

The month of May is always a magnificent time to experience the rejuvenation of nature's beauty, with flowers and tress coming back to life after winter's chill. In our Catholic Church, we celebrate this season of devotion to Our Blessed Virgin Mother, always watching over all Her children with maternal love. Especially at Corpus Christi, our love for our Lady of Fatima on this 107<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Her apparition; for Her intersession in our lives, and most importantly for Mary to bless all the mothers and grandmothers of our faith community in Mineola.

The other inspirational celebration of May is the children of our parish receiving their First Holy Communion. What a holy sight to see our beautiful girls in white dresses, and our handsome boys in sleek suits!! The Eucharist is the source and summit of all that we are and all that we do as Catholics. That is why the Corpus Christi mosaic in the sanctuary will be symbolic of our national Eucharistic Revival; to deepen our love for the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament.

# Corpus Christi's 2024 "Continuing the Educational Mission" Scholarship Award

We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi "Continuing the Educational Mission" Scholarship award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for several months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the success from past years, we will continue to offer three scholarships this year:

- One for 2 student parishioners attending a Catholic High School
- One for a student parishioner attending, full time, a college or university.

Now three young people from our parish will each be awarded a scholarship toward their education. A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to two students who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2024 for the academic school year 2024/2025.

A scholarship award of \$7,000 will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a full- time course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending starting August/September 2024, a 2-4-year college or university for the academic school year 2024/2025.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester. The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and <u>not</u> from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer on or around August 3<sup>rd</sup>. The scholarship is for one year. Applications must be submitted to the rectory by June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024.



In the gospel we have just heard Our Lord's final instructions, His Last Will and Testament. Just before leaving His disciples, He reminds them of what He expects of them. Earlier He had sent them out to spread the Kingdom of God. Those who go in His name, do so with His authority. The authority goes with the mission, so to speak. In Matthew's version he now adds this great promise, "I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Jesus is very definite about what He has to say. Like any gathering of people, the feelings of his disciples were varied. But He sends them out to speak and act in His name. Their mission was both easy and hard: easy to understand but hard to carry out. It was to teach others all that He had taught them. Just as He asked them to follow His way, they were to ask that others should follow that way too.

The message of salvation must continue to be shared until the end of time. With all the changes in the church and in society, neither Jesus nor his messages have changed. His Gospel remains a call to live our lives to the full; To Love one another.

# Español VII DOMINGO DE PASCUA



### **EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 17. 11-19**

En aquel tempo, Jesús levantó los ojos al cielo y dijo: "Padre santo, cuida en tu hombre a los que me ha dado, para que sean uno, como nosotros. Cuando estaba con ellos, vo cuidaba e tu nombre a los que me diste; yo velaba por ellos y ninguno de ellos se perdió, excepto el que tenía que perderse, para que se cumpliera la Escritura. Pero ahora voy a ti, y mientras estoy aún en el mundo, digo estas cosas para que m gozo llegue a su plenitud en ellos. Yo les he entregado tu palabra y el mundo los odia, porque no son del mundo, como yo tampoco soy del mundo. No te pido que los saques del mundo, sino que lo libres del mal. Ellos no son del mundo, como tampoco yo soy del mundo. Santificalos en la verdad. Tu palabra es la verdad. Así como tú me enviaste al mundo, así los envío vo también al mundo. Yo me santifico a mí mismo por ellos, para que también ellos sean santificados en la verdad".



El Evangelio de Juan nos transmite la gran oración de despedida de Jesús por sus discípulos. En lugar sobresaliente Él pide al Padre: "Protégelos en tu Nombre, a los que tú me has dado, para que ellos sean uno como lo somos nosotros". Por eso Él ora en primer lugar por aquellos Doce, que Él eligió como Apóstoles. Después continúa: "Pero yo te pido no sólo por esto, sino también por todos los que creerán en mí por su palabra". Juan tenía ante la vista cuando redactó esta petición de unidad, a las comunidades muy distintas de la Iglesia naciente. Pensemos sólo en las dificultades de una convivencia de judeocristianos y paganos-cristianos. Por tanto era muy adecuado poner de relieve la petición de unidad, que correspondía sin duda a la voluntad del Señor de la Iglesia, entonces como hoy eran y son las desavenencias eclesiales un escándalo para la credibilidad del mensaje cristiano.



En la primera lectura, de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, está la elección de san Matías para ocupar el puesto dejado por Judas Iscariotes. Toda vocación específica a seguir a Cristo más de cerca es una elección por parte de Dios. La llamada del Señor es una muestra de predilección, manifestada en una invitación a dejarlo todo para seguirle. La iniciativa es de Dios: No me habéis elegido vosotros a mí, sino que yo os elegí a vosotros, y os he destinado para que vayáis y des fruto, y vuestro fruto permanezca.

<u>EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 17. 11b-19</u>

Naquele tempo, Jesus ergueu os olhos ao Céu e orou deste modo: "Pai santo, guarda-os em teu nome, o nome que me deste, para que sejam um, como nós. Quando eu estava com eles, guardava-os em teu nome, o nome que me deste. Guardei-os e nenhum deles se perdeu, a não ser o filho da perdição; e assim se cumpriu a Escritura. Mas agora vou para ti; e digo isto no mundo, para que eles tenham em si mesmos a plenitude da minha alegria. Dei-lhes tua palavra e o mundo odiou-os, por não serem do mundo, como eu não sou do mundo. Não peço que os tires do mundo, mas que os livres do mal. Eles não são do mundo, como eu não sou do mundo. Consagra-os na verdade. A tua palavra é a verdade. Assim como tu me enviaste ao mundo, também eu os enviei ao mundo. Eu consagrome por eles, para que também eles sejam consagrados na verdade".



No séptimo domingo depois da Páscoa, celebramos a Oração Sacerdotal de Jesus. Na conclusão da sua despedida dos seus discípulos, durante a última ceia, antes de ser preso, condenado e crucificado, Jesus ora ao Pai e expressa o seu cuidado pelos seus discípulos. Depois da ceia, Jesus e os seus discípulos dirigem-se para o Jardim das Oliveiras, onde ele será preso. Nessa oração,

Jesus declara a sua total união com o Pai. Enquanto Jesus estava com os seus discípulos, ele os protegia. Agora que ele está para morrer na cruz, Jesus pede pelos seus discípulos, para que estejam unidos como ele está unido ao Pai. Cristo é a fonte da nossa unidade. Jesus vai voltar para o Pai, mas os discípulos vão permanecer no mundo. Eles tem a missão de levar o evangelho de Jesus ao mundo todo. Mas o mundo muitas vezes não aceita a pregação dos apóstolos. E sabemos que os discípulos de Jesus foram perseguidos e deram a vida para testemunhar a mensagem de Jesus.



Na primeira leitura, dos Actos dos Apóstolos vemos a eleição de Matias para ocupar o lugar de Judas, o apóstolo que traiu Jesus e se enforcou. Os candidatos teriam que terem convivido com os apóstolos desde o baptismo até o momento que Jesus foi elevado ao Céu. A pessoa escolhida deveria ser testemunha da ressurreição de Jesus. Dois candidatos foram apresentados: José, chamado Barsabás e Matias. Depois de orarem, as cento e vinte pessoas reunidas deitaram sortes e Matias foi escolhido para ser apóstolo.

Amados, visto que Deus assim nos amou, nós também devemos amar uns aos outros.
