
Our Parish Outreach Food Pantry Needs Your Help

“Continuing the Educational Mission” Scholarship Award

We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi “*Continuing the Educational Mission*” *Scholarship* award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for several months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the successes from past years, we will continue to offer two scholarships this year:

- One for a student parishioner attending a Catholic High School
- One for a student parishioner attending, full time, a college or university.

Now two young people from our parish will each be awarded a scholarship toward their education.

A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to a student who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2025 for the academic school year 2025/2026.

A scholarship award of \$7,000 will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a full-time course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending starting September 2025, a 2-4-year college or university for the academic school year 2025/2025.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester.

The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and **not** from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer on or around August 9th. The scholarship is for one year. Applications must be submitted to the rectory by July 9, 2025.



DOMINGO DE PENTECOSTÉS



EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 20, 19-23

Al anochecer del día de la resurrección, estando cerradas las puertas de la casa donde se hallaban los discípulos, por miedo a los judíos, se presentó Jesús en medio de ellos y les dijo: La paz esté con ustedes. Dicho esto, les mostró las manos y el costado. Cuando los discípulos vieron al Señor, se llenaron de alegría. De nuevo les dijo Jesús: La paz esté con ustedes. Como el Padre me ha enviado, así también los envío yo. Después de decir esto, sopló sobre ellos y les dijo: Reciban el Espíritu Santo. A los que les perdonen los pecados les quedarán perdonados; a los que no se los perdonen, les quedarán sin perdonar.



En este evangelio Juan cuenta la primera aparición de Jesús resucitado a sus discípulos, quienes estaban reunidos en un lugar cerrado por miedo. Jesús les trae paz, les muestra sus marcas, les da el Espíritu Santo y les encarga perdonar a los hombres y retener pecados, dando inicio a la misión de la Iglesia. El evangelio de hoy nos viene a decir que desde el mismo día en que Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos su comunicación con los discípulos se realizó por medio del Espíritu. Los discípulos estaban

reunidos con las puertas cerradas por miedo a los judíos. Este miedo refleja su desánimo y desesperación tras la muerte y crucifixión de Jesús. Jesús se manifiesta repentinamente en medio de ellos, demostrando su resurrección y presencia viva. El saludo de paz es un mensaje de consuelo y esperanza para los discípulos asustados y afligidos. Jesús les proporciona una evidencia física de su identidad y su victoria sobre la muerte. El Espíritu Santo es el don que Jesús entrega para fortalecerlos en su misión y capacitarlos para anunciar el mensaje de salvación. Al mismo tiempo Él establece la autoridad de la Iglesia para perdonar y retener pecados.



Pentecostés era una fiesta judía, en realidad la Fiesta de las Semanas. El nombre de Pentecostés se traduce por quincuagésimo. La fiesta se describe en Éxodo 23,16 como la fiesta de la cosecha. Son siete semanas completas desde la pascua, cuarenta y nueve días, el quincuagésimo día es la fiesta. Es verdad que no existe unanimidad entre los investigadores sobre el sentido propio de la fiesta. Las antiguas versiones litúrgicas y los comentarios de los rabinos señalaban estos aspectos teológicos en el sentido de poner de manifiesto la acogida del don de la Ley en el Sinaí, como condición de vida para la comunidad renovada y santa. Después del año 70 Después de Cristo, prevaleció en la liturgia el cómputo farisaico que fijaba la celebración de Pentecostés 50 días después de la Pascua. No es una Ley nueva lo que se recibe en el día de Pentecostés, sino el don del Espíritu de Dios o del Espíritu del Señor. El nuevo Israel y la nueva humanidad serán conducidos, no por una Ley que ya ha mostrado todas sus limitaciones en el viejo Israel, sino por el mismo Espíritu de Dios. Es el Espíritu el único que hace posible que todos los hombres, no sólo los israelitas, entren a formar parte del nuevo pueblo. Desde ahora Dios conducirá a su pueblo, un pueblo nuevo, la Iglesia, por medio del Espíritu.

DOMINGO DE PENTECOSTES



EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 20, 19-23

Na tarde daquele dia, o primeiro da semana, estando fechadas as portas da casa onde os discípulos se encontravam, com medo dos judeus, veio Jesus, apresentou-se no meio deles e disse-lhes: *“A paz esteja convosco”*. Dito isto, mostrou-lhes as mãos e o lado. Os discípulos ficaram cheios de alegria ao verem o Senhor. Jesus disse-lhes de novo: *“A paz esteja convosco. Assim como o Pai me enviou, também eu vos envio a vós. Disto isto, soprou sobre eles e disse-lhes: Recebei o Espírito Santo: àqueles a quem perdoardes os pecados ser-lhe-ão perdoados; e àqueles a quem os retiverdes ser-lhe-ão retidos”*.



Para os primeiros cristãos, o primeiro dia da semana é um dia importante porque é o dia do Senhor, é aquele em que a comunidade costuma reunir-se para partir o pão eucarístico (Actos 20, 7; I Coríntios 16, 2). A indicação temporal com que começa o trecho do evangelho (na tarde) é preciosa: indica talvez a hora tardia a que os cristãos costumavam encontrar-se para a sua celebração. Depois de ter saudado os discípulos pela segunda vez: *A paz esteja convosco*, Jesus dá-lhes o seu Espírito e confere-lhes o poder de perdoarem os pecados. No dia de Páscoa realizam-se as promessas de Jesus. Com um gesto simbólico – Jesus soprou sobre eles – é dado o Espírito. Este sopro nos lembra o momento da criação, quando o Senhor Deus formou o homem do pó da terra. Insuflou-lhes pelas narinas o sopro da vida (Gênesis 2, 7). O sopro de Jesus cria o

homem novo, o homem que já não é vítima das forças que o levam ao mal, mas é animado por uma energia nova que o leva ao bem. Onde chega este espírito, o mal está vencido, o pecado perdoado – cancelado, destruído – e nasce o homem novo modelado pela pessoa de Cristo. A missão que o Ressuscitado confia aos seus discípulos é a de perdoar os pecados, continuando assim a sua obra de Cordeiro de Deus, que tira o pecado do mundo (João 1, 29)



A primeira leitura é dos Actos dos Apóstolos. Jesus prometeu aos seus discípulos que não os deixaria sós e que iria enviar o Espírito. Lendo o trecho dos Actos ficamos admirados perante os numerosos prodígios acontecidos no dia de Pentecostes: rajada de vento, línguas de fogo, os apóstolos que falam todos os idiomas. Lucas coloca a descida do Espírito no dia de Pentecostes. E no entanto, precisamente no Evangelho de hoje, João conta que Jesus comunicou o Espírito no próprio dia da ressurreição. O mistério pascal é único. Morte, Ressurreição, Ascensão e dom do Espírito aconteceram no mesmo instante, no momento da morte de Jesus. Lucas apresenta o mistério pascal como se tivesse acontecido em três momentos sucessivos. Fê-lo para ajudar a compreender os seus múltiplos aspectos. João pôs a efusão do Espírito no dia de Páscoa para mostrar que o Espírito é dom de Jesus ressuscitado. O Pentecostes era uma festa hebraica muito antiga, celebrada cinquenta dias depois da Páscoa dos judeus, e que comemorava chegada do povo de Israel ao monte Sinai. Dizendo que o Espírito tinha descido sobre os discípulos precisamente no dia de Pentecostes, Lucas quer ensinar que o Espírito substituiu a antiga Lei e tornou-se a nova Lei para o cristão. Os rabinos diziam que no Sinai, no dia de Pentecostes, quando Deus tinha dado a Lei, as suas palavras tinham tomado a forma de setenta línguas de fogo, para indicar que a Torah (a Lei) estava destinada a todos os povos, que naquele tempo se pensava que fossem precisamente setenta. E as muitas línguas faladas pelos apóstolos? Provavelmente Lucas evoca um fenómeno muito comum na Igreja primitiva: depois de ter recebido o Espírito, os crentes começavam a louvar a Deus num estado de exaltação e, como que em êxtase, pronunciavam palavras estranhas noutras línguas.
