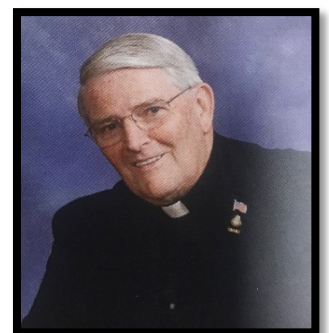

...“While He was still speaking a bright cloud cast a shadow over the disciples, then from the a cloud came a voice that said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."

“Prayer is one of the privileged ways of listening. But it must always be validated by life. One who listens to ‘what God is telling me’ in prayer, but pays little heed to what others are saying in daily life is surely suspect. Prayer must be in continual contact with people and events, since God speaks not only in the silence of our hearts, but also (and often first of all) in the people around us. It is only when what is heard is pondered, that its full meaning is revealed. Listening includes seeing, hearing, sensing, feeling, and perceiving. Indeed, attentiveness is one of the most important signs of respect for others. It is indispensable foundation of Vincentian spirituality.

Parish meetings can be a time of grace or a time when sin threatens grace. Meetings are a time of grace only through a communal quest to listen to God and communal attentiveness to the words of others. When there is listening there is a climate of freedom for discussion and discernment. When there is no listening, meetings create strife and division. They disrupt rather than unify. When listening wanes, meetings degenerate rapidly. Among the signs that sin is at work in meetings is fighting, strife, bad feelings disillusionment and bitterness.

TRANSFIGURACIÓN DEL SEÑOR



EVANGELIO DE SAN MATEO 17, 1-9

En aquel tiempo, Jesús tomó a Pedro, a Santiago y a Juan, el hermano de éste, y los hizo subir a solas con él a un monte elevado. Ahí se transfiguró en su presencia: su rostro se puso resplandeciente como el sol y sus vestiduras se volvieron blancas como la nieve. De pronto aparecieron ante ellos Moisés y Elías, conversando con Jesús. Entonces Pedro le dijo a Jesús: *“Señor, qué bueno sería quedarnos aquí! Si quieres, haremos aquí tres chozas, una para ti, otra para Moisés y otra para Elías”*. Cuando aún estaba hablando, una nube luminosa los cubrió y de ella salió una voz que decía: *“Este es mi Hijo muy amado, en quien tengo puestas mis complacencias; escúchenlo”*. Al oír esto, los discípulos cayeron rostro en tierra, llenos de un gran temor. Jesús se acercó a ellos, los tocó y les dijo: *“Levántense y no teman”*. Alzando entonces los ojos, ya no vieron a nadie más que Jesús. Mientras bajaban del monte, Jesús les ordenó: *“No le cuenten a nadie lo que han visto, hasta que el Hijo del hombre haya resucitado de entre los muertos”*.



¿Qué nos enseña
LA TRANSFIGURACIÓN
DEL SEÑOR?

Antes de iniciar su pasión, a la que ya había aludido Jesús otras veces, vuelve ahora a hablar sobre ella. Ante lo que iba a suponer para sus discípulos quiere afianzar su fe en Él; con ello pretende desterrar el desánimo, dejando clara su victoria final, es decir, su resurrección. San Mateo nos ofrece esta manifestación sobre quién es aquel Jesús que convive con sus apóstoles. Para ellos el Maestro escoge a tres de sus discípulos para que sean testigos de la experiencia que les va a regalar y puedan dar fe de lo que han visto y oído, tras acompañarlo a la cima del monte. Sus palabras: *“No contéis a nadie la visión hasta que el Hijo del hombre resucite de entre los muertos”*, están en la línea de quien es Él. Y, sin embargo, en el momento de la prueba, en el Monte de los Olivos, sucumbieron. Se olvidaron de Dios, y no vieron ya más que al hombre. Si, la fe consiste en aceptar a Cristo: pobre, humillado, humano. Dios no impone la fe por la fuerza de lo prodigioso. Él prefiere ganar las voluntades suavemente, respetando la libertad. *Éste es mi Hijo, el amado... Escúchenlo*. Efectivamente, éste es el Jesús en quien nosotros creemos, a quien escuchamos y recibimos en cada Eucaristía y a quien intentamos seguir en nuestra vida. No, no queremos quedarnos en la cima de la montaña, como quería Pedro, sino que estamos decididos a bajar al valle a trabajar y a anunciar el Reino.



Las lecturas de hoy nos presentan el poder, la gloria y el reinado de Jesús. El profeta Daniel contempla el poder del Hijo del hombre, cuya gloria se manifestará en Cristo Jesús en cima del monte. Pedro nos recuerda esa experiencia en su segunda carta. El autor del libro de Daniel nos presenta una visión esplendorosa del reino mesiánico, para dar aliento a los creyentes que están siendo perseguidos, asegurándoles que el bien va a triunfar sobre el mal, cuando llegue el Mesías prometido.

TRANSFIGURAÇÃO DO SENHOR



EVANGELHO DE SAN MATEUS 17, 1-9

Naquele tempo, Jesus tomou consigo Pedro, Tiago e João seu irmão e levou-os, em particular, a um alto monte e transfigurou-se diante deles: o seu rosto ficou resplandecente como o sol e as suas vestes tornaram-se brancas como a luz. E apareceram Moisés e Elias a falar com Ele. Pedro disse a Jesus: *“Senhor, como é bom estarmos aqui! Se quiseres, farei aqui três tendas: uma para Ti, outra para Moisés e outra para Elias”*. Ainda ele falava, quando uma nuvem luminosa os cobriu com a sua sombra e da nuvem uma voz dizia: *“Este é o meu Filho muito amado, no qual pus toda a minha complacência. Escutai-o”*. Ao ouvirem estas palavras, os discípulos caíram de rosto por terra e assustaram-se muito. Então Jesus aproximou-se e, tocando-os, disse: *“Levantai-vos e não temais”*. Erguendo os olhos, eles não viram mais ninguém, senão Jesus. Ao descender do monte, Jesus deu-lhes esta ordem: *“Não conteis a ninguém esta visão, até o Filho do homem ressuscitar dos mortos”*.



O relato da transfiguração de Jesus é antecedido pelo anúncio da paixão e de uma instrução sobre as atitudes próprias do discípulo convidado a renunciar a si mesmo, a tomar a sua cruz e a seguir Jesus. O episódio da transfiguração constitui uma palavra de ânimo para os discípulos, pois nela manifesta-se a glória de Jesus e atesta-se que ele é – apesar da cruz que se aproxima – o Filho amado de Deus. A

Transfiguração do Senhor oferece-nos uma mensagem de esperança – convida-nos a encontrar Jesus. Aqui está todo o sentido da festa de hoje: celebrar este instante de Luz pelo qual Jesus se faz conhecer, contemplar a visão do Senhor transfigurado, escutar a sua mensagem, descer do monte e espalhar a Luz à nossa volta.



A primeira leitura deste domingo, da profecia de Daniel fala da revelação em termos de *“visão”*: cena grandiosa do Filho do homem servido por todos os povos. A expressão Filho do homem, que aparece nesta leitura é expressão que Jesus há-de aplicar frequentemente a si mesmo. A visão do profeta Daniel acontece quando o povo sofre perseguição e a deportação. Nesta situação que parece desesperada para a fé, Deus anuncia o seu grande projeto de enviar, não um anjo ou qualquer outro mensageiro celeste, mas o Filho do homem. Essa profecia é uma preparação para o Evangelho da Transfiguração do Senhor.

De fato, não seguimos fábulas engenhosamente inventadas, quando falamos a vocês a respeito do poder e da vinda de nosso Senhor Jesus Cristo; ao contrário, nós fomos testemunhas oculares da sua majestade.

2 Pedro
1:16

Na segunda leitura deste domingo, Pedro dá testemunho da glória resplandecente de Deus vinda sobre Jesus. Pedro esteve no alto da montanha e viu Jesus transfigurar-se diante dele e dos outros dois apóstolos. Diante da transfiguração do Senhor, Pedro quer ficar no alto da montanha, mas é preciso voltar à vida normal.
