Dear Parishioner,

This month we celebrated Mother's Day and soon we will enjoy a long weekend in recognition of Memorial Day and all the brave men and women that gave up their lives for our country.

You have honored mothers and our veterans with your support of the Catholic Ministries Appeal with your gifts and prayers, and I thank you. Your support ensures that moms in our Long Island community need not put their children to bed hungry or a grandmother worry about having a safe and affordable place to live or receive a hot meal. It helps to give homeless veterans a place to call home or receive a nutritious meal at a soup kitchen.

As we battle COVID-19 Catholic Charities and Outreach teams are still providing face-to-face, round-the-clock care at our homes for the developmentally disabled, the mentally ill, teen moms and their babies and seniors in enriched housing. And their staff and volunteers deliver meals and groceries to hundreds of homebound seniors throughout Long Island. **We couldn't do this without you!**

Additionally, we would like to bring your attention to this year's CMA theme, Creating Pathways of Faith. Each year, the CMA creates pathways of faith for our parish and all the parishes across Long Island through the ministries supported by this appeal. They also include programs for youth and young adults, education and formation of our children, lay leaders, deacons and seminarians of our diocese. **More than 600,000 people are touched by the CMA each year.**

As a pastor within our Diocese, one of my responsibilities is to spread the word about the CMA and the good works it does. Along with the wide-ranging services the CMA helps to fund, the CMA also helps our parish as well. Once we raise 80% of our goal, we start to receive a rebate. Everything we raise between 80% and 100% of our goal comes right back to us, along with 80% of every dollar raised over the 100% mark. We could use all the support we can, especially given the situation we experienced last year. So, I humbly ask you to please consider making a gift to this year's CMA, if you have not already done so.

SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD



EVANGELIO SEGÚN SAN MATEO 28, 16-20

En aquel tiempo, los once discípulos se fueron a Galilea y subieron al monte en el que Jesús los había citado. Al ver a Jesús, se prostraron, aunque algunos titubeaban. Entonces Jesús se acercó a ellos y les dijo: Me ha sido dado todo poder en el cielo y en la tierra. Vayan, pues, y enseñen a todas las naciones, bautizándolas en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, y enseñándolas a cumplir todo cuanto yo les he mandado; y sepan que yo estaré con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo.



Por definición, la Santísima Trinidad está compuesta por três Perdonas divinas: el Padre, el Hijo (Jesús) y el Espíritu Santo (el Amor entre el Padre y el Hijo)...estas três Perssonas son distintas en sus Misiones (el Padre crea, el Hijo redime y el Espíritu Santo santifica), pero comparten una misma naturaleza divina: son Dios...esa comunión (común+unión) entre las três Personas divinas

forma una comunidade. Como dice San Juan, Dios es Amor, y ese amor se realiza en la comunicación mutua entre el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. La Santísima Trinidad es un misterio de amor, es Dio en lo más profundo de su intimidad.

Porque los hijos de Dios son todos aquellos que son guiados por el Espíritu de Dios.

Pues ustedes no han recibido un espíritu que los esclavice nuevamente al miedo, sino que han recibido el espíritu de adopción, por el cual clamamos: ¡Abba, Padre!

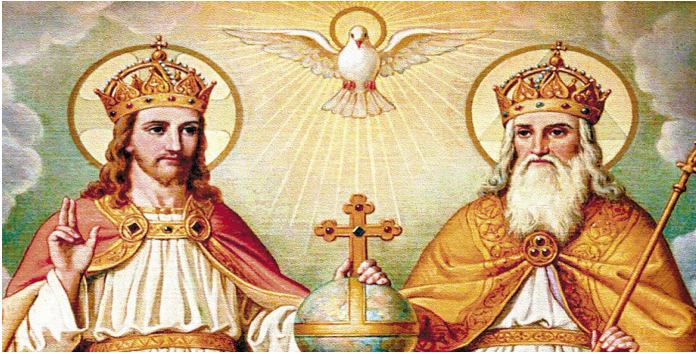
»Entonces recuerda lo siguiente y tenlo siempre presente:

SOLENIIDADE DA SANTÍSSIMA TRINDADE



EVANGELHO DE SÃO MATEUS 28, 16-20

Naquele tempo, os onze discípulos partiram para a Galileia, em direção ao monte que Jesus lhes indicara. Quando o viram, adoraram-no; mas alguns ainda duvidaram. Jesus aproximou-se e disse-lhes: *“Todo o poder me foi dado no céu e na terra. Ide e ensinai todas as nações, baptizando-as em nome do Pai e do Filho e do Espírito Santo, ensinando-as a cumprir tudo o que vos mandei. Eu estou sempre convosco até ao fim dos tempos”*.



No domingo depois de Pentecostes, celebramos a festa da Santíssima Trindade. Uma festa para contemplar e louvar o mistério de Deus em Três Pessoas: Pai, Filho e Espírito Santo. Deus é comunhão de amor. Jamais poderemos entender o mistério da Santíssima Trindade. Jesus revelou-nos esse mistério e no centro desse mistério está a verdade de que Deus é amor. Deus é a comunhão de três pessoas. Fomos baptizados em nome da Trindade Santíssima e todas as nossas orações sempre terminam com a invocação do Pai, Filho e

Espírito Santo. Essa festa faz-nos contemplar o mistério de Deus que incessantemente cria, redime e santifica, sempre com amor e por amor, e a cada criatura que o acolhe dá a possibilidade de refletir um raio da sua beleza, bondade e verdade. Jesus dá aos seus discípulos e a todos nós a missão de ensinar todas as nações e de baptizar em nome do Pai e do Filho e do Espírito Santo. E o Evangelho termina com a promessa de Jesus: *“Eu estou sempre convosco até o fim dos tempos”*.



Na Carta aos Romanos que lemos neste domingo, Paulo apresenta um resumo da sua mensagem e da sua pregação. Ele reflete sobre a vida nova que Deus oferece ao baptizado e que Paulo chama a vida no Espírito. Os que aceitam receber a vida de Deus e vivem no Espírito são filhos queridos de Deus.



Na primeira leitura deste domingo, Jahvéh revela-se como o Deus da relação, empenhado em estabelecer comunhão e familiaridade com o seu Povo. É um Deus que vem ao encontro dos homens, que lhes fala, que lhes indica caminhos seguros de liberdade e de vida, que está permanentemente atento aos problemas dos homens, que intervém no mundo para nos libertar.
