

*Español***XIX DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO
ORDINARIO****EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 12, 35-40**

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: "Estén listos, con la túnica puesta y las lámparas encendidas. Sean semejantes a los criados que están esperando a que su señor regrese de la boda, para abrirle en cuanto llegue y toque. Dichosos aquellos a quienes su señor, al llegar, encuentre en vela. Yo les aseguro que se recogerá la túnica, los hará sentar a la mesa y él mismo les servirá. Y si llega a medianoche o a la madrugada y los encuentra en vela, dichosos ellos. Fíjense en esto: Si un padre de familia supiera a qué hora va a venir el ladrón, estaría vigilando y no dejaría que se le metiera por un boquete en su casa. Pues también ustedes estén preparados, porque a la hora en que menos lo piensen vendrá el Hijo del hombre".




El evangelio de Lucas habla sobre la importancia de estar preparados para la venida del Hijo del Hombre, utilizando la metáfora de los siervos que esperan a su señor. Se enfatiza la necesidad de estar vigilantes y listos, con las lámparas encendidas, para recibirlo con alegría cuando regrese. La reflexión sobre Lucas 12:35-40 se centra en la importancia de la preparación y la vigilancia, ya que Jesús vendrá en un momento inesperado. Los versículos destacan la necesidad de estar listos y alerta, comparando a los creyentes con sirvientes esperando el regreso de su amo de una fiesta

de bodas. La parábola enfatiza que la recompensa espera a aquellos que estén preparados y velando, mientras que la falta de preparación puede llevar a consecuencias negativas.




El Libro de la Sabiduría 18:6-9 describe la noche en que Dios liberó a los israelitas de Egipto, destacando la luz que brillaba para ellos mientras que la oscuridad envolvía a los egipcios. Se enfatiza la certeza de la liberación y la preparación para la Pascua, así como la protección divina sobre el pueblo elegido.



Hoy, la segunda lectura, tomada de Hebreos 11, llena de contenido esta parte de la celebración, con su visión práctica de la fe evocada a la luz de grandes figuras de la historia de la salvación y de todos aquellos que por amor de lo que esperaban y de las realidades invisibles, renunciaron a los honores terrenos. Se dice que con este capítulo, el autor de la carta a los Hebreos, que no es San Pablo desde luego, sino un maestro desconocido, compuso este sermón para mover a la fe a la comunidad, al igual que los padres del pueblo, pero ahora con la esperanza que procura Jesús y su obra. Él es el ejemplo de nuestra fe en Dios y de nuestra entrega a los hombres al comprender todas las flaquezas. Por esto es Sumo Sacerdote, porque siendo Hijo de Dios, superior a los ángeles, a Moisés y a Aarón, comprendió más que nadie los pecados de los hombres.

DOMINGO XIX DO TEMPO COMUM



EVANGELHO DE SÃO LUCAS 12, 35-40

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos seus discípulos: *“Tende os rins cingidos e as lâmpadas acesas. Sede como homens que esperam o seu senhor ao voltar do casamento, para lhe abrirem logo a porta, quando chegar a bater. Felizes esses servos, que o senhor encontrar vigilantes. Em verdade vos digo: cingir-se-á e mandará que se sentem à mesa e, passando diante deles, os servirá. Se vier à meia-noite ou de madrugada, felizes serão se assim os encontrar. Compreendi isto: se o dono da casa soubesse a que hora viria o ladrão, não o deixaria arrombar a sua casa. Estai vós também preparados, porque na hora em que não pensais virá o Filho do homem”.*


mergulhado no pecado e cego à glória de Jesus. A nossa esperança na vinda de Cristo, portanto, deve estar bem firmada em duas outras virtudes: a fé e a caridade cristãs. No evangelho, Jesus diz que é preciso esperar, mas que não se sabe até quando. A espera, nesse sentido, seria necessária; mas o tempo e espera seria indeterminado. Certa a vinda, mas incerto o momento.



Israel é um povo que gosta de lembrar. Lembra-se sobretudo os prodígios do Êxodo. A primeira leitura do Livro da Sabedoria 18, 6-9 descreve a praga dos primogênitos no Egito e a ação divina que trouxe salvação para o povo de Israel, ao mesmo tempo em que puniu os egípcios. Na noite em que abandonaram a terra do faraó, os justos foram salvos e os inimigos exterminados. Eis porque decidiram reunir-se, todos os anos, para celebrar, na noite da Páscoa, estes acontecimentos gloriosos.



No Evangelho Jesus nos fala da virtude da *vigilância*, ou seja, daquela disposição constante e firme para permanecermos acordados à espera de Nosso Senhor, que há de voltar a esta terra e deseja encontrar nossos corações preparados para a sua gloriosa vinda. Como de costume, Cristo recorre a uma comparação bastante expressiva e clara, sobretudo para os judeus da época. Devemos ser, diz-nos o Senhor, como servos cujos rins estejam cingidos, isto é, temos de estar prontos para amar efetivamente a Deus; por outro lado, temos de manter acesas as lâmpadas da fé, sob cuja luz nos guiamos na escuridão de um mundo



A Segunda leitura nos fala de Abraão e de Sara, modelos de fé em Deus. Eles ficaram atentos à voz de Deus, sempre responderam prontamente, acreditaram na sua salvação, não obstante as aparências contrária.
