### Liturgical Minister Training- Spring 2026

The Diocese of Rockville Center will offer training for those who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors. No walk-ins permitted, all participants must be registered in advance, with a letter from their pastor.

**Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion: Part A** - This training is required for **all** those who are beginning as Ministers. This “BASIC” training is required for **all** Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend Part B training in addition to BASIC training. One **must** attend Part A training prior to Part B training. A **Lector Workshop** is available for both new and experienced lectors.



### STATIONS OF THE CROSS

## III DOMINGO DE CUARESMA



### EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 4, 5-42

En aquel tiempo, llegó Jesús a una ciudad de Samaria llamada Sicar, cerca del campo que dio Jacob a su hijo José; ahí estaba el pozo de Jacob. Jesús, cansado del camino, estaba allí sentado junto al pozo. Era hacia la hora sexta. Llega una mujer de Samaria a sacar agua, y Jesús le dice: «Dame de beber». Sus discípulos se habían ido al pueblo a comprar comida. La samaritana le dice: «¿Cómo tú, siendo judío, me pides de beber a mí, que soy samaritana?» (porque los judíos no se tratan con los samaritanos). Jesús le contestó: «Si conocieras el don de Dios y quién es el que te dice “dame de beber”, le pedirías tú, y él te daría agua viva». La mujer le dice: «Señor, si no tienes con qué sacar agua, y el pozo es hondo, ¿cómo vas a darme el agua viva?; ¿Acaso eres tú más que nuestro padre Jacob, que nos dio este pozo, y de él bebieron él y sus hijos y sus ganados?». Jesús le contestó: «El que bebe de esta agua vuelve a tener sed. Pero el que beba del agua que yo le daré nunca más tendrá sed; el agua que yo le daré se convertirá dentro de él en un manantial capaz de dar la vida eterna». La mujer le dice: «Señor, dame esa agua: así no tendré más sed, ni tendré que venir aquí a sacarla». «Ya veo que tú eres un profeta. Nuestros padres dieron culto en este monte, y vosotros decís que el sitio donde se debe dar culto está en Jerusalén». Jesús le dice: «Créeme, mujer: se acerca la hora en que ni en este monte ni en Jerusalén adorarán al Padre. Vosotros adoráis a uno que no conocéis; nosotros adoramos a uno que conocemos, porque la salvación viene de los judíos. Pero se acerca la hora, ya está aquí, en que los verdaderos adoradores adorarán al Padre en espíritu y verdad, porque el Padre desea que lo adoren así. Dios es espíritu, y los que lo adoran deben hacerlo en espíritu y verdad». La mujer le dice: «Sé que va a venir el

Mesías, el Cristo; cuando venga, él nos dará razón de todo». Jesús le dice: «Soy yo, el que habla contigo». En aquel pueblo muchos samaritanos creyeron en él por el testimonio que había dado la mujer: «Me ha dicho todo lo que he hecho». Así, cuando llegaron a verlo los samaritanos, le rogaban que se quedara con ellos. Y se quedó allí dos días. Todavía creyeron muchos más por su predicación, y decían a la mujer: «Ya no creemos por lo que tú dices; nosotros mismos lo hemos oído y sabemos que él es de verdad el salvador del mundo».



[Juan 4:5-42](#) destaca el encuentro transformador con "agua viva" que sacia la sed espiritual de amor, perdón y vida eterna. Jesús derriba barreras culturales y de género, mostrando que el verdadero adorador busca a Dios en espíritu y verdad, convirtiéndose la samaritana en testigo de su fe. De siglos venía la enemistad entre los judíos y los samaritanos; por eso, cuando vieron a Jesús hablando con una samaritana se extrañaron mucho. Pero Jesús, al hablar con la samaritana, les enseñó que para amar y adorar a nuestro Padre Dios, no hace falta ni se requiere un templo especial, porque Dios es espíritu, y es menester que le adoremos en espíritu y verdad, esto es. Desde el fondo de nuestro corazón.



En Éxodo 17, 3-7, el pueblo de Israel, sediento en el desierto de Refidim, murmura contra Moisés por la falta de agua, temiendo morir. Ante la amenaza de ser apedreado, Moisés clama a Dios, quien le ordena golpear la roca en Horeb con su vara, haciendo brotar agua para el pueblo. Moisés llama al lugar Masah y Meribá por la queja del pueblo y por probar a Jehová.

## Português

### DOMINGO III DA QUARESMA



#### EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 4, 5-42

Naquele tempo, chegou Jesus a uma cidade da Samaria, chamada Sicar, junto da propriedade que Jacob tinha dado a seu filho José, onde estava a fonte de Jacob. Jesus, cansado da caminhada, sentou-se à beira do poço. Era por volta do meio dia. Veio uma mulher da Samaria para tirar água. Disse-lhe Jesus: «Dá-me de beber». Os discípulos tinham ido à cidade comprar alimentos. Respondeu-lhe a samaritana: «Como é que tu, sendo judeu, me pedes de beber, sendo eu samaritana?» De facto, os judeus não se dão com os samaritanos. Disse-lhe Jesus: «Se conhecesses o dom de Deus e quem é aquele que te diz: ‘Dá-me de beber’, tu é que lhe pedirias e ele te daria água viva». Respondeu-lhe a mulher: «Senhor, tu nem sequer tens um balde, e o poço é fundo: donde te vem a água viva? Serás tu maior do que o nosso pai Jacob, que nos deu este poço, do qual ele mesmo bebeu, com os seus filhos e os seus rebanhos?» Disselhe Jesus: «Todo aquele que bebe desta água voltará a ter sede. Mas aquele que beber da água que eu lhe der nunca mais terá sede: a água que eu lhe der tornar-se á nele uma nascente que jorra para a vida eterna». «Senhor, suplicou a mulher dá me dessa água, para que eu não sinta mais sede e não tenha de vir aqui buscá-la». Os nossos antepassados adoraram neste monte e vós dizeis que é em Jerusalém que se deve adorar». Disse-lhe Jesus: «Mulher, podes acreditar em Mim: Vai chegar a hora em que nem neste monte nem em Jerusalém adorareis o Pai. Vós adorais o que não conheceis; nós adoramos o que conhecemos, porque a salvação vem dos judeus. Mas vai chegar a hora – e já chegou – em que os verdadeiros adoradores hão de adorar o Pai em

espírito a verdade, pois são esses os adoradores que o Pai deseja. Deus é espírito e os seus adoradores devem adorá-lo em espírito e verdade». Disse-lhe a mulher: «Eu sei que há de vir o Messias, isto é, Aquele que chamam Cristo. Quando vier há de anunciar nos todas as coisas». Respondeu-lhe Jesus: «Sou eu, que estou a falar contigo». Muitos samaritanos daquela cidade acreditaram em Jesus, por causa da palavra da mulher, que testemunhava: «Ele disse-me tudo o que eu fiz». Por isso os samaritanos, quando vieram ao encontro de Jesus, pediram-lhe que ficasse com eles. E ficou lá dois dias. Ao ouvi-lo, muitos acreditaram e diziam à mulher: «Já não é por causa das tuas palavras que acreditamos. Nós próprios ouvimos e sabemos que Ele é realmente o Salvador do mundo».



Os discípulos foram à procura do alimento material; a mulher veio buscar água ao poço. Mas Jesus oferece a todos um alimento e uma água que eles não conhecem. A água da samaritana é o símbolo das necessidades mais íntimas que atormentam o coração de Israel e o nosso coração: a necessidade de paz, de amor, de esperança, de felicidade. A água viva que Jesus promete é de outro gênero, é o espírito de Deus, é aquele amor que enche os corações. Quem se deixa guiar por este Espírito não precisa de mais nada. Aquela mulher anónima da Samaria, depois de encontrar o “salvador do mundo” que veio trazer aos homens a água que mata a sede de vida eterna, não guardou para si própria essa experiência inolvidável e não se fechou em casa a gozar a sua descoberta... Correu para a cidade e partilhou com os seus concidadãos a verdade que tinha encontrado e que tinha alterado a sua visão da vida.
