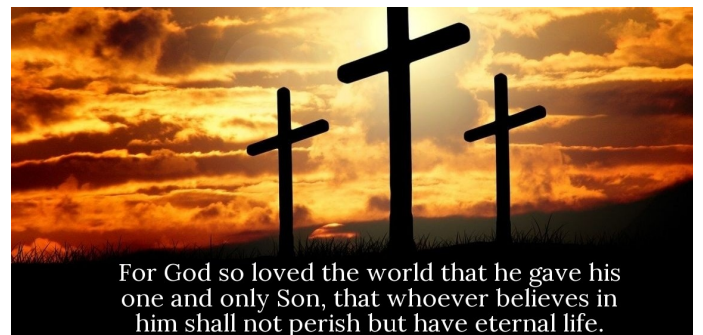

Saturday, 10 June at 5:00 PM



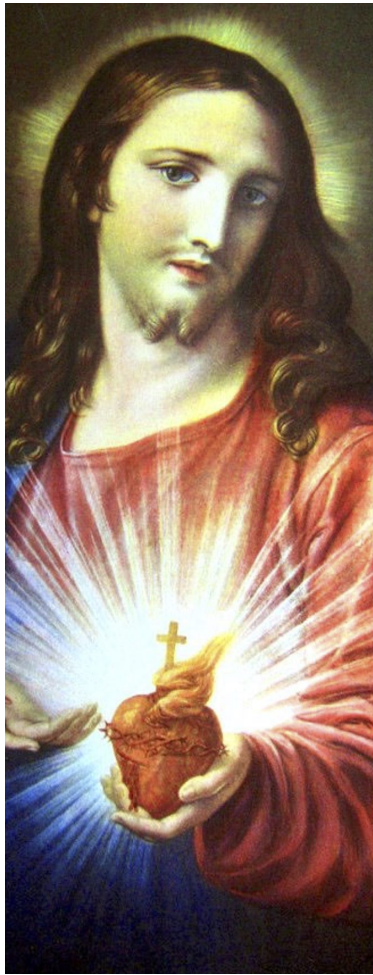

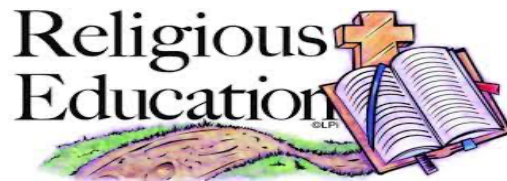

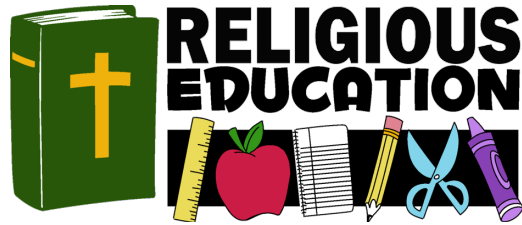

Every day, people in our community are helped because of support from funds raised through the Catholic Ministries Appeal.

Today, consider a dad like Paul. Paul saw information about the Catholic Ministries Appeal at his local parish, and he knew he had to turn to the Church for help since he had nowhere else to go. Paul had been gainfully employed for more than 10 years when he began to fall ill. Soon his medical issues made it impossible for him to keep working and he was forced to go out on disability.

After paying the co-pays on his medications, his family's rent and utilities bills, Paul had very little left to purchase food and other necessities for his family.

It was hard for him to ask for help, but with nowhere else to turn, he did. Catholic Charities found him a specialist who assessed the family's needs and directed them to appropriate resources in their community. He went to his Parish Outreach, where his family received food that allowed them to make it through the month. Paul and his family received the help they so desperately needed.

Today, Paul is back to work and the family is doing well. "I am so thankful that I know there is somewhere I can turn, where there are people that care, people I can talk to, if I am ever in such a situation again," shared Paul.

SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD



EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 3, 16-18

Tanto amó Dios al mundo, que le entregó a su Hijo único, para que todo el que crea en él no perezca, sino que tenga la vida eterna. Porque Dios no envió a su Hijo para condenar al mundo, sino para que el mundo se salvara por él. El que cree en él no será condenado; pero el que no cree ya está condenado, por no haber creído en el Hijo único de Dios.



La Iglesia Católica conmemora este domingo, uno de los días más grandes del año litúrgico. Celebramos la fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad, un misterio difícil de comprender. Imposible, si no es por la fe. Este misterio es uno de los más importantes de nuestra fe cristiana. Esta celebración es, en esencia, la fiesta de Dios Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. En el Evangelio, Juan nos invita a contemplar a un Dios cuyo amor por los hombres es tan grande, que llega hasta el punto de enviar al mundo a su Hijo único; es Jesús, el Hijo, que cumpliendo los planes del Padre, hace de su vida una donación total, hasta la muerte en cruz, a fin de ofrecernos a los hombres la vida definitiva. En esta fantástica historia de amor se plasma la grandeza del corazón de Dios. El Evangelio de hoy es parte de la conversación entre Jesús y Nicodemo. Después de explicar a Nicodemo que el mesías tiene que ser “elevado a lo alto”, como “Moisés elevó a la serpiente en el desierto” a fin de que todo aquel que

crea en él tenga vida definitiva. Jesús explica cómo la cruz se inserta en el proyecto de Dios. Porque amaba la humanidad, Dios envió su Hijo único al mundo con una propuesta de salvación. Esa oferta nunca fue retirada; continúa abierta y a la espera de respuesta. Ante la oferta de Dios, el hombre puede escoger la vida eterna o puede excluirse de la salvación.



En la primera lectura del Libro del Éxodo, Moisés hace una alabanza de Yahvé en un amanecer en el monte Sinaí, el monte de Dios, después de que el mismo Dios revelara quién era, cómo era, como sentía y cómo actuaba. Dios se revela como un Dios tierno, lento a la cólera y rico en piedad. Entonces cayó Moisés y pidió para él y para el pueblo lo que se había revelado en el mismo nombre de Dios. En esa lectura el Dios de la comunión y de la alianza, empeñado en establecer lazos familiares con el hombre, se presenta como clemente y compasivo. El Dios de misericordia y lento a la ira es el que todo creyente, el que todo ser humano, quiere encontrarse en su vida y con el que gusta entablar un diálogo.

"Resta, hermanos, que tengáis gozo, seáis perfectos, tengáis consolación, sintáis una misma cosa, tengáis paz; y el Dios de paz y de caridad sea con vosotros."

2 Corintios 13:11

Esta lectura es la conclusión de esta carta de Pablo a la comunidad de Corinto. Pablo expresa, a través de la fórmula litúrgica de la “gracia del Señor Jesucristo, el amor del Padre y la comunión del Espíritu Santo estén con vosotros”, la realidad de un Dios que es comunión, que es familia y que pretende atraer a los hombres hacia esa dinámica de amor.

SANTÍSSIMA TRINDADE



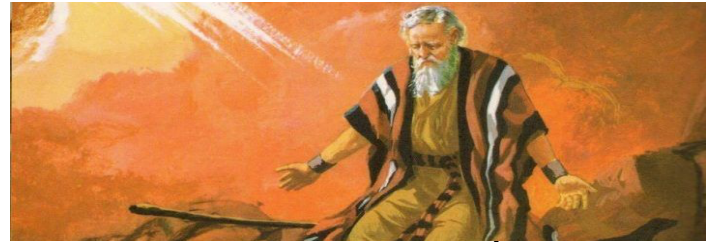
EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 3, 16-18

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus a Nicodemos: *“Deus amou tanto o mundo que entregou o seu Filho Unigénito, para que todo o homem que acredita nele tenha a vida eterna. Porque Deus não enviou o seu Filho ao mundo para condenar o mundo, mas para que o mundo seja salvo por ele. Quem acredita nele não é condenado, mas quem não acredita nele já está condenado, porque não acreditou no nome o Filho Unigénito de Deus”.*



O tempo pascal terminou em Pentecostes com o dom do Espírito Santo. Ao reiniciar o curso do tempo litúrgico que atravessa todo o ano, esta festa da Santíssima Trindade é uma celebração alegre e agradecida a Deus uno e trino pela obra da nossa salvação. A festa de hoje pede uma resposta à pergunta: Quem é Deus? O mistério de um Deus uno, na comunhão de três pessoas, nos faz compreender que a vida de Deus é essencialmente diálogo, comunicação. O texto do Evangelho de hoje pertence ao diálogo de Jesus com Nicodemos, e seu tema central é o novo renascimento pela água e pelo Espírito. Seu contexto é, portanto, um relato doutrinal ou uma catequese sobre o baptismo. Nessa leitura fala-se diretamente do Pai e do Filho, mas não do Espírito Santo. Neste evangelho de São João ele convida-nos a contemplar um Deus cujo amor pelos homens é tão grande, a ponto de enviar ao mundo o seu Filho único; e Jesus, o Filho, cumprindo o plano de Deus Pai, fez da sua vida um dom total, até a

morte da cruz, a fim de oferecer aos homens a vida definitiva.



Na primeira leitura do livro do Êxodo, Moisés, depois de ter obtido o perdão de Deus para o Povo, subiu sozinho à presença de Deus. Consigo, levava as duas novas tábuas de pedra que havia talhado e sobre as quais seriam gravados os mandamentos da aliança. Israel é convidado a descobrir e a comprometer-se com esse Deus que é sempre fiel aos seus compromissos e solidário com todos aqueles que d’Ele necessitam.

Quanto ao mais, irmãos, regozijai-vos, sede perfeitos, sede consolados, sede de um mesmo parecer, vivei em paz; e o Deus de amor e de paz será convosco.

2 Coríntios 13:11

A Primeira Carta aos Coríntios, que criticava alguns membros da comunidade por atitudes pouco condizentes com os valores cristãos, provocou uma reação estremada e uma campanha organizada no sentido de desacreditar Paulo. Este, informado de tudo, dirigiu-se apressadamente para Corinto e teve um violento confronto com os seus detractores. Depois, retirou-se para Éfeso. Tito, amigo de Paulo, fino negociador e hábil diplomata, partiu para Corinto, a fim de tentar a reconciliação. Paulo, reencontrou Tito, regressado de Corinto. As notícias trazidas por Tito eram animadoras: o problema fora ultrapassado e os coríntios estavam outra vez, em comunhão com Paulo. Reconfortado, Paulo escreveu uma tranquila apologia do seu apostolado. O mais notável desta carta é a fórmula de saudação: *“a graça de Senhor Jesus Cristo, o amor de Deus e a comunhão do Espírito Santo estejam convosco”.* Essa fórmula constitui uma impressionante confissão de fé no Deus trino.
