## **First Sunday of Advent** **26/27 November 2022**

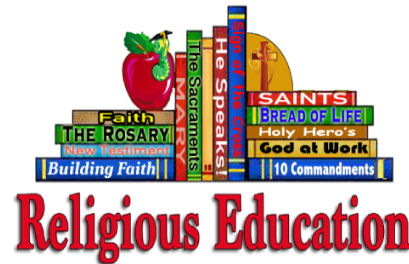

Gospel – Luke 23:35-43

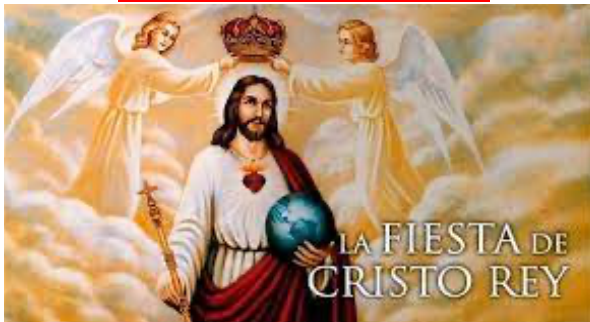

## Español

### NUESTRO SEÑOR JESUCRISTO, REY DEL UNIVERSO



#### EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 23, 35-43

Cuando Jesús estaba ya crucificado, las autoridades le hacían muecas, diciendo: “A otros ha salvado; que se salve a sí mismo, si él es el Mesías de Dios, el elegido”. También los soldados se burlaban de Jesús, y acercándose a él, le ofrecían vinagre y le decían: “Si tú eres el rey de los judíos, sálvate a ti mismo”. Había, en efecto, sobre la cruz un letrero en griego, latín y hebreo, que decía: “Este es el rey de los judíos”. Uno de los malhechores crucificados insultaba a Jesús, diciéndole: “Si tú eres el Mesías, sálvate a ti mismo y a nosotros”. Pero el otro le reclamaba, indignado. “Ni siquiera temes tú a Dios estando en el mismo suplicio? Nosotros justamente recibimos el pago de lo que hicimos. Pero éste ningún mal ha hecho”. Y le decía a Jesús: “Señor, cuando llegues a tu Reino, acuérdate de mí”. Jesús le respondió: “Yo te aseguro que hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso”.



Termina el año litúrgico, el ciclo del evangelio de Lucas y la Iglesia lo dedica a Jesucristo, ya que en El convergen todas las causas justas del mundo. La lectura de hoy de este evangelio de Lucas plantea claramente el rechazo del messianismo triunfalista. La aceptación del mesianismo del Siervo sufriente, móstranos a Jesús, al Justo, en el

suplicio de la cruz, la aceptación de un reinado mesiánico que no se corresponde con este mundo. El evangelio de Lucas forma parte del relato de la crucifixión, diríamos que es el momento culminante de un relato que encierra toda la teología de Lucas. El no entiende la muerte de Jesús como un fracaso. Y no lo es en verdad. Es el momento supremo de la entrega a una causa por la que merece dar la vida.



La lectura se ambienta en Hebrón, donde según la tradición, se conservan las tumbas de los Patriarcas del pueblo de la Alianza. Los del sur, a cuya tribu de Judá pertenece David, ya lo había proclamado rey. Ahora vienen las tribus del norte, las de Israel, para pedirle que lo quieren también como rey. David tenía fama de buen defensor y sobre él se tejera la leyenda sagrada de rey justo y capaz de alcanzar la unidad. El conquista la paz; aunque, lógicamente, la paz de David es una paz efímera, lo mismo que la solidaridad entre las tribus, entre el norte y el sur, se resiente de muchos defectos. Pero es el primer apunte de una teología de pacificación y solidaridad que solamente se encontrará con Jesús de Nazaret.



La segunda lectura, de la carta de Pablo a los colosenses, proclama que Cristo es el primogénito de la creación y de la salvación. Y él es la Cabeza del Cuerpo que es la Iglesia. No hay salvación sino por la unión con Cristo Cabeza, es decir, no hay salvación fuera de la Iglesia.

## Português

### NOSSO SENHOR JESUS CRISTO REI DO UNIVERSO



### EVANGELHO DE SÃO LUCAS 23, 35-43

Naquele tempo, os chefes dos judeus zombavam de Jesus, dizendo: *“Salvou os outros: salve-se a si mesmo, se é o Messias de Deus, o Eleito”*. Também os soldados troçavam dele; aproximando-se para lhe oferecerem vinagre, diziam: *“Se és o Rei do judeus, salva-te a ti mesmo”*. Por cima dele havia um letrado: Este é o Rei dos judeus. Entretanto, um dos malfeitores que tinham sido crucificado insultava-o, dizendo: *“Não és tu o Messias? Salva-te a ti mesmo e a nós também”*. Mas o outro, tomando a palavra, repreendeu-o: *“Não temes a Deus, tu que sofres o mesmo suplício? Quanto a nós, fez-se justiça, pois recebemos o castigo das nossas más acções. Mas ele nada praticou de condenável”*. E acrescentou: *“Jesus, lembra-te de mim, quando vieres com a tua realeza”*. Jesus respondeu-lhe: *“Em verdade te digo: Hoje estarás comigo no Paraíso”*.



Os israelitas estavam à espera de um grande rei. Sonhavam-no rico, revestido de mantos preciosos, forte, sentado num trono de ouro. Queriam vê-lo dominando sobre todos os povos, humilhando os inimigos. Alimentavam a esperança de que o seu reino deveria ser eterno e universal. No trecho do evangelho de hoje nos é apresentada a resposta de Deus a estas expectativas. Estamos no monte Calvário. Jesus está pregado na cruz, tem ao seu lado dois ladrões e sobre a sua cabeça está colocada uma inscrição: Este é o rei dos judeus. É

exatamente o contrário do que os homens estão acostumados a imaginar. Celebramos, com fé e a Solenidade de Nosso Senhor Jesus Cristo, Rei do Universo. É o último domingo do Ano Litúrgico, estamos a caminho do encontro com Jesus, que virá como Rei e Senhor da vida e da história. A força da realeza de Cristo está no amor, na justiça e misericórdia, no perdão e no serviço. Nosso Senhor veio para servir. Eis a sua realeza, pela morte de Cruz é vitorioso, é nosso Rei.



A primeira leitura deste domingo, do segundo livro de Samuel, apresenta-nos o momento em que David se tornou o rei e todo Israel. Com ele, iniciou-se um tempo de felicidade de abundância, de paz, que ficou na memória de todo o povo de Deus. Nos séculos seguintes, o Povo sonhava com o regresso a essa era de felicidade e com a restauração do Reino de David; e os profetas prometeram a chegada de um descendente de David que iria realizar esse sonho.

**Leitura da Carta de São Paulo aos Colossenses.**  
 Irmãos: Com alegria dai graças ao Pai, que vos tornou capazes de participar da luz, que é a herança dos santos. Ele nos libertou do poder das trevas e nos recebeu no reino de seu Filho amado, por quem temos a redenção, o perdão dos pecados.
