Corpus Christi needs new Altar Servers!!

These are some of the requirements to serve as an Altar Server:

**You have to be a registered member of Corpus Christi.
The boys and girls have to have completed 4th grade.
They have to have the Sacrament of First Holy Communion.**

Altar Servers form a very important part of our Parish and we are enriched through their dedication and service. They assist the priest and deacon of the parish during the celebration of the Mass. As visible members of our Parish ministry team, Altar Servers have a responsibility to serve as an example to others of one's commitment to their faith. Serving prayerfully with reverence, respect and attentiveness to the assigned tasks during the Mass is very important.

Some of the tasks Altar Servers perform include carrying the Cross during the entrance and recessional processions; presenting the bread, wine and water to the priest and assist him in receiving the gifts; as well as many other tasks throughout the Mass. These are very important tasks and therefore, the Altar Servers have to undergo extensive training with the help of the more experienced Altar Servers both during training as well as when they first altar serve in a Mass. Servers should be mature enough to understand their responsibilities and to carry them out well and with appropriate reverence.

XXI DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 13, 22-30

En aquel tiempo Jesús atravesaba ciudades y pueblos enseñando, mientras caminaba hacia Jerusalén. Uno le dijo: «Señor, ¿son pocos los que se salvan?» Él les dijo: «Luchad por entrar por la puerta estrecha, porque, os digo, muchos pretenderán entrar y no podrán. «Cuando el dueño de la casa se levante y cierre la puerta, os pondréis los que estáis fuera a llamar a la puerta, diciendo: "¡Señor, ábrenos!" Y os responderá: "No sé de dónde sois." Entonces empezareis a decir: "Hemos comido y bebido contigo, y has enseñado en nuestras plazas"; y os volverá a decir: "No sé de dónde sois. ¡Retiraos de mí, todos los agentes de injusticia!" «Allí será el llanto y el rechinar de dientes, cuando veáis a Abraham, Isaac y Jacob y a todos los profetas en el Reino de Dios, mientras a vosotros os echan fuera. Y vendrán de oriente y occidente, del norte y del sur, y se pondrán a la mesa en el Reino de Dios. Y hay últimos que serán primeros, y hay primeros que serán últimos.



Jesús está viajando hacia Jerusalén, enseñando en pueblos y aldeas. Alguien le pregunta si son pocos los que se salvan. El pasaje del Evangelio según San Lucas 13:22-30 habla sobre la importancia de esforzarse para entrar por la puerta estrecha del Reino de Dios, ya que muchos intentarán entrar y no podrán. Jesús enseña que la salvación no es automática por pertenecer a un grupo o por haber tenido cercanía con Él, sino que

requiere una decisión personal y un compromiso con sus enseñanzas.

Llegará un momento en que la puerta se cerrará y será demasiado tarde para arrepentirse y entrar. El lamento de los rechazados: Los que se queden afuera llorarán y crujirán los dientes al ver a los patriarcas y profetas en el Reino de Dios, mientras ellos son excluidos. Todos son bienvenidos, pero no todos entrarán: Personas de todas partes del mundo serán invitadas al banquete del Reino, pero solo aquellos que hayan vivido conforme a la voluntad de Dios serán admitidos. Los últimos serán los primeros y los primeros los últimos: La salvación no depende de la posición social o religiosa, sino de la fidelidad a Dios. En resumen: El pasaje enfatiza la urgencia de tomar la decisión de seguir a Jesús y vivir según sus enseñanzas, ya que la puerta del Reino de Dios es estrecha y no todos los que deseen entrar serán admitidos.




La primera lectura es del profeta Isaías 66, 18-21. Es un oráculo que se dirige a los que han retornado del exilio de Babilonia; es una llamada de esperanza universal. El fracaso del pueblo, con toda su identidad, debería haberles enseñado a abrirse a todos los pueblos, razas y lenguas, para que el proyecto universal de salvación de Yahvé, el Dios de Israel, se cumpliera. Es esto lo que se anuncia en esta lectura; es una llamada a la misión, que no van a escuchar los dirigentes y responsables. Se cerrarán en su religión y frustrarán muchas esperanzas. Jesús, quien volverá a recuperar para su pueblo y para el mundo lo que significa este oráculo.



En la Segunda lectura, de Hebreos es una amplia exhortación a vivir la fe en medio de las dificultades que deben suportar.

DOMINGO XXI DO TEMPO COMUM




EVANGELHO DE SÃO LUCAS 13, 22-30

Naquele tempo, Jesus dirigia-Se para Jerusalém e ensinava nas cidades e aldeias por onde passava. Alguém Lhe perguntou: «Senhor, são poucos os que se salvam?» Ele respondeu: «Esforçai-vos por entrar pela porta estreita, porque Eu vos digo que muitos tentarão entrar sem o conseguir. Uma vez que o dono da casa se levante e feche a porta, vós ficareis fora e batereis à porta, dizendo: ‘Abre-nos, senhor’; mas ele responder-vos-á: ‘Não sei donde sois’. Então começareis a dizer: “Comemos e bebemos contigo e tu ensinaste nas nossas praças”. Mas ele responderá: ‘Repito que não sei donde sois. Afastai-vos de mim, todos os que praticais a iniquidade’. Aí haverá choro e ranger de dentes, quando virdes no reino de Deus Abraão, Isaac e Jacob e todos os Profetas, e vós a serdes postos fora. Hão de vir do Oriente e do Ocidente, do Norte e do Sul, e sentar-se-ão à mesa do reino de Deus. Há últimos que serão dos primeiros e primeiros que serão dos últimos».¹



“Jesus dirigia-se para Jerusalém e ensinava as cidades e aldeias por onde passava”. Jesus vai a Jerusalém para enfrentar as autoridades religiosas judaicas e lhes apresentar o projeto de salvação que Deus lhe confiou. O trecho do Evangelho de Lucas 13:22-30 começa com uma pergunta de um anônimo: “Senhor, são poucos os que se salvam”? O trecho do evangelho fala sobre a porta estreita e a importância de entrar por ela para alcançar a salvação. Jesus, ao passar por cidades e povoados, ensinando no caminho para Jerusalém, é questionado sobre quantos se salvarão. Ele responde

incentivando as pessoas a se esforçarem para entrar pela porta estreita, pois muitos tentarão, mas não conseguirão. A parábola da porta fechada ilustra que aqueles que não se esforçarem e não forem reconhecidos pelo Senhor como seus, ficarão de fora, com choro e ranger de dentes, enquanto outros, vindo de todas as partes, serão recebidos no Reino de Deus, invertendo a ordem dos primeiros e últimos. Lucas relata este episódio porque sabe que nas suas comunidades há discórdias. Sabe que, não obstante as exortações do Mestre, os anciãos, os dirigentes dos diversos ministérios, se deixam levar pela ambição de ocupar os primeiros lugares.



Os israelitas estavam convencidos de serem os únicos homens bons, justos, fiéis a Deus, e tinham estabelecido leis muito severas para impedir os encontros, as amizades, os casamentos com membros de outros povos que não conheciam o Senhor e adoravam os ídolos. Os acontecimentos da história, porém, encarregaram-se de demolir, passo a passo, esses preconceitos. Durante o exílio na Babilônia, os israelitas têm a oportunidade de conhecer pessoalmente. O Livro de Isaías, capítulo 66, versículos 18 a 21, descreve a reunião de todas as nações e línguas por Deus, que virão ver Sua glória e terão alguns de seus membros enviados como mensageiros para anunciar sua glória entre as nações. Estes mensageiros trarão os remanescentes de volta a Jerusalém, e alguns serão escolhidos para serem sacerdotes e levitas.

1ª Leitura

Carta aos Hebreus 12,4-7.11-15

O Senhor corrige a quem ele ama.



Na Segunda leitura, um mestre cristão exorta os crentes a verem os sofrimentos e as contrariedades que tiverem de suportar, não como castigos, mas como sinais do amor de Deus.
