

Pentecost Sunday








Sunday, 15 June 2025

“Continuing the Educational Mission” Scholarship Award

We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi “*Continuing the Educational Mission*” *Scholarship* award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for several months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the successes from past years, we will continue to offer two scholarships this year:

- One for a student parishioner attending a Catholic High School
- One for a student parishioner attending, full time, a college or university.

Now two young people from our parish will each be awarded a scholarship toward their education.

A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to a student who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2025 for the academic school year 2025/2026.

A scholarship award of \$7,000 will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a full-time course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending starting September 2025, a 2-4-year college or university for the academic school year 2025/2025.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester.

The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and **not** from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer on or around August 9th. The scholarship is for one year. Applications must be submitted to the rectory by July 9, 2025.

Every day, people in our community are helped because of support from funds raised through the Catholic Ministries Appeal.

Today, consider a dad like Paul. Paul saw information about the Catholic Ministries Appeal at his local parish, and he knew he had to turn to the Church for help since he had nowhere else to go. Paul had been gainfully employed for more than 10 years when he began to fall ill. Soon his medical issues made it impossible for him to keep working and he was forced to go out on disability.

After paying the co-pays on his medications, his family's rent and utilities bills, Paul had very little left to purchase food and other necessities for his family.

It was hard for him to ask for help, but with nowhere else to turn, he did. Catholic Charities found him a specialist who assessed the family's needs and directed them to appropriate resources in their community. He went to his Parish Outreach, where his family received food that allowed them to make it through the month. Paul and his family received the help they so desperately needed.

Today, Paul is back to work and the family is doing well. *"I am so thankful that I know there is somewhere I can turn, where there are people that care, people I can talk to, if I am ever in such a situation again,"* shared Paul.



SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD



EVANGELIO DE SAN JUAN 16,12-15

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: *“Aún tengo muchas cosas que decirles, pero todavía no las pueden comprender. Pero cuando venga el Espíritu de verdad, él los irá guiando hasta la verdad plena, porque no hablará por su cuenta, sino que dirá lo que haya oído y les anunciará las cosas que van a suceder. Él me glorificará, porque primero recibirá de mí lo que les vaya comunicando. Todo lo que tiene el Padre es mío. Por eso he dicho que tomará de lo mío y lo comunicará a ustedes”*.



Misterio insondable y de riqueza inagotable el que encierra y se manifiesta en el Dios de los cristianos. Comenzamos por creer en un solo Dios, pero no solitario, sino amor puro que busca darse de forma creadora y llevarnos a participar en su unidad vital eterna. Al lo largo de la historia de la Revelación Dios ha manifestado su poder y su fuerza creadora antes de darnos a conocer su nombre (Yahvé), su identidad y soberanía frente a otros dioses, que pululaban en

los diversos panteones de otras culturas. La idea dominante de Dios en el Antiguo Testamento destaca su función de Señor y Creador; a Él debe su existencia el pueblo elegido y puede contar con Él en todas las vicisitudes cualesquiera que sea su índole. La verdadera paternidad de Dios se revela cuando el Verbo eterno del Padre manifiesta en la Encarnación su condición de Hijo de Dios. Esa es la gran noticia y el gran regalo que trae Jesús a la historia de la humanidad: el Dios Creador y Salvador de Israel es el Dios Padre, que ahora está más cercano a nosotros los hombres porque Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, se ha hecho hombre sin dejar nunca la prerrogativa de la filiación divina. Así nos ha hecho a todos capaces de participar de la dignidad de los hijos de Dios. Toda esta acción es obra del espíritu, la fuerza y vigor de Dios, que actúa en la persona del Espíritu Santo. Esta acción del Espíritu Santo es la propia vida divina que se hace presente en nosotros y nos permite llamar a Dios Padre y sentirnos hermanos del propio Jesús, el Hijo de Dios Encarnado. Un solo Dios, pero no solitario, que manifiesta su riqueza insondable al darse sin límites como Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.



Dios es sabiduría creadora, ya que sin ella, no podemos ni admirar a Dios, ni admirarnos de nosotros mismos. Ese texto de la sabiduría personificada antes de la creación del mundo se ha visto como una especie de puente en el Antiguo Testamento de la gran revelación de Jesucristo como palabra creadora y eterna, y como sabiduría de Dios. Esa primera lectura del Libro de la Sabiduría es un poema de amor divino en lo humano. Dios se complace en estar con nosotros. La sabiduría se complace en derramarse y en que todos los hombres la posean. En ese sentido, la sabiduría se ha acercado a los hombres en Jesucristo. Toda la creación es la manifestación de esta sabiduría.

SANTÍSSIMA TRINDADE



EVANGELHO DE SÃO JOÃO 16,12-15

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos seus discípulos: *“Tenho ainda muitas coisas para vos dizer, mas não as podeis compreender agora. Quando vier o Espírito da verdade, Ele vos guiará para a verdade plena; porque não falará de Si mesmo, mas dirá tudo o que tiver ouvido e vos anunciará o que está para vir. Ele me glorificará, porque receberá do que é meu e vo-lo anunciará. Tudo o que o Pai tem é meu. Por isso vos disse que Ele receberá do que é meu e vo-lo anunciará”*.



A festa de hoje nos revela o aspecto específico da nossa fé: nós acreditamos em Deus Trindade. Deus é um só. Acreditamos que ele é o Pai que criou o universo e que governa com sabedoria e amor; acreditamos que ele não permaneceu no céu, mas, na sua Imagem o Filho, ele veio para este mundo e se fez um de nós; cremos que ele realiza o seu projeto de amor com a sua força, o Espírito. É a quinta vez que neste evangelho de João, Jesus promete enviar o Espírito e afirma que ao mesmo está confiada a missão de levar a bom termo o projeto do Pai. Sem a sua participação ativa os homens não teriam condições de receber a salvação. Por que? No-lo revela Jesus no Evangelho de hoje. O Mestre começa dizendo: muitas coisas ainda tenho a dizer-vos, mas não as podeis suportar agora. Ele afirma que o

Espírito não acrescentará nada àquilo que ele ensinou, não revelará nada de novo em relação ao que ele ensinou, não revelará nada de novo em relação ao Evangelho; sua missão se limitará a iluminar os discípulos para que eles entendam de maneira correta aquilo que o Mestre lhes ensinou. O espírito completará a obra do Pai e do Filho.



A primeira leitura deste domingo, do Livro dos Provérbios, nos fala, através de imagens, do Pai e da sua obra criadora. Ensina-nos que, antes de qualquer outra coisa, Deus criou a Sabedoria, uma criatura tão sublime que o Senhor a colocou logo ao seu lado, como uma filha inteligente e amável, e quis que ela acompanhasse e contemplasse todas as suas obras. Na sua presença, ele criou o universo, colocou no seu lugar os abismos e as nascentes das quais brotam as águas; fixou os fundamentos das montanhas, criou a terra e o campos, firmou as nuvens no alto e estabeleceu um limite às águas dos mares. Ter fé em Deus Pai significa acreditar que ele fez tudo com sabedoria e amor.



Na Segunda leitura de Paulo aos Romanos, ele explica que, depois de sermos justificados pela fé, temos paz com Deus e acesso à graça através de Jesus Cristo, e nos gloriamos na esperança da Glória de Deus. A tribulação que enfrentamos produz paciência, e a paciência gera experiência, que por sua vez, leva à esperança.
