**- LUKE 14:13-14**

One of the main principles of living a Stewardship lifestyle is to give without expecting anything in return. This is difficult for some to comprehend in our "consumerist" culture that we live in. This is even difficult for many parish communities that have become heavily dependent on parish fundraising events to support the mission and ministry of their local parish. Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it's just a financial transaction. This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus', renewing our covenant relationship with Him.



## Liturgical Minister Training~ Fall 2025

The Diocese of Rockville Center will offer training for those who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors. No walk-ins permitted, all participants must be registered in advance with a letter from their pastor.

**Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion: Part A** - This training is required for **all** those who are beginning as Ministers. This “BASIC” training is required for **all** Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend Part B training in addition to BASIC training. One **must** attend Part A training prior to Part B training.

A **Lector Workshop** is available for both new and experienced lectors. You may not take EMHC Part A and the Lector Workshop on the same day.

Also help if you have previous military/police/fire-fighter/martial arts training, and have the courage at that moment to take on the attacker. Three, **HAIL**, meaning Hail Mary and pray every possible prayer in our Corpus Christi house of God, that the Eucharistic Body of Christ will protect our bodies and families.

## **Corpus Christi needs new Altar Servers!!**

These are some of the requirements to serve as an Altar Server:

**You have to be a registered member of Corpus Christi.**

**The boys and girls have to have completed 4<sup>th</sup> grade.**

**They have to have the Sacrament of First Holy Communion.**

Altar Servers form a very important part of our Parish and we are enriched through their dedication and service. They assist the priest and deacon of the parish during the celebration of the Mass. As visible members of our Parish ministry team, Altar Servers have a responsibility to serve as an example to others of one's commitment to their faith. Serving prayerfully with reverence, respect and attentiveness to the assigned tasks during the Mass is very important.

Some of the tasks Altar Servers perform include carrying the Cross during the entrance and recessional processions; presenting the bread, wine and water to the priest and assist him in receiving the gifts; as well as many other tasks throughout the Mass. These are very important tasks and therefore, the Altar Servers have to undergo extensive training with the help of the more experienced Altar Servers both during training as well as when they first altar serve in a Mass. Servers should be mature enough to understand their responsibilities and to carry them out well and with appropriate reverence.

# Español

## XXII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



### EVANGELIO DE SAN LUCAS 14, 1.7-14

Un sábado, Jesús entró a comer en casa de uno de los principales fariseos. Ellos lo observaban atentamente. Y al notar cómo los invitados buscaban los primeros puestos, les dijo esta parábola: «Si te invitan a un banquete de bodas, no te coloques en el primer lugar, porque puede suceder que haya sido invitada otra persona más importante que tú, y cuando llegue el que los invitó a los dos, tenga que decirte: ‘Déjale el sitio’, y así, lleno de vergüenza, tengas que ponerte en el último lugar. Al contrario, cuando te inviten, ve a colocarte en el último sitio, de manera que cuando llegue el que te invitó, te diga: ‘Amigo, acércate más’, y así quedarás bien delante de todos los invitados. Porque todo el que ensalza será humillado, y el que se humilla será ensalzado». Después dijo al que lo había invitado: «Cuando des un almuerzo o una cena, no invites a tus amigos, ni a tus hermanos, ni a tus parientes, ni a los vecinos ricos, no sea que ellos te inviten a su vez, y así tengas tu recompensa. Al contrario, cuando des un banquete, invita a los pobres, a los lisiados, a los paralíticos, a los ciegos. ¡Feliz de ti, porque ellos no tienen cómo retribuirte, y así tendrás tu recompensa en la resurrección de los justos!».



Nos encontramos con dos parábolas del buen comportamiento en la mesa. En la primera Jesús se dirige a los comensales a propósito del puesto que

deben ocupar cuando son invitados y en la segunda se dirige a quien invita para que haga una buena elección de los invitados. La parábola de los primeros y los últimos puestos en un banquete le sirve a Jesús para poner de manifiesto la humildad. La parábola de los comensales del banquete es una seria advertencia para no caer en la tentación de la vanagloria, para no alardear. Humilde es quien reconoce la grandeza de Dios y su favor al hacernos dignos de ser invitados a su mesa. Los pobres y los marginalizados deben saber que Dios no los excluye de su mesa. La enseñanza que nos ofrece el evangelio de hoy al ser formulada en un banquete, donde la elite de los fariseos y doctores de la ley se invitan entre sí, podría resumirse así: no busquéis la reciprocidad y la recompensa; haced el bien y prestad sin esperar nada a cambio. Nadie mejor que Jesús puede mostrarnos el valor de la humildad frente a la arrogancia de quien impone su criterio o distribuye los favores para alcanzar el aplauso y la estima de los demás.



La primera lectura del Sirácida es una colección de dichos y refranes de sabiduría, como casi todo el libro, en que se hace el elogio de la humildad, la reflexión y la limosna. Si tienes conciencia de ser grande, de valer algo, procura manifestarte ante los otros con humildad.



La Segunda lectura, de la Carta a los Hebreos, prosigue con la alta teología sobre la fe. Esta exhortación a una comunidad judeo-cristiana que está pasando por un mal momento, por dificultades internas y externas, pone de manifiesto la obra redentora de Cristo, el Sumo Sacerdote, en comparación con la liturgia, ya muerta e irreversible, del antiguo templo de Jerusalén. Ahora la liturgia que se propone es de tipo celeste, vital, existencial.

### DOMINGO XXII DO TEMPO COMUM



#### EVANGELHO DE SÃO LUCAS 14, 1.7-14

Naquele tempo, Jesus entrou, a um sábado, em casa de um dos principais fariseus para tomar uma refeição. Todos O observavam. Ao notar como os convidados escolhiam os primeiros lugares, Jesus disse-lhes esta parábola: «Quando fores convidado para um banquete nupcial, não tomes o primeiro lugar. Pode acontecer que tenha sido convidado alguém mais importante que tu; então, aquele que vos convidou a ambos, terá que te dizer: ‘Dá o lugar a este’; e ficarás depois envergonhado, se tiveres de ocupar o último lugar. Por isso, quando fores convidado, vai sentar-te no último lugar; e quando vier aquele que te convidou, dirá: ‘Amigo, sobe mais para cima’; ficarás então honrado aos olhos dos outros convidados. Quem se exalta será humilhado e quem se humilha será exaltado». Jesus disse ainda a quem O tinha convidado: «Quando ofereceres um almoço ou um jantar, não convides os teus amigos nem os teus irmãos, nem os teus parentes nem os teus vizinhos ricos, não seja que eles por sua vez te convidem e assim serás retribuído. Mas quando ofereceres um banquete, convida os pobres, os aleijados, os coxos e os cegos; e serás feliz por eles não terem com que retribuir-te: ser-te-á retribuído na ressurreição dos justos.

**«Quem se exalta será humilhado  
e quem se humilha será exaltado»**

Lc 14, 1.7-11

O Evangelho de hoje está ambientado na casa de um fariseu que, num sábado, depois da liturgia da Palavra na sinagoga, convida Jesus para uma refeição. À mesa, porém, ninguém pode sentar-se como lhe apraz. Os

costumes do povo de Israel dão muita importância à hierarquia e os lugares são distribuídos com muito cuidado. Há sempre alguém que gosta de aparecer e vai se infiltrando no lugar do outro. No Reino de Deus os mais importantes não são aqueles que procuram os lugares de honra, mas são aqueles que se apresentam com humildade e simplicidade e não se consideram superiores aos outros. Quase no final da refeição, Jesus dirigiu-se ao dono da casa e deixou-lhe algumas sugestões sobre as pessoas a quem devia convidar para um banquete. Os fariseus escolhiam cuidadosamente os seus convidados para a mesa. Em geral, evitavam convidar pessoas de nível menos elevado. Eles não estavam dispostos a estabelecer laços com qualquer um, nomeadamente com gente desclassificada e pecadora. O conselho de Jesus subverte completamente esta lista e propõe uma lista de convidados oposta à que as convenções sociais sugeriam: “quando ofereceres um banquete, convida os pobres, os aleijados, os coxos e os cegos” (vers. 13). A proposta de Jesus parece descabida. Na época de Jesus, a religião do Templo considerava os aleijados, os cegos e os coxos gente indigna, castigada por Deus, que vivia à margem da comunidade da salvação. Apesar disso, Jesus recomenda ao dono da casa onde comeu naquele sábado que, quando der um banquete, os convide para a sua mesa. Para Jesus não há gente indigna, maldita, que deva ficar de fora do banquete do Reino de Deus.



A primeira leitura é do Livro de Ben-Sirá. “Sê modesto...comporta-te como uma pessoa humilde,” aconselha Sirac ao seu discípulo. Tudo o que somos recebemos de Deus. Nada nos pertence. De nada podemos nos vangloriar.
