## Pastor's Notes

This spring 2023 feels like the first time that I as your Pastor, am not contemplating huge financial costs for construction projects around the parish. In the last six years we have spent in excess of 2.5 million dollars of your money (and insurance coverage) on the parish buildings (exterior roofs on church and school; parking lots; boilers; windows in school; Last Supper window in Sanctuary; ceiling repair in church; lighting and security cameras; gym floor; bathroom repairs; just to mention the necessary major expenditures). As you can see in the accompanying picture, the only construction we are planning for this summer is a wheelchair ramp leading people into the main entrance of the church (estimates under \$20,000; to be paid for by our parish Fall-Fundraiser). Fortunately, Corpus Christi still stands on solid financial footing: because of parishioners' generosity all year long (Easter alone \$55,000); because of some strong and safe portfolio investments; because of some generous wills/bequests; and because of a deeply dedicated finance committee led by chairperson Ann-Marie Ely, trustee Patricia Moyett, and trustee Joe Basel. Thank you one and all, for making my life and job a lot easier!

Our existence is founded on God's unbreakable love and faithfulness. In order to enter eternal life we must listen to Jesus. We have to tune our minds to the sound of his voice. Self-centeredness can make us deaf to the voice of Jesus. Easy options can draw us into easier paths than the one he has for us. Pressure to abandon Christian principles is inevitable. But God is faithful and will not let us be tempted beyond our strength. No one can drag us away from him, The Father has entrusted us to his Son.

## IV DOMINGO DE PÁSCOA



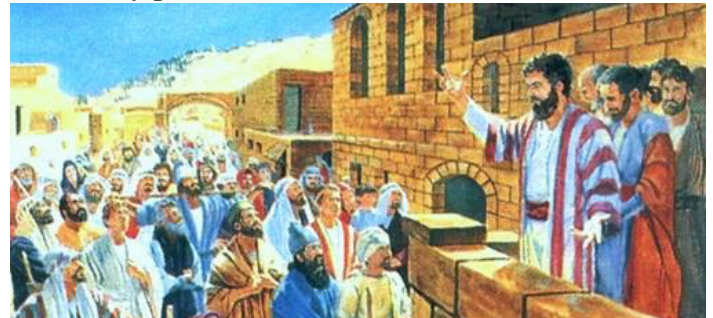
### EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 10, 1-10

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a los fariseos: *“Yo les aseguro que el que no entra por la puerta del redil de las ovejas, sino que salta por otro lado, es un ladrón, un bandido; pero el que entra por la puerta, ése es el pastor de las ovejas. A ése le abre el que cuida la puerta, y las ovejas reconocen su voz; él llama a cada una por su nombre y las conduce afuera. Y cuando ha sacado a todas sus ovejas camina delante de ellas, y ellas lo siguen porque conocen su voz. Pero a un extraño no lo seguirán, sino que huirán de él, porque no conocen la voz de los extraños. Jesús les puso esta comparación, pero ellos no entendieron lo que les quería decir. Por eso añadió: Les aseguro que yo soy la puerta de las ovejas. Todos los que han venido antes que yo, son ladrones y bandidos; pero mis ovejas no los han escuchado. Yo soy la puerta; quien entre por mí se salvará, podrá entrar y salir y encontrará pastos. El ladrón sólo viene a robar, a matar y a destruir. Yo he venido para que tengan vida y la tengan en abundancia”.*



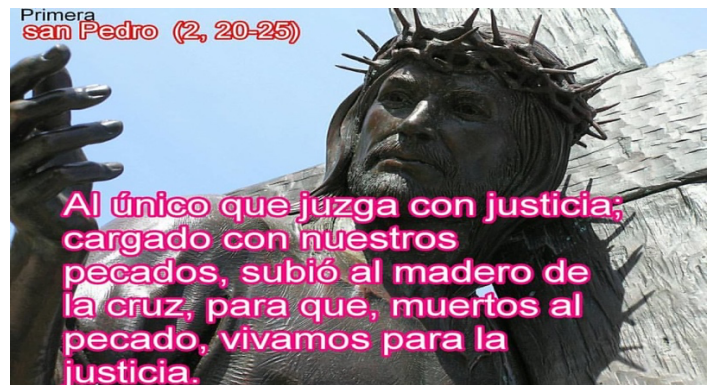
El evangelio de Juan, nos habla del buen pastor que es la imagen del día en la liturgia de este cuarto domingo de Pascua. Comienza el evangelio con una especie de discurso enigmático, que es así para los oyentes, que este texto es bien claro: en el redil de las ovejas, el pastor entra por la puerta, los ladrones saltan por el muro. Jesús en este evangelio se propone como la persona en la que podemos confiar; por Él podemos entrar y salir para encontrar a Dios y para encontrar la vida. Quien esté fuera de esa puerta, quien pretende construir un mundo al

margen de Jesús lo puede hacer, pero no hay otro camino para encontrarse con Dios de vida y con la verdad de nuestra existencia. Se habla de un entrar y salir, que son dos verbos significativos de la vida, como el nacer y el morir. En Jesús, puerta verdadera de la vida, ésta adquiere una dimensión inigualable. Jesús hace lo contrario de los ladrones que entran de cualquier manera en la casa para robar, para matar, para llevarse todo lo que pueden. El pastor verdadero da la vida por sus ovejas. Jesús es el verdadero pastor porque conoce a sus ovejas. Por eso los sacerdotes y los que predicán el evangelio deben ser como Jesús. Infelizmente hay tantos predicadores que se aprovechan de su condición para explotar a la gente. Es lo que sucedía en el tiempo de Jesús. Los escribas y fariseos utilizaban la religión para dominar y para robar.



La lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles en la segunda lectura quiere mostrar las consecuencias del discurso de Pedro, que era el centro de esta lectura en el domingo anterior. El mensaje debe resonar con fuerza: el crucificado, es el Señor y Mesías. Y es Dios quien lo ha constituido como tal. La respuesta, desde el corazón de los oyentes, ante el anuncio de la Pascua, ofrece a Lucas la oportunidad de mostrar un itinerario bautismal. El misterio de la Pascua es tan radical tan profundo, que el hombre que oye hablar de los que el Señor ha hecho por nosotros debe preguntarse por el sentido de su vida. El mensaje de esta lectura es el de la conversión.

## DOMINGO IV DA PÁSCOA



### EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 10, 1-10

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus: *“Em verdade, em verdade vos digo: Aquele que não entra no aprisco das ovelhas pela porta, mas entra por outro lado, é ladrão e salteador. Mas aquele que entra pela porta é o pastor das ovelhas. O porteiro abre-lhe a porta e as ovelhas conhecem a sua voz. Ela chama cada uma delas pelo seu nome e leva-as para fora. Depois de ter feito sair todas as que lhe pertencem, caminha à sua frente e as ovelhas seguem-no, porque conhecem a sua voz. Se for um estranho, não o seguem, mas fogem dele, porque não conhecem a voz dos estranhos. Jesus apresentou-lhes esta comparação, mas eles não compreenderam o que queria dizer”. Jesus continuou: “Em verdade, em verdade vos digo: Eu sou a porta das ovelhas. Aqueles que vieram antes de mim são ladroes e salteadores, mas as ovelhas não o escutaram. Eu sou a porta. Quem entra por mim será salvo: é como a ovelha que entra e sai do aprisco e encontra pastagem. O ladrão não vem senão para roubar, matar e destruir. Eu vim para que as minhas ovelhas tenham vida e a tenham em abundância”.*



Este é o domingo do bom Pastor. O Evangelho apresenta Cristo como o Pastor, cuja missão é libertar o rebanho de Deus do domínio da escravidão e levá-lo ao encontro das pastagens verdejantes onde

há vida em plenitude. O Evangelho diz: As ovelhas ouvem a sua voz: ele chama as ovelhas pelo nome. O Senhor nos chama pelo nome porque nos ama. Porém, diz ainda o Evangelho, há outras vozes a não serem seguidas: as de estranhos, ladrões e malfeitores que querem o mal das ovelhas. Jesus não esconde o ataque a seus inimigos, os dirigentes judeus, que parecem não se dar por atingidos na figura do ladrão e do bandido que saltam a cerca do redil. Jesus não usa meias palavras: os dirigentes judeus são ladrões e bandidos, que se servem das suas prerrogativas para explorar o povo e usam a violência para o manter sob a sua escravidão. Aproximam-se do Povo de Deus de forma abusiva e ilegítima, porque Deus não lhes confiou essa missão: foram eles que a usurparam. O seu objectivo não é o bem das ovelhas, mas o seu próprio interesse. Esse evangelho é uma mensagem muito importante para todos os dirigentes da Igreja. Servir o Povo de Deus, cuidar das ovelhas é a missão dos sacerdotes e de todos aqueles que pregam o Evangelho.



Continuamos no mesmo ambiente em que nos colocava a primeira leitura do passado domingo: em Jerusalém, na manhã do dia de Pentecostes. Pedro é o porta-voz de uma comunidade que, iluminada pelo Espírito, toma consciência da necessidade de testemunhar Jesus, a sua vida, a sua morte e a sua ressurreição. Diante dos habitantes de Jerusalém e dos forasteiros reunidos para a festa judaica do “Savuot” (Pentecostes – a festa que celebrava a aliança do monte Sinai e o dom da Lei), a comunidade cristã apresenta a pregação sobre Jesus e proclama a sua fé. A adesão a Jesus traduz-se num gesto: o receber o baptismo. Receber o baptismo significa receber o Espírito Santo. É o início do crescimento da comunidade cristã.
