## Corpus Christi's 2023 "Continuing the Educational Mission" Scholarship Award

We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi "***Continuing the Educational Mission***" **Scholarship** award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for several months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the success from past years, we will continue to offer three scholarships this year:

- One for 2 student parishioners attending a Catholic High School
- One for a student parishioner attending, full time, a college or university.

Now three young people from our parish will each be awarded a scholarship toward their education. A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to two students who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2023 for the academic school year 2023/2024.

A scholarship award of \$7,000 will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a full-time course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending starting September 2023, a 2-4-year college or university for the academic school year 2023/2024.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester.

The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and **not** from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer on or around July 31. The scholarship is for one year. Applications must be submitted to the rectory by July 1, 2023.

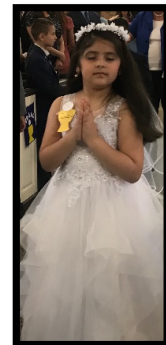
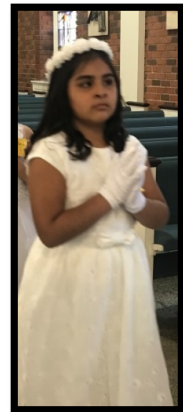

“The needs were overwhelming,” the Home Visit team recalled, “And they were beyond what we could provide. So we just prayed.” The emotions were high, the needs were great, there was nothing we could do, so...we just prayed.

It's easy to feel as though we've let down the neighbor sometimes. We are the ones who return their calls, who listen and understand and more often than not, are able to help with that overdue bill, or rent, so when we can't, or when the problem isn't really a matter of material assistance, it can seem as if we've fallen short.

Yet no matter the need, no matter the outcome of our Home Visit, we always pray. It isn't an afterthought, or something we fall back on only when things seem hopeless! Our prayers are the most important thing we have to offer.

Vincentians are people of “prayer and action.” Bl. Frédéric calls us to “do all the good we can and trust to God for the rest.” However great or little our efforts, our work is never complete without prayer. We never just pray. The final balance between our action and our prayer is up to God alone. As St. Vincent reminds us, “God does not consider the outcome of the good work undertaken, but the charity that accompanied it.” In our prayers, we place the needs of the neighbors before God in order to assure them that they are not forgotten, that this, too, shall pass. We add our voices to theirs, knowing that God has placed us in their presence for this reason, that He, too, is present on our Home Visit, and that the hope we offer is not merely the hope of a light bill payment.

## VI DOMINGO DE PASCUA



### EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 14, 15-21

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: *“Si me aman, cumplirán mis mandamientos; yo le rogaré al Padre y él les enviará otro Consolador que esté siempre con ustedes, el Espíritu de verdad. El mundo no puede recibirlo, porque no lo ve ni lo conoce; ustedes, en cambio, sí lo conocen, porque habita entre ustedes y estará en ustedes. No los dejaré desamparados, sino que volveré a ustedes. Dentro de poco el mundo no me verá más, pero ustedes sí me verán, porque yo permanezco vivo y ustedes también vivirán. En aquel día entenderán que yo estoy en mi Padre, ustedes en mí y yo en ustedes. El que acepta mis mandamientos y los cumple, ése me ama. Al que me ama a mí, lo amará mi Padre, yo también lo amaré y me manifestaré a él”*.

**SI ME AMÁIS, GUARDAD MIS MANDAMIENTOS.**



El evangelio de Juan prosigue con su discurso de revelación de la última cena. Se hace una conexión entre amor y mandamientos. Si amamos a Jesús estamos llamados a amarnos los unos a los otros. Para llevar adelante este mandamiento Jesús pedirá un defensor, un ayudador: el Espíritu. Jesús promete no dejarnos huérfanos: El Espíritu es más fuerte que el mundo, como el amor y la verdad son más fuerte que el mundo, aunque nos parezca lo contrario. Qué sentido tiene todo este discurso? Pues que aunque falte Jesús, no nos faltará el Espíritu. Es una presencia nueva de Jesús, una presencia que viene

después de la Resurrección y que no podemos dudar que existe y existirá. El Espíritu será quien nos enseñe a vivir el mandamiento del amor, quien venga en nuestra ayuda en los momentos difíciles, quien nos sostenga y levante. La actuación del Espíritu está en continuidad con la de Jesús. Cuando él ya no está físicamente presente entre nosotros, será el Espíritu quien haga que no se nos olviden las enseñanzas del Maestro, pues nos ayudará a recordarlas, a interpretarlas con más profundidad y a actualizar su sentido.



En la primera parte de la primera lectura, de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, tenemos un sumario que resume la actividad misionera de Felipe, uno de los siete diáconos, entre los samaritanos. Dice la lectura que los samaritanos se adherían unánimemente a las palabras de Felipe y fueron bautizados. En la segunda parte, Lucas relata la llegada a Samaría de los apóstoles Pedro y Juan que van a inspeccionar la actividad de Felipe. Estos imponen las manos sobre los que habían sido bautizados y ellos reciben el Espíritu Santo. Es curioso que la difusión del Evangelio fuera de Jerusalén se produzca precisamente en Samaria, que era, para los judíos, una tierra prácticamente pagana. El anuncio del Evangelio a los samaritanos muestra que la Iglesia no tiene fronteras y da lugar al paso siguiente: la evangelización del mundo pagano.



*Hermanos: Veneren en sus corazones a Cristo, el Señor, dispuesto siempre a dar, al que las pidiere, las razones de la esperanza de ustedes. Pero háganlo con sencillez y respeto. (1 Pedro 3, 15-18)*

### DOMINGO VIDA PÁSCOA



#### EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 14, 15-21

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos seus discípulos: *“Se me amardes, guardareis os meus mandamentos. E eu pedirei ao Pai que vos dará outro Paráclito, para estar sempre convosco. Ele é o Espírito da verdade, que o mundo não pode conhecer, porque não o vê nem o conhece, mas que vós conheceis, porque habita convosco e está em vós. Não vos deixarei órfãos: voltarei para junto de vós. Daqui a pouco o mundo já não me verá, mas vós ver-me-eis, porque eu vivo e vós vivereis. Nesse dia reconheceréis que eu estou no Pai e que vós estais em mim e eu em vós. Se alguém aceita os meus mandamentos e os cumpre, esse realmente me ama. E quem me ama será amado por meu Pai e eu amá-lo-ei e manifestar-me-ei a ele”.*

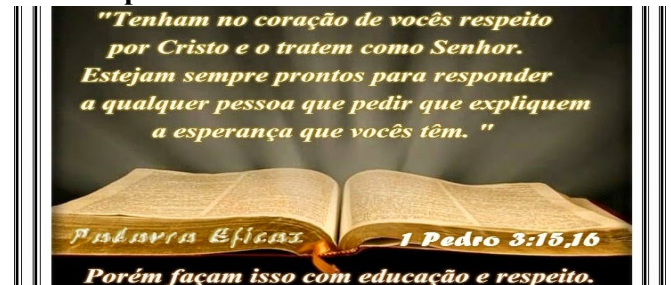


Na noite antes da sua morte na cruz, Jesus reuniu-se com os seus discípulos numa ceia. No decurso da ceia, Jesus despediu-se dos discípulos e fez-lhes as últimas recomendações. Ele sabe que vai partir para o Pai e que os discípulos vão continuar no mundo. Jesus garante aos discípulos que não os deixará sós no mundo. Ele vai para o Pai; mas vai encontrar forma de continuar presente e de acompanhar a caminhada dos seus discípulos. É preciso, no entanto, que os

discípulos continuem a manifestar a sua adesão a ele, a amá-lo. A consequência desse amor é o cumprir os mandamentos que Jesus deixou. Os mandamentos tornam-se a expressão clara do amor dos discípulos a Jesus. Jesus fala no envio do Paráclito, que estará sempre com os discípulos. A palavra grega “paráklêtos”, significa aquele que ajuda ou defende o acusado. Pode, portanto, traduzir-se como advogado, auxiliar, defensor. O Paráclito que Jesus vai enviar é o Espírito Santo, apresentado aqui como o Espírito da Verdade que ensinará e irá cuidar da comunidade de Jesus.



Durante os primeiros anos, o cristianismo praticamente não saiu de Jerusalém. Na primeira leitura deste domingo, dos Actos dos Apóstolos, vemos como Filipe, um dos sete diáconos, sai de Jerusalém e vai pregar o evangelho na Samaria, onde batizou novos cristãos. É muito significativa a abertura da Samaria ao evangelho, pois era uma região hostil ao judaísmo, quase pagã para os judeus. Os samaritanos, entram agora na comunidade cristã, o novo Povo de Deus. Vemos também como Pedro e João vão a Samaria para impor as mãos naqueles que tinham recebido o baptismo. E dessa forma esses samaritanos recebem o Espírito Santo. Pela primeira vez os dois sacramentos, baptismo e confirmação, são dados separadamente.
