mora Deus. É, portanto, mensageira de vida do Deus da vida que habita no meio do seu povo. O mar Morto chama-se assim porque, apesar de receber todo o volume de água doce do rio Jordão, não tem vida nem vazão. É, pois, símbolo de ausência de vida, sinônimo de morte. Mas com a água que sai do templo torna-se extremamente fecundo.
