VI DOMINGO DE PASCUA



EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 14, 15-21

En aquel tiempo, dijo Jesús a sus discípulos: “Si ustedes me aman, guardarán mis mandamientos, y yo rogaré al Padre y les dará otro Defensor* que permanecerá siempre con ustedes. Este es el Espíritu de Verdad, que el mundo no puede recibir porque no lo ve ni lo conoce. Pero ustedes lo conocen porque permanece con ustedes y estará con ustedes. No los dejaré huérfanos, sino que vengo a ustedes. Dentro de poco, el mundo no me verá más, pero ustedes me verán, por que yo vivo, y ustedes también vivirán. En este día ustedes comprenderán que yo estoy en mi Padre, y que ustedes están en mí, y yo en ustedes. El que conoce mis mandamientos y los guarda, ése es el que me ama a mí, y yo también lo amaré y me mostraré a él”.



Jesús continúa su discurso de despedida en la Última Cena, prometiendo enviar otro Defensor: se refiere al Espíritu Santo. El Espíritu Santo guía a los creyentes e inspira su oración para que sea escuchada. El Espíritu también nos hace comprender e interpretar para cada tiempo las palabras de Jesús. Jesús quiso decir que se daría a conocer mediante su Espíritu. Cuando Juan escribió su Evangelio en los años 90, ya la Iglesia había

experimentado la venida y la presencia del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. La lectura de hoy nos recuerda que el amor es el fundamento de la vida cristiana. Juan ve a Jesús como el primer Defensor, que al irse, enviará otro. Por eso los apóstoles, que lo vieron hombre entre los hombres en el tiempo de su humillación voluntaria, deben alegrarse de su partida. El Espíritu Santo procede del Padre que es la fuente única, pero el Hijo no nos lo da como si sólo transmitiera algo recibido: es su propio Espíritu. Este Defensor no “caminará entre nosotros”, sino que “habitará en nosotros”. Los primeros cristianos esperaban el pronto regreso de Jesús como Jesús lo había prometido.



La Primera Lectura de los Hechos 8, 5-8. 14-17 narra la expansión del Evangelio a Samaria mediante Felipe, rompiendo barreras culturales. Los samaritanos aceptan la palabra, y Pedro y Juan consolidan esta conversión imponiendo las manos para que reciban el Espíritu Santo, uniendo a la nueva comunidad con la iglesia de Jerusalén. Felipe no se limita a su zona de confort, llevando a Cristo a Samaria, un lugar históricamente rechazado por los judíos. Esto enseña que la Iglesia debe derribar prejuicios y llevar el mensaje a todos. La visita de Pedro y Juan, y la imposición de manos (confirmación), aseguran que la Iglesia samaritana no es una facción separada, sino parte del mismo cuerpo de Cristo unificado. La experiencia en Samaria subraya la necesidad de recibir el Espíritu Santo, que actúa como sello de la fe y empodera a los creyentes, consolidando su compromiso.

DOMINGO VI DA PÁSCOA



EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 14, 15-21

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos seus discípulos: «Se Me amardes, guardareis os meus mandamentos. E Eu pedirei ao Pai, que vos dará outro Defensor, para estar sempre convosco: o Espírito da verdade, que o mundo não pode receber, porque não O vê nem O conhece, mas que vós conheceis, porque habita convosco e está em vós. Não vos deixarei órfãos: voltarei para junto de vós. Daqui a pouco o mundo já não Me verá, mas vós ver- Me- eis, porque Eu vivo e vós vivereis. Nesse dia reconhecereis que Eu estou no Pai e que vós estais em Mim e Eu em vós. Se alguém aceita os meus mandamentos e os cumpre, esse realmente Me ama. E quem Me ama será amado por meu Pai e Eu amá-lo-ei e manifestar-Me-ei a ele».



Jesus garante aos discípulos que não os deixará sós no mundo. Ele vai para o Pai; mas vai encontrar forma de continuar presente e de acompanhar, a par e passo, a caminhada dos seus discípulos. É preciso, no entanto, que os discípulos continuem a seguir Jesus, a manifestar a sua adesão a Ele, a amá-lo. A consequência desse amor é o cumprir os mandamentos que Jesus deixou. Nesse caso, os mandamentos deixam de ser normas externas que é preciso cumprir, para se tornarem a expressão clara do amor dos discípulos e da sua sintonia com Jesus. Como é que Jesus vai estar presente ao lado dos discípulos, dando-lhes a coragem para percorrer “o caminho” do amor e do dom da vida?

Jesus fala no envio do “Paráclito”, que estará sempre com os discípulos. A palavra grega “paráklêtos”, utilizada por João, pertence ao vocabulário jurídico e designa, aquele que ajuda ou defende o acusado. Pode, portanto, traduzir-se como “advogado”, “auxiliar”, “defensor”. A partir daqui, pode deduzir-se, também, quer o sentido de “consolador”, quer o sentido de “intercessor”. No Novo Testamento, a palavra só aparece em João, onde é usada quer para designar o Espírito, quer o próprio Jesus (que no céu, cumpre uma missão de intercessão. O “Paráclito” que Jesus vai enviar é o Espírito Santo – apresentado aqui como o “Espírito da Verdade”. Enquanto esteve com os discípulos, Jesus ensinou-os, protegeu-os, defendeu-os; mas, a partir de agora, será o Espírito que ensinará e cuidará da comunidade de Jesus.



A primeira leitura deste domingo fala-nos de Filipe – um dos sete diáconos, do mesmo grupo do mártir Estêvão (cf. Act 6,1-7) – que, deixando Jerusalém foi anunciar o Evangelho aos habitantes da região central da Palestina, a Samaria. É curioso que a difusão do Evangelho fora de Jerusalém ocorra, precisamente, na Samaria. A Samaria era, para os judeus, uma terra praticamente pagã. Os judeus desprezavam os samaritanos por serem uma mistura de sangue israelita com estrangeiros e consideravam-nos hereges. O anúncio do Evangelho aos samaritanos mostra que a Igreja não tem fronteiras e anuncia o passo seguinte: a evangelização do mundo pagão.
