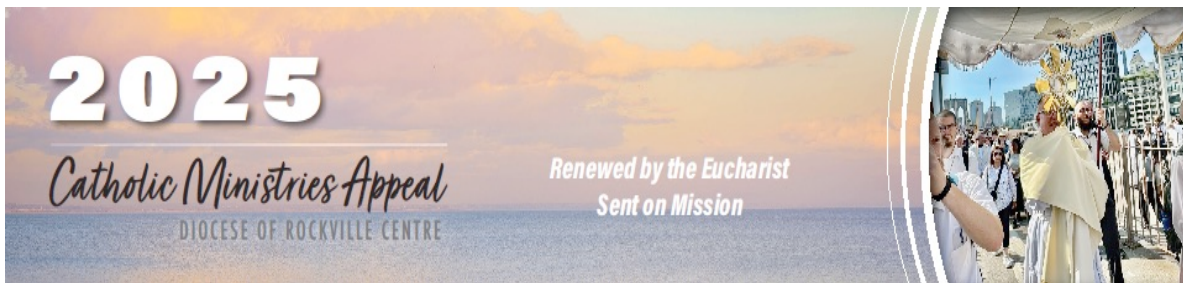

### Liturgical Minister Training- Spring 2025

The Diocese of Rockville Center will offer training for those who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors. No walk-ins permitted, all participants must be registered in advance with a letter from their pastor.

**Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion:** Part A - This training is required for **all** those who are beginning as Ministers. This “BASIC” training is required for **all** Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend Part B training in addition to BASIC training. One **must** attend Part A training prior to Part B training. A **Lector Workshop** is available for both new and experienced lectors.

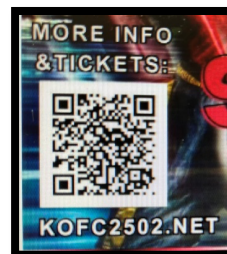

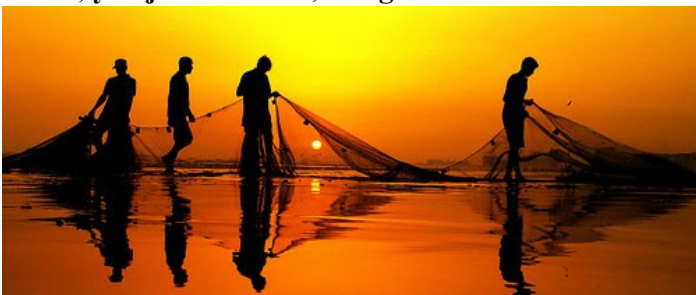

## V DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



### EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 5, 1-11

En aquel tiempo, Jesús estaba a orilla del lago de Genesaret y la gente se agolpaba en torno suyo para oír la palabra de Dios. Jesús vio dos barcas que estaban junto a la orilla. Los pescadores habían desembarcado y estaban lavando las redes. Subió Jesús a una de las barcas, la de Simón, le pidió que la alejara un poco de tierra y sentado en la barca, enseñaba a la multitud. Cuando acabó de hablar, dijo a Simón: *“Lleva la barca a mar adentro y echen sus redes para pescar”*. Simón replicó: *“Maestro, hemos trabajado toda la noche y no hemos pescado nada; pero, confiado en tu palabra, echaré las redes”*. Así lo hizo y cogieron tal cantidad de pescados, que las redes se rompían. Entonces hicieron señas a sus compañeros que estaban en la otra barca, para que vinieran a ayudarlos. Vinieron ellos y llenaron tanto las dos barcas, que casi se hundían. Al ver esto, Simón Pedro se arrojó a los pies de Jesús y le dijo: *“Apártate de mí, Señor, porque soy un pecador”*. Porque tanto él como sus compañeros estaban llenos de asombro al ver la pesca que habían conseguido. Lo mismo les pasaba a Santiago y a Juan, hijos de Zebedeo, que eran compañeros de Simón. Entonces Jesús le dijo a Simón: *“No temas; desde ahora serás pescador de hombres”*. Luego llevaron las barcas a tierra, y dejándolo todo, lo siguieron.



Así nos describe el evangelista Lucas lo ocurrido a Pedro en su barca la noche antes de que Jesús le invitase a adentrarse en el mar y echar las redes para pescar. La decepción de un profesional de la pesca provocó en Pedro cierta resistencia a obedecer al Maestro que le invita a volver a su tarea. Pedro quiere justificar su próximo fracaso advirtiendo a Jesús que esa zona no ofrece posibilidad de captura, pero ya que lo dice el Señor, su Maestro, él lanzará las redes. La sorpresa es inmensa como enorme fue también la captura conseguida. Pedro se siente humillado ante su Señor, autor del hecho admirable que se ha convertido en una lección de confianza y obediencia. Él se sabía fracasado por haber pasado la noche bregando sin haber capturado ni una sola pieza; pero ahora se siente más humillado todavía ante el abundante regalo que le ha hecho el Señor por haber lanzado las redes sin fiarse plenamente de su Maestro. Diríamos que Jesús premia con holgura la obediencia a regañadientes de Pedro. Quería el Maestro enseñar a Pedro que su tarea como discípulo y apóstol del Señor no debía apoyarse sólo en sus conocimientos y posibilidades, sino en la misión que Jesús le ordena. La presencia de Dios en la barca de Pedro hace el milagro de llenar la barca vacía a pesar de haber bregado toda la noche; hoy podemos volver a sentir esos milagros de cada día si somos capaces de poner a Dios en nuestras vidas: de repente lo baldío da fruto, y nuestras vidas vacías y sin sentido recobran esperanza y plenitud.



En la lectura profética se nos describe la experiencia de Isaías en el templo de Jerusalén cuando es llamado para ser enviado y hablar al pueblo en nombre de Dios. El profeta se siente indigno, porque ha tenido una experiencia tan intensa de lo que es Dios, de lo que es su Palabra, que no se atreve a hablar a un pueblo infiel, ya que él mismo se considera parte de ese mismo pueblo.

## Português

### DOMINGO V DO TEMPO COMUM



#### EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 5, 1-11

Naquele tempo, estava a multidão aglomerada em volta de Jesus, para ouvir a palavra de Deus. Ele encontrava-se na margem do lago de Genesaré e viu dois barcos estacionados no lago. Os pescadores tinham deixado os barcos e estavam a lavar as redes. Jesus subiu para um barco, que era de Simão, e pediu-lhe que se afastasse um pouco da terra. Depois sentou-se e do barco pôs-se a ensinar a multidão. Quando acabou de falar, disse a Simão: Faz-te ao largo e lança as redes para a pesca. Respondeu-lhe Simão: *“Mestre, andámos na faina toda a noite e não apanhamos nada. Mas, já que o dizes, lançarei as redes”*. Eles assim fizeram e apanharam tão grande quantidade de peixes que as redes começaram a romper-se. Fizeram sinal aos companheiros que estavam no outro barco, para os virem ajudar; eles vieram e encheram ambos os barcos de tal modo que quase se afundavam. Ao ver o sucedido, Simão Pedro lançou-se aos pés de Jesus e disse-lhe: *“Senhor, afasta-te de mim, que sou um homem pecador”*. Na verdade, o temor tinha se apoderado dele e de todos os seus companheiros, por causa da pesca realizada. Isto mesmo sucedeu a Tiago e a João, filhos de Zebedeu, que eram companheiros de Simão. Jesus disse a Simão: *“Não temas. Daqui em diante serás pescador de homens”*. Tendo conduzido os barcos para a terra, eles deixaram tudo e seguiram Jesus.



No muito conhecido relato da pesca milagrosa, Jesus dirige seu primeiro chamado a Pedro e aos outros. Até este momento, eles haviam sido discípulos distantes do Senhor. Mas partir do momento em que descobrem a verdade absoluta e o poder da palavra de Jesus no milagre da pesca, ficam preparados para seguir Jesus mais de perto na tarefa da evangelização. O motivo principal pelo qual Lucas nos narra este episódio é o de explicar aos discípulos de suas comunidades que a missão que devem cumprir neste mundo é esta: são chamados a ser pescadores de homens. Esta missão não é confiada só aos padres, mas a toda a comunidade cristã. Ela tem a responsabilidade de mostrar que é possível construir uma sociedade fundada em novos princípios: no perdão, na partilha dos bens, no serviço recíproco, no respeito pelos outros.



A primeira leitura traz-nos a descrição do chamamento do profeta Isaías. Enquanto dialoga com Deus, Isaías apercebe-se de que Deus tem planos para ele. Apesar de se sentir frágil e indigno, Isaías abraça o convite de Deus e responde, com toda a convicção: *“eis-me aqui: podeis enviar-me”*.

**“Antes de tudo,  
vos entreguei o que também recebi: que  
Cristo morreu pelos nossos pecados,  
segundo as escrituras.”**

I Coríntios 15: 3

Na segunda leitura, São Paulo fala-nos da ressurreição de Cristo que nos permite encarar a vida com esperança. Recorda-nos que somos chamados – como o próprio Paulo foi – a acreditarmos e a sermos testemunhas da vida nova que brota de Jesus.
