




We are in need of the following items:

“Continuing the Educational Mission” Scholarship Award

We are pleased to announce again this year the Corpus Christi **“Continuing the Educational Mission” Scholarship** award. Even though our beloved parish school has closed, the mission of educating the young people of our parish continues. It is in this spirit that the scholarship award has been established.

A committee of educators from grammar school, middle school, high school and college as well as members from the financial community was formed and worked on this program for several months and developed this scholarship.

Based upon the successes from past years, we will continue to offer two scholarships this year:

- One for a student parishioner attending a Catholic High School
- One for a student parishioner attending, full time, a college or university.

Now two young people from our parish will each be awarded a scholarship toward their education.

A scholarship award of \$5,000 will be given to a student who will be attending a local Catholic High School starting September 2025 for the academic school year 2025/2026.

A scholarship award of \$7,000 will be given to a matriculated college student carrying a full-time course load of a minimum 12 credits/semester who will be attending starting September 2025, a 2-4-year college or university for the academic school year 2025/2025.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school, college or university in two equal payments, one half for the fall semester and the second half for the spring semester or if the academic year is divided into trimesters, half will be paid in the first trimester and the second half paid in the third trimester.

The funding for these scholarships will come directly from the investment income earned from the proceeds of the sale of the Searing Avenue properties and **not** from any weekly or special parish collections. The announcement of the scholarship recipients will be made later this summer on or around August 9th. The scholarship is for one year. Applications must be submitted to the rectory by July 9, 2025.





SANTOS PEDRO Y PABLO



EVANGELIO DE SÃO MATEO 16, 13-19

En aquel tiempo, cuando llegó a la región de Cesarea de Filipo, hizo esta pregunta a sus discípulos: “¿Quién dice la gente que es el Hijo del hombre?” Ellos le respondieron: “Unos dicen que eres Juan el Bautista; otros, que Elías; otros, que Jeremías o alguno de los profetas”. Luego les preguntó: “Y ustedes, ¿quién dicen que soy yo?” Simón Pedro tomó la palabra y le dijo: “Tú eres el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios vivo”. Jesús le dijo entonces: “Dichoso tú, Simón, hijo de Juan, porque esto no te lo ha revelado ningún hombre, sino mi Padre, que está en los cielos! Y yo te digo a ti que tú eres Pedro y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia. Los poderes del infierno no prevalecerán sobre ella. Yo te daré las llaves del Reino de los cielos; todo lo que ates en la tierra quedará atado en el cielo, y todo lo que desates en la tierra quedará desatado en el cielo”.



En el Evangelio de hoy Jesús plantea dos preguntas a sus discípulos. La primera: “La gente, ¿quién dice que es el Hijo del hombre?” es una pregunta que demuestra en qué medida el corazón y la mirada de Jesús están abiertos a todos. A Jesús le interesa lo que piensa la gente no para complacerla, sino para poder entrar en comunicación en ella. Sin saber lo que la

gente piensa, el discípulo se aísla y empieza a juzgar a la gente según sus pensamientos y convicciones. Mantener un sano contacto con la realidad, con lo que la gente vive, con sus lágrimas y sus alegrías, es la única forma de poder ayudarle, de poder formarla y comunicar con ella. Es el único modo de hablar al corazón de las personas tocando su experiencia cotidiana: el trabajo, la familia, los problemas de salud, el tráfico, la escuela, los servicios sanitarios, etc... Es el único modo de abrir su corazón a la escucha de Dios. En realidad, cuando Dios quiso hablar con nosotros se encarnó. Los discípulos de Jesús nunca deben olvidar de dónde fueron elegidos, es decir de entre la gente, y nunca deben caer en la tentación de asumir actitudes distantes, como si lo que la gente piensa y vive no les afectase y no fuese importante para ellos. (Homilía de papa Francisco, 10 de noviembre de 2015).



Hechos 12, 1-11 narra la persecución de la iglesia primitiva por el rey Herodes Agripa I, quien encarceló y mató a Jacobo y luego encarceló a Pedro. Sin embargo, Pedro fue liberado milagrosamente por un ángel, mientras que la iglesia oraba fervientemente por él.



Esta es una frase bíblica que se encuentra en II Timoteo 4:7 y significa que Pablo ha perseverado en la fe cristiana, ha cumplido con la misión encomendada y ha mantenido la fidelidad a Dios a pesar de las dificultades. Es una reflexión sobre la lucha espiritual y la victoria obtenida a través de la fe y la obediencia a Dios.

SÃO PEDRO E SÃO PAULO



EVANGELHO DE SÃO MATEUS 16, 13-19

Naquele tempo, Jesus ao chegar à região de Cesareia de Filipe, Jesus fez a seguinte pergunta aos seus discípulos: «Quem dizem os homens que é o Filho do Homem?» Eles responderam: «Uns dizem que é João Baptista; outros, que é Elias; e outros, que é Jeremias ou algum dos profetas.» Perguntou-lhes de novo: «E vós, quem dizeis que Eu sou? Tomando a palavra, Simão Pedro respondeu: «Tu és o Messias, o Filho de Deus vivo. Jesus disse-lhe em resposta: «És feliz, Simão, filho de Jonas, porque não foi a carne nem o sangue que to revelou, mas o meu Pai que está no Céu. Também Eu te digo: Tu és Pedro, e sobre esta Pedra edificarei a minha Igreja, e as portas do Abismo nada poderão contra ela. Dar-te-ei as chaves do Reino do Céu; tudo o que ligares na terra ficará ligado no Céu e tudo o que desligares na terra será desligado no Céu.



Desde o século III que a Liturgia une na mesma celebração as duas colunas da Igreja, Pedro e Paulo. Mestres inseparáveis de fé e de inspiração cristã pela sua autoridade, simbolizam todo o Colégio Apostólico. O texto evangélico consta de duas partes: a resposta de Pedro acerca da messianidade de Jesus, Filho de Deus e a promessa do primado que Jesus confere a Pedro. O povo reconhecia Jesus como um

profeta. Mas os Doze têm uma opinião muito própria, que é expressa por Pedro: Jesus é o Messias, o Filho de Deus. Essa opinião, mais do que baseada na experiência que tinham de Jesus, era fruto da ação do Espírito Santo. Por causa dessa confissão, Pedro será a rocha sobre a qual Cristo edificará a sua Igreja. A Pedro e aos seus sucessores é confiada a missão de serem o fundamento visível da realidade invisível que é Cristo Ressuscitado. O poder de ligar e desligar, expresso na metáfora das chaves, indica a autoridade sobre a Igreja.



Pelos anos 41-44 da nossa era, reinava na Judeia Herodes Agripa, que moveu uma perseguição contra a Igreja. Foi por essa ocasião que Pedro foi preso, durante a páscoa judia, e teria a mesma sorte de Jesus, se Deus não tivesse intervindo com um milagre: um anjo libertou Pedro da morte certa.



Este texto apresenta-nos o que podemos chamar testamento de Paulo. O Apóstolo presente sua morte.
