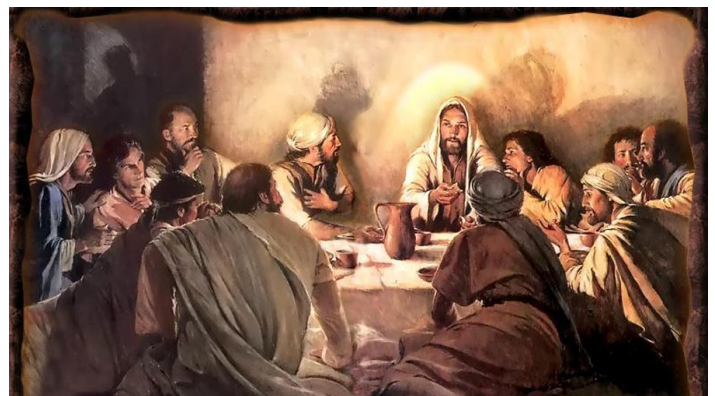

Corpus Christi's 2023 "Continuing the Educational Mission" Scholarship Award

We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi "***Continuing the Educational Mission***" **Scholarship** award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for several months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the success from past years, we will continue to offer three scholarships this year:

- One for 2 student parishioners attending a Catholic High School
- One for a student parishioner attending, full time, a college or university.

Now three young people from our parish will each be awarded a scholarship toward their education. A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to two students who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2023 for the academic school year 2023/2024.

A scholarship award of \$7,000 will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a full-time course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending starting September 2023, a 2-4-year college or university for the academic school year 2023/2024.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester.

The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and **not** from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer on or around July 31. The scholarship is for one year. Applications must be submitted to the rectory by July 1, 2023.

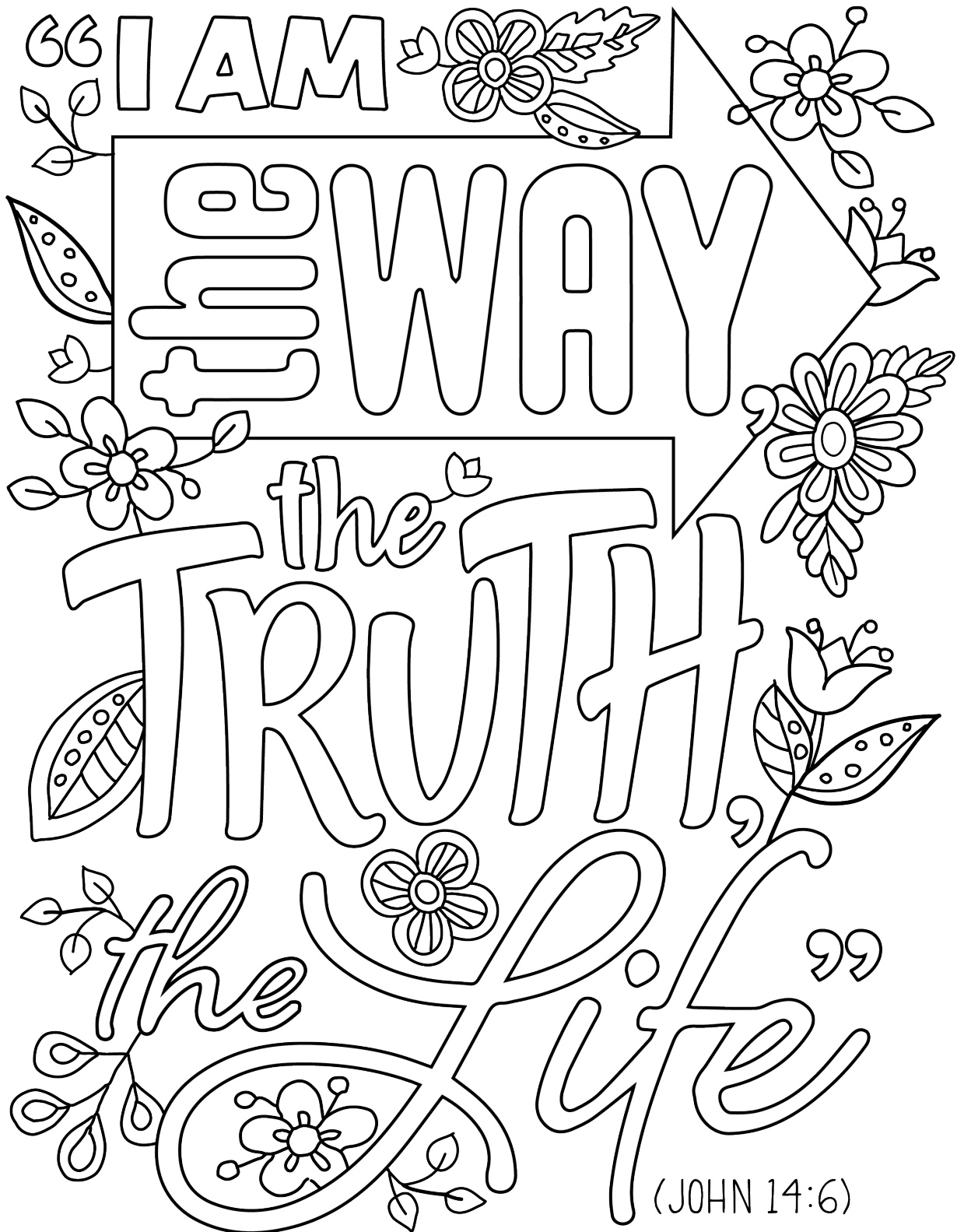

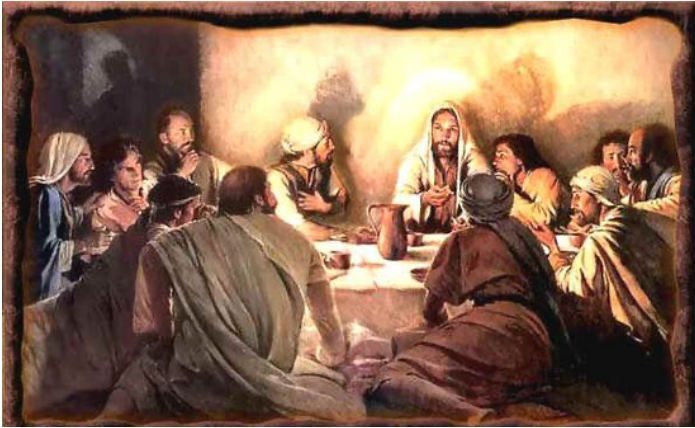

V DOMINGO DE PASCUA



EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 14, 1-12

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: *“No pierdan la paz. Si creen en Dios, crean también en mí. En la casa de mi Padre hay muchas habitaciones. Si no fuera así, yo se lo habría dicho a ustedes, porque voy a prepararles un lugar. Cuando me vaya y les prepare un sitio, volveré y los llevaré conmigo, para que donde yo esté, estén también ustedes. Y ya saben el camino para llegar al lugar a donde voy”*. Entonces Tomás le dijo: *“Señor, no sabemos a dónde vas, ¿cómo podemos saber el camino?”* Jesús le respondió: *“Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida. Nadie va al Padre si no es por mí. Si ustedes me conocen a mí, conocen también a mi Padre. Ya desde ahora lo conocen y lo han visto”*. Le dijo Felipe: *“Señor, muéstranos al Padre y eso nos basta”*. Jesús le replicó: *“Felipe, tanto tiempo hace que estoy con ustedes, y todavía no me conoces? Quien me ha visto a mí, ha visto al Padre. ¿Entonces por qué dices: Muéstranos al Padre? ¿O no crees que yo estoy en el Padre y que el Padre está en mí? Las palabras que yo les digo, no las digo por mi propia cuenta. Es el Padre, que permanece en mí quien hace las obras. Créanme: Yo les aseguro: el que crea en mí, hará las obras que hago yo y las hará aún mayores, porque yo me voy al Padre”*.

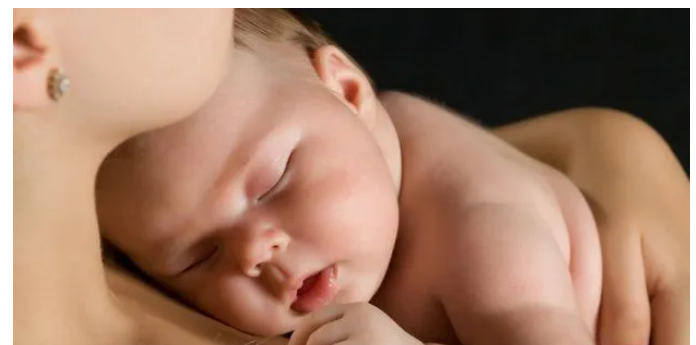


El Evangelio de hoy de Juan, es uno de los discursos

de revelación más densos de su obra. Está inserto en el testamento de Jesús a los discípulos en la última cena. Él empieza a despedirse de sus discípulos. Estos están un poco desorientados y desconcertados. No saben lo que va a ser de ellos. Es un relato muy particular de este evangelista. Aquella noche, entiende Juan, Jesús comunicó a los suyos las verdades más profundas de su vida, de su existencia. Jesús se propone, se auto-revela, como el camino que lleva a Dios; se presenta igual a Dios que es Padre. El centro del mismo es la afirmación de Jesús como *“camino, verdad y vida”*.



La primera lectura de hoy, de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, cuenta del clima de tensión en la Iglesia primitiva de Jerusalén entre los hebreos (cristianos de origen judío originarios de Palestina) y los helenistas (cristianos de origen judío, originarios de comunidades judías esparcidas por todo el imperio romano y también fuera de él). Aparentemente, lo que provoca la cuestión en nuestro texto es un problema de orden material: la distribución de los alimentos a los miembros necesitados de la comunidad. La elección de siete responsables para los cristianos que se habían convertido, demuestra un cambio de rumbo, que sin duda marcará el futuro de los cristianos frente al judaísmo. La Iglesia es una comunidad santa, aunque formada por hombres pecadores, una comunidad de servidores que reciben los dones de Dios y que ponen esos dones al servicio de los hermanos.

EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 14, 1-12

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos seus discípulos: *“Não se perturbe o vosso coração. Se acreditais em Deus, acreditai também em mim. Em casa de meu Pai há muitas moradas; se assim não fosse, eu vos teria dito que vou preparar-vos um lugar? Quando eu for preparar-vos um lugar, virei novamente para vos levar comigo, para que, onde eu estou, estejais vós também. Para onde eu vou, conheceis o caminho”*. Disse-lhe Tomé: *“Senhor, não sabemos para onde vais: como podemos conhecer o caminho?”* Respondeu-lhe Jesus: *“Eu sou o caminho, a verdade e a vida. Ninguém vai ao Pai senão por mim. Se me conhecêsseis, conheceríeis também o meu Pai. Mas desde agora já o conheceis e já o vistes”*. Disse-lhe Filipe: *“Senhor, mostra-nos o Pai e isto nos basta”*. Respondeu-lhe Jesus: *“Há tanto tempo que estou convosco e não me conheces, Filipe? Que me vê, vê o Pai. Como podes tu dizer : Mostra-nos o Pai? Não acreditas que eu estou no Pai e o Pai está em mim? As palavras que eu vos digo, não as digo por mi próprio; mas é o Pai, permanecendo em mim, que faz as obras. Acreditai-me: Eu estou no Pai e o Pai está em mim; acreditai ao menos pelas minhas obras. Em verdade, em verdade vos digo: quem acredita em mim fará também as obras que eu faço e fará obras ainda maiores, porque eu vou para o Pai”*.

No Evangelho de hoje, ouvimos o início do chamado *“Discurso de despedida”* de Jesus. São as palavras que ele dirigiu aos discípulos no final da Última Ceia, pouco antes de enfrentar a Paixão. As palavras de Jesus soam a testamento final: Ele sabe que vai partir para o Pai e que os discípulos vão continuar no mundo. A aventura que eles começaram com Jesus, na Galileia, terá chegado ao fim? Os discípulos não sabem o que vai acontecer nem que caminho vão percorrer. Num momento tão dramático, Jesus começou por dizer: Não se perturbe o vosso coração. Ele diz-nos também a nós, nos dramas da vida. Cristo é o caminho para o Pai para todos os que creem nele.

A Instituição dos Diáconos

Atos 6:1-7



A primeira leitura deste domingo nos fala do desenvolvimento das primeiras comunidades cristãs. A caridade cria novas tarefas: Surgem os diáconos ou servidores da comunidade, ao lado dos apóstolos, que serão em primeiro lugar pregadores da Palavra e fundadores de comunidades; seus sucessores são os bispos. As comunidades estabelecidas recebem um grupo de anciãos ou presbíteros. Nesses serviços reconhecemos o que hoje se chama a ordem do sacerdócio ministerial (bispos, presbíteros e diáconos).
