One of the most treasured tenets of our Vincentian spirituality is trust in Providence. When our treasuries run low, or we are not sure of the path to take, we trust in Providence. But Providence is more than simply a generous donor our trust demands much more from us than simply expecting things to work out.

In our households we set aside money for “rainy days” because we have obligations – bills. But what about the Conference assistance we give to neighbors in need? These are not obligations, and there is no amount of saving up that will assure we can meet them. Our works, being entirely optional, should be from day to day; besides, nothing is more Christian than to trust one’s self to Providence and to count upon its inexhaustible care when the work is undertaken for God. To have before us a disposable capital which we never touch; are proceedings essentially contrary to the spirit of our Society.

Our tradition seems almost to defy common sense. Surely it is better to set aside money for those neighbors who will certainly call us next week than to give it all out today! Or, perhaps, giving all we have to meet today’s needs makes the most sense. The needs presented to us are as unique and unrepeatable as the images of God who presents them, and we can never know in advance the best way to help. This is why we are called to assess each home visit as a unique encounter and not set of predefined limitations on the amount or type of help to be given.

To trust in Providence means to abandon ourselves completely to the will of God, and it is from Providence that both donations and the needs of the neighbor are placed before us. Money can be saved in a bank, but it isn’t money we are trying to save.

**VII DOMINGO DE PASCUA****EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 17, 1-11**

En aquel tiempo , Jesús levanto los ojos al cielo y dijo: *“Padre, ha llegado la hora. Glorifica a tu Hijo, para que tu Hijo también te glorifique, y por el poder que le diste sobre toda la humanidad, dé la vida eterna a cuantos le has confiado. La vida eterna consiste en que te conozcan a ti, único Dios verdadero, y a Jesucristo, a quien tú has enviado. Yo te he glorificado sobre la tierra, llevando a cabo la obra que me encomendaste. Ahora, Padre, glorifícame en ti con la gloria que tenía , antes de que el mundo existiera. He manifestado tu nombre a los hombres que tú tomaste del mundo y me diste. Eran tuyos y tú me los diste. Ellos han cumplido tu palabra y ahora conocen que todo lo que me has dado viene de ti, porque yo les he comunicado las palabras que tú me diste; ellos las han recibido y ahora reconocen que yo salí de ti y creen que tú me has enviado. Te pido por ellos; no te pido por el mundo, sino por éstos, que tu me diste, porque son tuyos. Todo lo mío es tuyo y todo lo tuyo es mío. Yo he sido glorificado en ellos. Ya no estaré más en el mundo, pues voy a ti; pero ellos se quedan en el mundo”.*

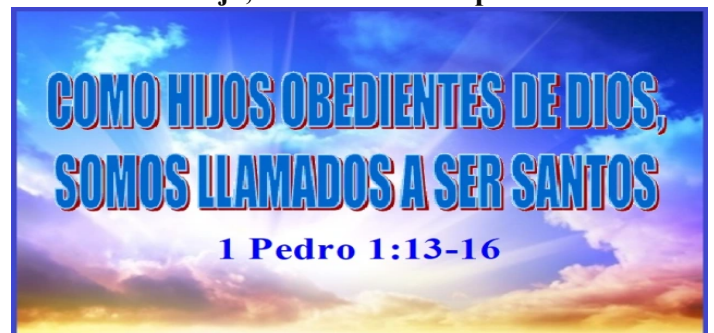


La misión de Jesús está a punto de realizarse. San Juan ve la pasión y la muerte de Jesús, como el momento en el cual él es más glorioso, porque su misión es revelar, en su forma humana, el amor infinito y la misericordia de Dios, en todas las circunstancias y para toda la humanidad. Este amor y misericordia es más evidente, cuando Jesús

responde con amor y misericordia, al ser traicionado, rechazado, burlado, flagelado y crucificado. El mensaje es que nada puede separarnos de su amor y misericordia. El texto del evangelio nos presenta la escena de Jesús y sus discípulos sentados a la mesa de la cena, en la que Jesús ofrece al Padre la oración sacerdotal pidiendo por los suyos y los invita a tomar conciencia de su misión y identidad. Jesús encomienda los cristianos al cuidado del Padre. Al acercarse su hora, no quiere desampararnos, y pide al Padre por aquellos que creerán el Evangelio a lo largo de toda la historia.



En la primera lectura contemplamos a la primera comunidad cristiana reunida en oración y a la espera del Espíritu que el Señor Jesús le había prometido. En esta convocatoria están presentes los apóstoles, con ellos otros discípulos y varias mujeres, ante todo María, la Madre de Jesús. Allí está ella, presente, en medio de la comunidad, en su condición de Madre de Jesús. Está con los discípulos, todos unidos en oración. Ella acompaña a los apóstoles y a los demás discípulos en la plegaria común, en la oración, en la anhelante espera, en la preparación y disposición a la obra de su Hijo, el envío de su Espíritu.



Desde el principio de su carta, Pedro ha hecho referencias al tema del sufrimiento y lo ha tratado en detalle. En particular, el sufrimiento que Pedro ha tratado es la persecución o el padecer injustamente.

**DOMINGO VII DA PÁSCOA****EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 17, 1-11a**

Naquele tempo, Jesus ergueu os olhos ao Céu e disse: *“Pai, chegou a hora. Glorifica o teu Filho, para que o teu Filho Te glorifique, e, pelo poder que lhe deste sobre toda a criatura, Ele dê vida eterna a todos os que Lhe confiastes. É esta a vida eterna; que Te conheçam a Ti, único Deus verdadeiro, e Aquele que enviaste, Jesus Cristo. Eu glorifiquei-Te sobre a terra, consumando a obra que Me encarregaste de realizar. E agora, Pai, glorifica-Me junto de Ti mesmo com a glória que tinha em Ti, antes que houvesse mundo. Manifestei o teu nome aos homens que no mundo Me deste. Eram teus e Tu mos deste e eles guardam a tua palavra. Agora sabem que tudo quanto Me deste vem de Ti, porque lhe comuniquei as palavras que Me confiaste e eles receberam-nas: reconheceram verdadeiramente que aí de Ti e acreditaram que Me enviaste. É por eles que Eu te rogo; não pelo mundo, mas por aqueles que Me deste, porque são teus. Tudo o que é meu é teu e tudo o que é teu é meu; e neles sou glorificado. Eu já não estou no mundo, mas eles estão no mundo, enquanto Eu vou para Ti”.*



Neste evangelho Jesus profere a *“Oração Sacerdotal”*, revelando a sua última vontade, o seu testamento. Jesus sabia que a sua hora tinha chegado. E assim sendo, não quer deixar seus discípulos dispersos e desunidos. Ele apresenta ao Pai a oração mais sublime da unidade na comunhão do amor. Nesta oração Jesus coloca em destaque primeiro a glória conjunta do Pai e d’Ele. E ao mesmo tempo faz-nos saber que a obediência na

realização da vontade de Deus seu Pai constitui a maior glória do Pai, na terra. Por isso, terminando a sua missão diz: Eu mostrei quem tu és para aqueles que tirastes do mundo e me deste. Eles eram teus, e tu os deste para mim. Eles tem obedecido à tua mensagem e agora sabem que tudo o que me tens dado vem de ti. No seu imenso amor, Jesus roga por aqueles que, graças à sua Palavra, crerão nele, para que todos sejam um, *“como tu, Pai, estás em mim e eu em ti”*.



A primeira leitura deste domingo narra o que sucedeu depois que Jesus subiu ao Céu, como os apóstolos voltaram para Jerusalém e ficaram reunidos e perseveraram em oração, em companhia de algumas mulheres, entre as quais Maria, Mãe de Jesus. Esse é um reflexo da vida das primeiras comunidades cristãs em Jerusalém: a união na oração.
