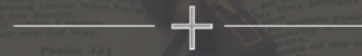

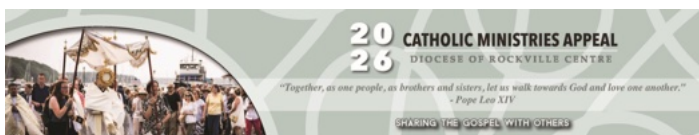

Pastor's Notes

As the long summer days seem to fade into the upcoming colors of fall, so too our lives constantly transform with the everlasting grace of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist: Jesus, who is the same yesterday, today and forever. Countless changes have happened at Corpus Christi over these 125 years of our beloved parish life-time. Nevertheless, like the constancy of the north star in the night sky, God's Love in Father, Son, Spirit always remains eternal.

Many of you might recall eight years ago when we moved the "Last Supper" stained glass window into the sanctuary; a priceless image of Corpus Christi that was the centerpiece of the original church, but hidden away inside the steeple of the new church since 1971. Now we need your help to repair and preserve the eight other stained glass windows which flank our side walls. The protective glass (not the stained glass) is damaged in several places; along with the eight ventilation windows.

Autumn is always the traditional time for our once-a-year parish fundraiser, by way of the four raffle tickets we are sending to each home. They are \$25 each, which will go towards the refurbishing of the eight windows. Any additional funds that we raise will go towards some needed upgrades to our parish parking lot, as well as necessary emergency exit lights in the church. There will be three cash prizes (\$1,500, \$1,000, \$500) to be drawn on Sunday 22 November at the end of the 11:30am Mass; celebrating the Solemnity of Christ the King!

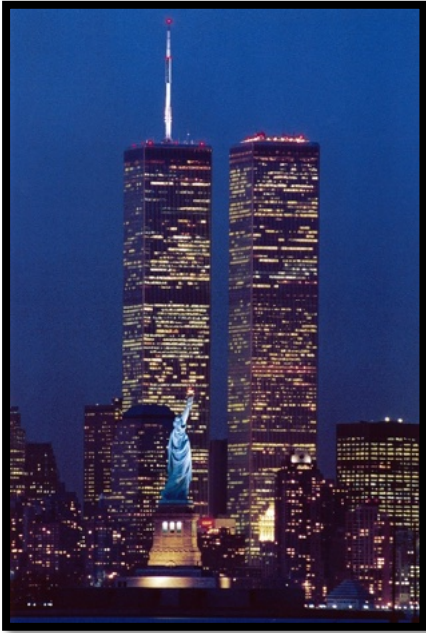

PATRIOT DAY

9/11



11 September recalls the tragic time 25 years ago when our beloved homeland was attacked by terrorists. Nearly 3000 persons from 60-plus different nations perished that day (with still more than 1000 bodies never identified). And through these many years, thousands more have died from related illnesses, especially our brave first responders.

After 9/11/2001, I was doing a lot of funeral Masses and/or memorial Masses (without a body present). At one Mass, a widowed mother whose son died that day, gave me a steel cross, given to her by fire-fighters in New York City. The steel came from the Twin Towers, for family members who lost loved ones. So

much of that steel has spread throughout the USA, for countless communities to have memorials in remembrance of the faithful departed souls.

At all the Masses on the long weekend of September 11, 12, 13, we invite all parishioners to honor the memory of our fallen patriots. I will attach the small steel cross from the twin towers, to our large wooden cross that we venerate on Good Friday. If you choose, please come forward during the recessional song at the end of Mass, to offer your touch and prayer.

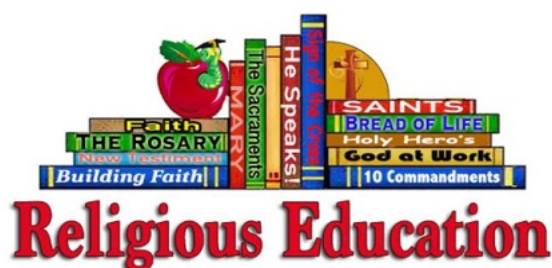

The Diocese of Rockville Centre will offer training for those who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors. No walk-ins permitted, all participants must be registered in advance with a letter of approval from their pastor.

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion: Part A - This training is required for **all** those who are beginning as Ministers. This “BASIC” training is required for **all** Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend Part B training in addition to BASIC training. One **must** attend Part A training prior to Part B training.

A **Lector Workshop** is available for both new and experienced lectors.

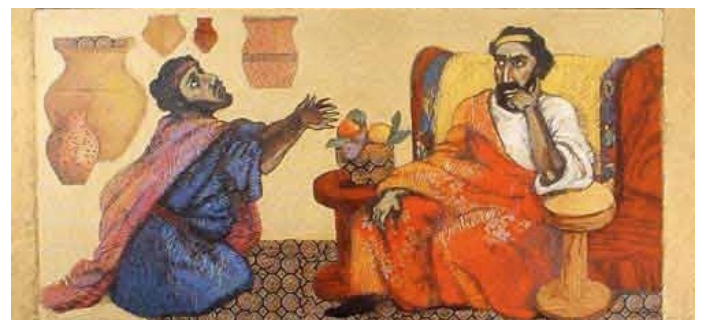

*Español***XXIV DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO
ORDINARIO****EVANGELIO DE SAN MATEO 18, 21-35**

Se adelantó Pedro y le dijo: «Señor, ¿cuántas veces tendré que perdonar a mi hermano las ofensas que me haga? ¿Hasta siete veces?». Jesús le respondió: «No te digo hasta siete veces, sino hasta setenta veces siete. Por eso, el Reino de los Cielos se parece a un rey que quiso arreglar las cuentas con sus servidores. Comenzada la tarea, le presentaron a uno que debía diez mil talentos. Como no podía pagar, el rey mandó que fuera vendido junto con su mujer, sus hijos y todo lo que tenía, para saldar la deuda. El servidor se arrojó a sus pies, diciéndole: «Señor, dame un plazo y te pagaré todo». El rey se compadeció, lo dejó ir y, además, le perdonó la deuda. Al salir, este servidor encontró a uno de sus compañeros que le debía cien denarios y, tomándolo del cuello hasta ahogarlo, le dijo: ‘Págame lo que me debes’. El otro se arrojó a sus pies y le suplicó: ‘Dame un plazo y te pagaré la deuda’. Pero él no quiso, sino que lo hizo poner en la cárcel hasta que pagara lo que debía. Los demás servidores, al ver lo que había sucedido, se apenaron mucho y fueron a contarle a su señor. Este lo mandó llamar y le dijo: ‘¡Miserable! Me suplicaste, y te perdoné la deuda. ¿No debías también tú tener compasión de tu compañero, como yo me compadecí de tí?’ E indignado, el rey lo entregó en manos de los verdugos hasta que pagara todo lo que debía. Lo mismo hará también mi Padre celestial con ustedes, si no perdonan de corazón a sus hermanos».



El Evangelio de hoy habla de la necesidad del perdón. No es fácil perdonar. Pues ciertas heridas siguen machucando el corazón. Hay personas que dicen: “Yo perdono pero no olvido” Rencor, tensiones, discusiones, opiniones diferentes, ofensas, provocaciones dificultan el perdón y la reconciliación. Vamos a meditar las palabras de Jesús que hablan de reconciliación y que nos traen la parábola del perdón sin límites. Jesús va más lejos de la propuesta de Pedro. Elimina todo y cualquier límite posible para el perdón: «No te digo siete, sino setenta veces siete.” O sea, ¡setenta veces siempre! Pues no hay proporción entre el perdón que recibimos de Dios y el perdón que debemos ofrecer a los hermanos, como nos enseña la parábola del perdón sin límites.



El Eclesiástico no empieza diciendo «perdona», sino algo más hondo: «acuérdate». Acuérdate de tu fin, acuérdate de los mandamientos, acuérdate de la alianza del Altísimo. El remedio contra el rencor no es, en primer lugar, un esfuerzo heroico de nuestra voluntad, sino la recuperación de una memoria más amplia que la del agravio. El hombre resentido solo sabe repetirse la ofensa recibida; el creyente, por el contrario, debe aprender a recordar una historia mayor, la de la fidelidad de Dios, que empequeñece cualquier otra cuenta pendiente. Ben Sirá habla del rencor como de algo que el pecador «guarda» dentro de sí: el problema no es solo la herida, sino la decisión de conservarla, alimentarla, dejar que se convierta en la lente con la que miramos todo lo demás y a todos los demás.

Português

DOMINGO XXIV DO TEMPO COMUM



EVANGELHO DE SÃO MATEUS 18, 21-35

Naquele tempo, Pedro aproximou-se de Jesus e perguntou-Lhe: «Se meu irmão me ofender, quantas vezes deverei perdoar-lhe? Até sete vezes?» Jesus respondeu: «Não te digo até sete vezes, mas até setenta vezes sete. Na verdade, o reino de Deus pode comparar-se a um rei que quis ajustar contas com os seus servos. Logo de começo, apresentaram-lhe um homem que devia dez mil talentos. Não tendo com que pagar, o senhor mandou que fosse vendido, com a mulher, os filhos e tudo quanto possuía, para assim pagar a dívida. Então o servo prostrou-se a seus pés, dizendo: ‘Senhor, concede-me um prazo e tudo te pagarei’. Cheio de compaixão, o senhor daquele servo deu-lhe a liberdade e perdoou-lhe a dívida. Ao sair, o servo encontrou um dos seus companheiros que lhe devia cem denários. Segurando-o, começou a apertar-lhe o pescoço, dizendo: ‘Paga o que me deves’. Então o companheiro caiu a seus pés e suplicou-lhe, dizendo: ‘Concede-me um prazo e pagar-te-ei’. Ele, porém, não conseguiu e mandou-o prender, até que pagasse tudo quanto devia. Testemunhas desta cena, os seus companheiros ficaram muito tristes e foram contar ao senhor tudo o que havia sucedido. Então, o senhor mandou-o chamar e disse: ‘Servo mau, perdoei-te, porque me pediste. Não devias, também tu, compadecer-te do teu companheiro, como eu tive compaixão de ti?’ E o senhor, indignado, entregou-o aos verdugos, até que pagasse tudo o que lhe devia. Assim procederá convosco meu Pai celeste, se cada um de vós não perdoar a seu irmão de todo o coração».



O Evangelho deste domingo é sobre a necessidade de perdoar sempre, de forma radical e ilimitada. Trata-se – todos estamos conscientes do facto – de uma das exigências mais difíceis que Jesus nos faz. Ele deu testemunho, em gestos concretos, do amor, da bondade e da misericórdia do Pai. Na cruz, ele morreu pedindo perdão para os seus assassinos... Ora o cristão é, antes de mais, um seguidor de Jesus. O mandamento do perdão não é novo – como vimos, aliás, na primeira leitura. Os catequistas de Israel ensinavam a perdoar as ofensas e a não guardar rancor contra o irmão que tinha cometido qualquer falha. Os “mestres” de Israel estavam, no entanto, de acordo em que a obrigação de perdoar existia apenas em relação aos membros do Povo de Deus (os inimigos estavam excluídos dessa dinâmica de amor e de misericórdia). A grande discussão girava, porém, à volta do número limite de vezes em que se devia perdoar. Todos – desde os mais exigentes aos mais misericordiosos – aceitavam, contudo, que o perdão tem limites e que não se deve perdoar indefinidamente.



A primeira leitura deixa claro que a ira e o rancor são sentimentos maus, que não convêm à felicidade e à realização do homem. Mostra como é ilógico esperar o perdão de Deus e recusar-se a perdoar ao irmão; e avisa que a nossa vida nesta terra não pode ser estragada com sentimentos, que só geram infelicidade e sofrimento. Ensina que a verdadeira “sabedoria” está em não se deixar dominar pelo rancor, pela ira e pelos sentimentos de vingança. É interessante a relação estabelecida aqui entre o perdão humano e o perdão divino: quem se recusa a perdoar ao irmão, como poderá ter a coragem de pedir o perdão de Deus?
