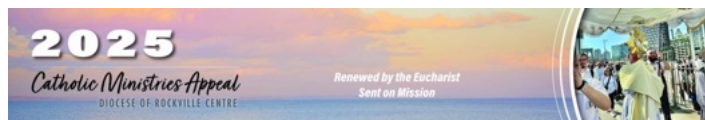

Holy Week, from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday, was a magnificent manifestation of resurrected faith and hope here at Corpus Christi! Sadly, on Easter Monday 21 April, our beloved Holy Father Pope Francis breathed his last and went home to the Risen Lord. Born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, Jorge Mario Bergoglio, was ordained to Priesthood in 1969, named Cardinal by Pope John Paul II in 2001 and then elected as Pope Francis on March 13, 2013. He was the 226th pope (the first non-European pope) and the first Latin American pontiff. As the leader of the Roman Catholic Church, Pope Francis was very modest and left behind a legacy of service, unity and compassion. He was the symbol of change and hope for the Catholic Church.

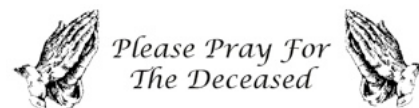

III DOMINGO III DA PÁSCOA



EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 21, 1-19

En aquel tiempo, Jesús se les apareció otra vez a los discípulos junto al lago de Tiberíades. Se les apareció de esta manera: Estaban juntos Simón Pedro, Tomás (llamado el Gemelo), Natanael (el de Caná de Galilea), los hijos de Zebedeo y otros dos discípulos. Simón Pedro les dijo: “Voy a pescar”. Ellos le respondieron: “También nosotros vamos contigo”. Salieron y se embarcaron, pero aquella noche no pescaron nada. Estaba amaneciendo, cuando Jesús se apareció en la orilla, pero los discípulos no lo reconocieron. Jesús les dijo: “Muchachos, ¿han pescado algo”? Ellos contestaron: “No”. Entonces él les dijo: “Echen la red a la derecha de la barca y encontrarán peces”. Así lo hicieron, y luego ya no podían jalar la red por tantos pescados. Entonces el discípulo a quien amaba Jesús le dijo a Pedro: “Es el Señor”. Tan pronto como Simón Pedro oyó decir que era el Señor, se anudó a la cintura la túnica, pues se la había quitado, y se tiró al agua. Los otros discípulos llegaron en la barca, arrastrando la red con los pescados, pues no distaban de tierra más de cien metros. Tan pronto como saltaron a tierra, vieron unas brasas y sobre ellas un pescado y pan. Jesús les dijo: “Traigan algunos pescados de los que acaban de pescar”. Entonces Simón Pedro subió a la barca y arrastró hasta la orilla la red, repleta de pescados grandes. Eran ciento cincuenta y tres, y a pesar de que eran tantos, no se rompió la red. Luego les dijo Jesús: “Vengan a almorzar”. Y ninguno de los discípulos se atrevía a preguntarle: ¿Quién eres?, porque ya sabían que era el Señor. Jesús se acercó, tomó el pan y se los dio y también el pescado. Esta fue la tercera vez que Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos después de resucitar de entre los muertos. Después de almorzar le preguntó Jesús a Simón Pedro: “Simón, hijo de Juan, ¿me amas más que éstos”? Él le contestó: “Sí, Señor, tú sabes que te quiero”. Jesús le dijo: “Apacienta mis corderos”. Por

segunda vez le preguntó: “Simón, hijo de Juan, ¿me amas”? Él le respondió: “Sí, Señor, tú sabes que te quiero”. Jesús le dijo: “Pastorea mis ovejas”. Por tercera vez le preguntó: “Simón, hijo de Juan, ¿me quieres”? Pedro se entristeció de que Jesús le hubiera preguntado por tercera vez si lo quería y le contestó: “Señor, tú lo sabes todo; tú bien sabes que te quiero”. Jesús le dijo: “Apacienta mis ovejas. Yo te aseguro: cuando eras joven, tú mismo te ceñías la ropa e ibas a donde querías; pero cuando seas viejo, extenderás los brazos y otro te ceñirá y te llevará a donde no quieras”. Esto se lo dijo para indicarle con qué género de muerte habría de glorificar a Dios. Después le dijo: Sígame.



El evangelio de este domingo, como todo Juan 21, es muy probablemente un añadido a la obra cuando ya estaba terminada. Pero procede de la misma comunidad de Juan, pues contiene su mismo estilo, lenguaje y las mismas claves teológicas. Quiere ser una afora de resarcir a Pedro, el primero de los apóstoles, de sus tres negaciones en el momento de la Pasión. Jesús pide a Pedro el testimonio de su amor y su fidelidad, porque a él le debe encomendar la responsabilidad de la primera comunidad de discípulos. Sus negaciones, sus miserias, su debilidad, no impiden que pueda ser el guía de la comunidad de los discípulos. Su amor al Señor ha curado su pasado, sus negaciones. En el evangelio de Juan todo se cura con el amor.

DOMINGO III DA PÁSCOA



EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 21, 1-14

Naquele tempo, Jesus manifestou-se outra vez aos seus discípulos, junto ao mar de Tiberíades. Manifestou-se deste modo: Estavam juntos Simão Pedro e Tomé, chamado Dídimo, Natanael, que era de Caná da Galileia, os filhos de Zebedeu e mais dois discípulos de Jesus. Disse-lhes Simão Pedro: *“Vou pescar”*. Eles responderam-lhe: *“Nós vamos contigo”*. Saíram de casa e subiram para o barco, mas naquela noite não apanharam nada. Ao romper da manhã, Jesus apresentou-se na margem, mas os discípulos não sabiam que era ele. Disse-lhes Jesus: *“Rapazes, tendes alguma coisa de comer?”* Eles responderam: *“Não”*. Disse-lhes Jesus: *“Lançai a rede para a direita do barco e encontrareis”*. Eles lançaram a rede e já mal a podiam arrastar por causa da abundância de peixes. O discípulo predilecto de Jesus disse a Pedro: *“É o Senhor”*. Simão Pedro, quando ouviu dizer que era o Senhor, vestiu a túnica que tinha tirado e lançou-se ao mar. Os outros discípulos, que estavam apenas a uns duzentos côvados da margem, vieram no barco, puxando a rede com os peixes. Quando saltaram em terra, viram brasas acesas com peixe em cima, e pão. Disse-lhes Jesus: *“Trazei alguns dos peixes que apanhastes agora”*. Simão Pedro subiu ao barco e puxou a rede para terra cheia de cento e cinquenta e três grandes peixes: e apesar de serem tantos, não se rompeu a rede. Disse-lhes Jesus: *“Vinde comer”*. Nenhum dos discípulos se atrevia a perguntar: Quem és tu?, porque bem sabiam que era o Senhor. Jesus aproximou-se, tomou o pão e deu-lho, fazendo o mesmo com os peixes. Esta foi a terceira vez que Jesus se manifestou aos seus discípulos depois de ter ressuscitado dos mortos. Depois de comerem, Jesus perguntou a Simão Pedro: *“Simão, filho de João, tu amas-me mais do que estes?”* Ele respondeu-lhe: *“Sim, Senhor, tu*

sabes que te amo”. Disse-lhe Jesus: *“Apascenta os meus cordeiros”*. Voltou a pergunta-lhe: *“Simão, filho de João, tu amas-me?”* Ele respondeu-lhe: *“Sim, Senhor, tu sabes que te amo”*. Disse-lhe Jesus: *“Apascenta as minhas ovelhas”*. Perguntou-lhe pela terceira vez: *“Simão, filho de João, tu amas-me?”* Pedro entristeceu-se por Jesus lhe ter perguntado pela terceira vez se o amava e respondeu-se: *“Senhor, tu sabes tudo, bem sabes que te amo”*. Disse-lhe Jesus: *“Apascenta as minhas ovelhas. Em verdade, em verdade te digo: Quando eras mais novo, tu mesmo te cingias e andavas por onde querias; mas quando fores mais velho, estenderás a mão e outro te cingirá e te levará para onde não queres”*. Jesus disse isto para indicar o género de morte com que Pedro havia de *dar glória a Deus*. Dito isto, acrescentou: *“Segue-me”*.



O evangelho deste domingo não situa a aparição de Jesus num domingo, mas num dia de semana, pois a aparição ocorre enquanto os discípulos estão entretidos no trabalho: estão pescando. Ao voltarmos nosso olhar para o evangelho, contemplamos o diálogo entre Jesus e Pedro, no qual Cristo, por três vezes, pergunta a Pedro se ele o ama. Nesse questionamento repetido, revela-se o centro da missão cristã: o amor. Diante da resposta afirmativa de Pedro, Jesus lhe confiou a tarefa de apascentar seus cordeiros e cuidar de seus rebanhos. Esse chamado nos ensina que o amor deve ser a força geradora de toda a ação evangelizadora, pois somente amando verdadeiramente, como Cristo nos amou, seremos capazes de cuidar e guiar o próximo no caminho da fé.
