

The children need only the following supplies:



XVII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 11, 1-13


Un día, Jesús estaba orando y cuando terminó, uno de sus discípulos le dijo: "Señor, enséñanos a orar, como Juan enseñó a sus discípulos". Entonces Jesús les dijo: "Cuando oren, digan: 'Padre, santificado sea tu nombre, venga tu Reino, danos hoy nuestro pan de cada día y perdona nuestras ofensas, puesto que también nosotros perdonamos a todo aquel que nos ofende, y no nos dejes caer en tentación'". También les dijo: "Supongan que alguno de ustedes tiene un amigo que viene a medianoche a decirle: 'Préstame, por favor, tres panes, pues un amigo mío ha venido de viaje y no tengo nada que ofrecerle'. Pero él le responde desde dentro: 'No me molestes. No puedo levantarme a dártelos, porque la puerta ya está cerrada y mis hijos y yo estamos acostados'. Si el otro sigue tocando, yo les aseguro que, aunque no se levante a dárselos por ser su amigo, sin embargo, por su molesta insistencia, sí se levantará y le dará cuanto necesite. Así también les digo a ustedes: Pidán y se les dará, busquen y encontrarán, toquen y se les abrirá. Porque quien pide, recibe; quien busca, encuentra, y al que toca, se le abre. ¿Habrá entre ustedes algún padre que, cuando su hijo le pida pan, le dé una piedra? ¿O cuando le pida pescado le dé una víbora? ¿O cuando le pida huevo, le dé un alacrán? Pues, si ustedes, que son malos, saben dar cosas buenas a sus hijos, ¿cuánto más el Padre celestial dará el Espíritu Santo a quienes se lo pidan?"



En el Evangelio del día de hoy, vemos como uno de los discípulos pide a Jesús que les enseñe a orar. Desde ahora ya podemos sentirnos identificados con él, porque cuántas veces no sabemos rezarle a Dios y solo pensamos en pedir y pedir, pero realmente no debe ser así... Orar es más bien pasar tiempo con el Amado, con aquel que nos ha dado todo lo que tenemos. Cristo nos revela la intimidad con su Padre, esa intimidad que nos lleva a darnos totalmente, aunque no nos guste a veces, humanamente, como lo ha hecho Cristo en la cruz. Saber que estamos presentes en la oración de Dios mismo es algo que debe resonar en nuestro corazón. Él, conociendo que no sabemos rezar ha querido enseñarnos esta misma oración. Cuando rezamos el padrenuestro, nos dirigimos al mismo Padre que nos ha creado y nos ha revelado su gran amor entregándonos a su Hijo único.



La primera lectura de este domingo del libro del Génesis 18:20-32 se centra en la conversación entre Dios y Abrahán sobre la destrucción de Sodoma y Gomorra. Abrahán intercede por los justos en la ciudad, negociando con Dios para salvarla si encuentra un cierto número de personas justas. La reflexión se centra en la justicia y misericordia de Dios. La primera lectura de este domingo viene para poner de manifiesto la intercesión de Abrahán a Dios por los justos, por Lot, su sobrino y sus familiares. Es una explicación de cómo el hombre de todos los tiempos, y muy especialmente el de la antigüedad recurre a lo divino frente a las leyes de la naturaleza que se presenta tan atroz en momentos determinados.



La segunda lectura es de la carta de san Pablo a los colosenses.

DOMINGO XVII DO TEMPO COMUM



EVANGELHO DE SÃO LUCAS 11, 1-13

Naquele tempo, estava Jesus em oração em certo lugar. Ao terminar, disse-Lhe um dos discípulos: «*Senhor, ensina-nos a orar, como João Baptista ensinou também os seus discípulos*». Disse-lhes Jesus: «*Quando orardes, dizei: ‘Pai, santificado seja o vosso nome; venha o vosso reino; dai-nos em cada dia o pão da nossa subsistência; perdoai-nos os nossos pecados, porque também nós perdoamos a todo aquele que nos ofende; e não nos deixeis cair em tentação’*». Disse-lhes ainda: «*Se algum de vós tiver um amigo, poderá ter de ir a sua casa à meia-noite, para lhe dizer: ‘Amigo, empresta-me três pães, porque chegou de viagem um dos meus amigos e não tenho nada para lhe dar’. Ele poderá responder lá de dentro: ‘Não me incomodes; a porta está fechada, eu e os meus filhos estamos deitados e não posso levantar-me para te dar os pães’. Eu vos digo: Se ele não se levantar por ser amigo, ao menos, por causa da sua insistência levantar-se-á para lhe dar tudo aquilo de que precisa. Também vos digo: Pedi e dar-se-vos-á; procurai e encontrareis; batei à porta e abrir-se-vos-á. Porque quem pede recebe; quem procura encontra e a quem bate à porta, abrir-se-á. Se um de vós for pai e um filho lhe pedir peixe, em vez de peixe dar-lhe-á uma serpente? E se lhe pedir um ovo, dar-lhe-á um escorpião? Se vós, que sois maus, sabeis dar coisas boas aos vossos filhos, quanto mais o Pai do Céu dará o Espírito Santo àqueles que Lho pedem!*».

A Bíblia nos exorta a rezar sempre, a agradecer a Deus em todas as circunstâncias da vida. Mas, o que é a oração? O que significa orar? Quando orar? Como e por que orar? A primeira leitura e o Evangelho respondem a estas perguntas. Todos os que acreditam em Deus rezam, pertençam esses a que religião for. Rezam por quem está doente, pela família, pelos amigos. Pedem que Deus mande a chuva, que abençoe as colheitas, que afaste as infelicidades. O Pai-nosso não é uma fórmula de oração superior às outras; é uma síntese de toda a mensagem cristã. Neste Evangelho Jesus conta aos discípulos a sua experiência de Deus e mostra-lhes como devem falar com Deus. Convida-os a verem Deus como um pai bom e cheio de amor, sempre disponível a escutar os seus filhos. Cada momento de oração é uma experiência de intimidade, de familiaridade e de comunhão com Deus.



Certo dia, diz a bíblia, Deus revelou a Abraão que queria ir até a cidade de Sodoma para verificar se era verdade o que se dizia sobre a maldade dos seus habitantes. Abraão, que tinha um sobrinho naquela cidade, fica preocupado e começa a interceder para que a cidade seja poupada, por causa dos justos que moram nela. Na primeira leitura, do Livro do Génesis, o patriarca Abraão dirige-se ao Deus que veio visita-lo e dialoga com Ele. Abraão expõe a Deus as suas inquietações, as suas dúvidas, as suas questões, num diálogo respeitoso, sincero, confiante. Deus responde de forma franca às perguntas de Abraão. Essa “conversa” pode ser modelo da nossa oração, do nosso diálogo com Deus.
