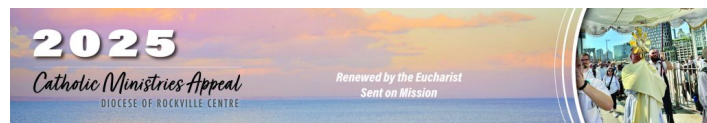

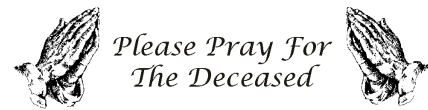

## **V DOMINGO DE CUARESMA**



### **EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 8, 1-11**

En aquel tiempo, Jesús se retiró al monte de los Olivos y al amanecer se presentó de nuevo en el templo, donde la multitud se le acercaba; y él, sentado entre ellos, enseñaba. Entonces los escribas y fariseos le llevaron a una mujer sorprendida en adulterio, y poniéndola frente a él, le dijeron: *“Maestro, esta mujer ha sido sorprendida en flagrante adulterio. Moisés nos manda en la ley apedrear a estas mujeres. ¿Tú, qué dices?”* Le preguntaban esto para ponerle una trampa y poder acusarlo. Pero Jesús se agachó y se puso a escribir en el suelo con el dedo. Pero como insistían en su pregunta, se incorporó y les dijo: *“Aquel de ustedes que no tenga pecado, que le tire la primera piedra”*. Se volvió a agachar y siguió escribiendo en el suelo. Al oír aquellas palabras, los acusadores comenzaron a escabullirse uno tras otro, empezando por los más viejos, hasta que dejaron solos a Jesús y a la mujer, que estaba de pie, junto a él. Entonces Jesús se enderezó y le preguntó: *“Mujer, ¿dónde están los que te acusaban? ¿Nadie te ha condenado?”* Ella le contestó: *“Nadie, Señor”*. Y Jesús le dijo: *“Tampoco yo te condeno. Vete y ya no vuelvas a pecar”*.



El libro del Levítico dice: si adultera un hombre con la mujer de su prójimo, hombre y mujer adúlteros serán castigados con la muerte (Lv 20,10); y el Deuteronomio, por su parte, exige: los llevaréis a los dos a las puertas de la ciudad y los lapidaréis hasta matarlos (Dt 22,24). Estas eran las penas establecidas por la Ley. Dios esto no ha exigido nunca, sino que la cultura de la época impuso estos castigos como exigencias morales. Jesús no puede estar de acuerdo con ello: ni con las leyes de lapidación y muerte, ni con la ignominia de que solamente el ser más débil – la mujer – tenga que pagar públicamente. ¿Solamente los débiles son los culpables? Jesús no mandó buscar al compañero para que juntos pagaran. Lo que indigna a Jesús es la dureza de corazón de los fuertes oculta en el puritanismo de aplicar una ley tan injusta como inhumana. En el relato del evangelio Jesús se sitúa en un terreno que trasciende la Ley, y no es que él transgreda, sino que la supera. Toda religión que exige la pena de muerte ante los pecados... deja de ser verdadera religión, porque Dios no quiere la muerte del pecador. Esto debería ser una conquista absoluta de la humanidad.



El texto de Isaías recuerda el momento culminante de la actuación de Dios en el Antiguo Testamento: la liberación de Egipto. Hacer memoria del pasado es bueno, no para la nostalgia, sino precisamente para renovarse.



Este es uno de los pasajes más íntimos y personales del apóstol Pablo. Nos habla de lo que supone para él haber conocido a Cristo.

### DOMINGO V DA QUARESMA



### EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 8., 1-11

Naquele tempo, Jesus foi para o monte das Oliveiras. Mas de manhã cedo, apareceu outra vez no templo e todo o povo se aproximou-se dele. Então sentou-se e começou a ensinar. Os escribas e os fariseus apresentaram a Jesus uma mulher surpreendida em adultério, colocaram-na no meio dos presentes e disseram a Jesus: *“Mestre, esta mulher foi surpreendida em flagrante adultério. Na Lei, Moisés mandou-nos apedrejar tais mulheres. Tu que dizes?”* Falavam assim para lhe armarem uma cilada e terem pretexto para o acusar. Mas Jesus, inclinou-se e começou a escrever com o dedo no chão. Como persistiam a interrogá-lo, ergueu-se disse-lhes: *“Quem de entre vós estiver sem pecado atire a primeira pedra”*. Inclinou-se novamente e continuou a escrever no chão. Eles, porém, quando ouviram tais palavras, foram saindo um após outro, a começar pelos mais velhos, e ficou só Jesus e a mulher, que estava no meio. Jesus ergueu-se e disse-lhe: *“Mulher, onde estão eles? Ninguém te condenou?”* Ela respondeu: *“Ninguém, Senhor”*. Disse então Jesus: *“Nem eu te condeno. Vai e não tornes a pecar”*.



Este Evangelho da pecadora adúltera retoma o tema da misericórdia de Deus, tão próprio da Quaresma e quer pôr em evidência não os nossos méritos e esforços, mas a gratuidade desta graça. Jesus não desautoriza a Lei, mas supera-a com um gesto de misericórdia. A misericórdia de Jesus não condena. Neste Evangelho, Jesus reprova a atitude condenatória e estritamente legalista dos escribas e fariseus. É surpreendente que não se fale do parceiro da mulher adúltera. Por que também ele não foi agarrado? Aqueles homens eram tão pecadores quanto a adúltera, ou mais; no entanto se colocam como juízes dessa pecadora. Essa é a essência da hipocrisia. Devemos nos questionar primeiro, antes de julgar os outros. Remover primeiramente a trave dos nossos olhos antes de querer tirar o cisco no olho alheio.

#### Leitura da Carta de São Paulo aos Filipenses.



Irmãos, na verdade,  
considero tudo como  
perda diante da  
vantagem suprema que  
consiste em conhecer a Cristo  
Jesus, meu Senhor.

**Por causa dele eu perdi tudo.**

Na segunda leitura São Paulo partilha com os cristãos da cidade de Filipos a sua experiência: desde que se encontrou com Cristo, Paulo deixou para trás todo o “lixo” que lhe limitava os movimentos e que o impedia de correr ao encontro de Cristo. A sua grande preocupação é identificar-se cada vez mais com Cristo e correr para a meta final, onde espera encontrar a vida definitiva.
