**“Continuing the Educational Mission” Scholarship Award**  
***Application Due Date extended to June 30, 2021***

We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi **“Continuing the Educational Mission” Scholarship** award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for a number of months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the success from last year, this year we are expanding the scholarship program with the inclusion of an award for a student parishioner attending a Catholic grammar or middle school. Now three young people from our parish, will each be awarded a scholarship toward their Catholic education. A scholarship award of \$4,000 will be given to a student who will be attending starting September 2021 at a local Catholic school in grades 6, 7 or 8 for the academic school year 2021/2022. A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to a student who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2021 for the academic school year 2021/2022 and a \$6,000 scholarship will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending full time starting September 2021, a 2-4 year college or university for the academic school year 2021/2022. The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester.

The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and **not** from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer. The scholarship is for one year.

## CORPUS CHRISTI



### EVANGELIO SEGÚN SAN MARCOS

#### 14, 12-16.22-26

El primer día de la fiesta de los panes Ázimos, cuando se sacrificaba el cordero pascual, le preguntaron a Jesús sus discípulos: “¿Dónde quieres que vayamos a prepararte la cena de Pascua?” Él les dijo a dos de ellos: “Vayan a la ciudad. Encontrarán a un hombre que lleva un cántaro de agua; síganlo y díganle al dueño de la casa en donde entre: El Maestro manda preguntar: ¿Dónde está la habitación en que voy a comer la Pascua con mis discípulos? Él les enseñará una sala en el segundo piso, arreglada con divanes. Prepárennos allí la cena.” Los discípulos se fueron, llegaron a la ciudad, encontraron lo que Jesús les había dicho y prepararon la cena de Pascua. Mientras cenaban, Jesús tomó un pan, pronunció la bendición, lo partió y se lo dio a sus discípulos, diciendo: “Tomen: esto es mi cuerpo”. Y tomando en sus manos la copa de vino, pronunció la acción de gracias, se la adió, todos bebieron y les dijo: “Esta es mi sangre, sangre de la alianza, que se derrama por todos. Yo les aseguro que no volveré a beber del fruto de la vid hasta el día en que beba el vino nuevo en el Reino de Dios”. Después de cantar el himno, salieron hacia el monte de los Olivos.



*Danos hoy nuestro pan de cada día*, pedimos en el Padre Nuestro. Sin embargo, este alimento diario, que pedimos y que Dios nos proporciona, no es sólo el pan material, sino también – muy especialmente – el Pan Espiritual, el Pan de Vida. Jesucristo murió, resucitó y subió a los cielos, y está sentado a la derecha de Dios Padre. Pero también permanece en la Hostia Consagrada, en todos los sagrarios del mundo. Y allí está vivo, en Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad.

Este es el gran misterio que conmemoramos en la Fiesta de Corpus Christi. El Jueves Santo Jesucristo instituyó el Sacramento de la Eucaristía. El evangelista Marcos nos ofrece el relato de la institución de la Eucaristía en aquel primer Jueves Santo celebrado por el Señor. Se queda Él mismo con todos los que a través de los tiempos lo hagan presente en cada Eucaristía.

### CORPUS CHRISTI



#### EVANGELHO DE S. MARCOS 14, 12-16.22-26

No primeiro dia dos Ázimos, em que se imolava o cordeiro pascal, os discípulos perguntaram a Jesus: *“Onde queres que façamos os preparativos para comer a Páscoa?”* Jesus enviou dois discípulos e disse-lhes: *“Ide à cidade. Virá ao vosso encontro um homem com uma bilha de água. Segui-o e, onde ele entrar, dizei ao dono da casa: O Mestre pergunta: Onde está a sala, em que hei-de comer a Páscoa com os meus discípulos? Ele vos mostrará uma grande sala no andar superior, alcatifada e pronta. Preparai-nos o que é preciso”*. Os dois discípulos partiram e foram à cidade. Encontraram tudo como Jesus lhes tinha dito e prepararam a Páscoa. Enquanto comiam, Jesus tomou o pão, recitou a bênção e partiu-o, deu-o aos discípulos e disse: *“Tomai: isto é o meu Corpo”*. Depois tomou um cálice, deu graças e entregou-lho. E todos beberam dele. Disse Jesus: *“Este é o meu Sangue, o Sangue da nova aliança, derramado pela multidão dos homens. Em verdade vos digo: Não voltarei a beber do fruto da videira, até ao dia em que beberei do vinho novo do reino de Deus”*. Cantaram os salmos e saíram para o monte das Oliveiras.



Na solenidade do Santíssimo Corpo e Sangue de Nosso Senhor Jesus Cristo celebramos o grande tesouro da Igreja, que é o Sacramento da Eucaristia. A Eucaristia celebrada é o Sacramento

que torna presente para nós o mistério da paixão, morte e ressurreição de Jesus. Por isso também é o que se diz que a Eucaristia é o memorial da Páscoa de Cristo, que envolve e torna participantes dos frutos da Páscoa a todos aqueles que participam da celebração da Eucaristia com fé e devoção. A Eucaristia é o Sacramento de nossa íntima comunhão com Deus por meio de Jesus Cristo e da união fraterna entre nós. Na celebração da Eucaristia, nós nos unimos a Cristo sumo e eterno sacerdote, que se oferece sem cessar ao Pai pela nossa salvação. Com Jesus, a Igreja oferece a Deus Pai a grande adoração e louvor, apresenta súplicas por si e pela humanidade, pede perdão pelos pecados e agradece as graças recebidas.



O sacrifício significa e realiza a aliança entre Deus e o homem. Na Antiga Aliança eram os animais que eram sacrificados para o perdão dos pecados. Na Nova Aliança, é o sangue derramado por Cristo que perdoa os nossos pecados e nos alcança a salvação.
