Liturgical Minister Training~ Fall 2025

The Diocese of Rockville Center will offer training for those who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors. No walk-ins permitted, all participants must be registered in advance with a letter from their pastor.

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion: Part A - This training is required for **all** those who are beginning as Ministers. This “BASIC” training is required for **all** Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend Part B training in addition to BASIC training. One **must** attend Part A training prior to Part B training.

A **Lector Workshop** is available for both new and experienced lectors. You may not take EMHC Part A and the Lector Workshop on the same day.



XXV DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



EVANGELIO SEGÚN SAN LUCAS 16, 1013

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: *El que es fiel en las cosas pequeñas, también es fiel en las grandes, y el que es infiel en las cosas pequeñas, también es infiel en las grandes. Si ustedes no son fieles administradores del dinero, tan lleno de injusticias, quién les confiará los bienes verdaderos? Y si no han sido fieles en lo que no es de ustedes, quién les confiará lo que si es de ustedes? No hay criado que pueda servir a dos amos, pues odiará a uno y amará al otros, o se apegará al primero y despreciará al segundo. En resumen, no pueden ustedes servir a Dios y a dinero.*



El evangelio de hoy es uno de los momentos más sociales de la obra de Lucas, en consonancia con el mensaje del profeta Amós. Corresponde este texto a la primera parte de Lucas 16, y quiere mostrar el planteamiento nuevo de cómo los discípulos tienen que comportarse en este mundo, en el que uno de los valores más deseados por todos es la riqueza (lo que es lo más estimable para los hombres). Es cierto que el lenguaje

del evangelio no podemos sacarlo de su verdadero contexto y es clara la intencionalidad de Lucas cuando nos está advirtiendo del riesgo enorme que tiene el dinero para apartarnos de Dios. Por supuesto el evangelio no pretende anular nuestra relación con el dinero, más bien parece que nos alienta a que sepamos tratarlo como lo que es: el precio que hay que pagar para conseguir algo que vale más que el dinero. El dinero se presenta con frecuencia como un ídolo poderoso que pretende ocupar el primer lugar en nuestras decisiones. Acumular dinero sin un fin superior al mismo es sencillamente ponerse al servicio de este ídolo. Solo queremos recordar las constantes advertencias evangélicas de la caducidad y de los bienes de este mundo; la necesidad de buscar el reino de Dios y su justicia y lo demás se nos dará por añadidura.



Hoy nos enfrentan los textos de la liturgia con esa realidad que se valora tanto en la vida de los hombres: el poder, el dinero y la vanagloria. Sabemos que la religión debe estar inmersa en la vida de cada día. En este sentido, la primera lectura, tomada del profeta Amós, es una buena muestra de lo que decimos. Sabemos que el profeta es el representante más cualificado del profetismo social. Es una invectiva contra los mercaderes y negociantes que se percatan que la religión les estorba a sus planes; quieren que pasen las fiestas sagradas, el sábado, día del Señor, para poder emprender su tarea financiera, y con ello, las injusticias que conlleva la avaricia de los que son amantes del dinero. No quiere decir que todos los empresarios sean avariciosos, pero el profeta sabe el terreno que pisa. El tema que el profeta vislumbra es que su religión y su dios es el dinero, pero no obstante no quieren saltarse ciertas reglas de comportamiento religioso en los días festivos religiosos; incluso algunos pueden aparentar ser muy religiosos, pero su corazón está donde está su tesoro. El profeta Amós pone el dedo en la llaga y sigue siendo bien actual.

DOMINGO XXV DO TEMPO COMUM




EVANGELHO DE SÃO LUCAS 16, 10-13

Naquele tempo, disse Jesus aos seus discípulos: *Quem é fiel nas coisas pequenas também é fiel nas grandes; e quem é injusto nas coisas pequenas também é injusto nas grandes. Se não fostes fiéis no que se refere ao vil dinheiro, quem vos confiará o verdadeiro bem? E se não fostes fiéis no bem alheio, quem vos entregará o que é vosso? Nenhum servo pode servir a dois senhores, porque, ou não gosta de um deles e estima o outro, ou se dedica a um e despreza o outro. Não podeis servir a Deus e ao dinheiro.*



Não podemos considerar como riqueza o que não podemos levar conosco, pois o que somos obrigados a deixar neste mundo não nos pertence, mas é dos outros. Os bens do mundo futuro, o reino de Deus, ao invés, são chamados a verdadeira riqueza. Esses bens podem ser conquistados só mediante a renúncia a tudo aquilo que não tem valor. Jesus afirma que ninguém pode servir a dois senhores. Não podeis servir a Deus e ao dinheiro. Nós gostaríamos de agradecer aos dois senhores: daríamos ao primeiro o domingo e ao outro os demais dias da semana; mas não é possível, pois eles dão ordens contraditórias. Um sugere: partilha os teus bens, ajuda os irmãos, perdoa a dívida do pobre...; o outro, ao contrário, repete: pensa nos teus interesses, preocupa-te em ganhar quanto mais puderes, em acumular fortunas, mesmo que tenhas que praticar a injustiça. Guarda tudo para ti, não distribuas nada a ninguém.



A primeira leitura do profeta Amós denuncia a exploração dos pobres e a injustiça social praticada pelos comerciantes ricos, que desejavam o fim das festas religiosas (Lua Nova e Sábado) para poderem vender grãos e trigo de má qualidade, usando balanças desonestas e cobrando preços exorbitantes. O Senhor, através do profeta, afirma que nunca esquecerá as obras de Israel e que o juízo virá sobre eles. Quem são os denunciados? Os que maltratam os necessitados e exploram os humildes da terra. Os comerciantes que só pensam em fazer negócios e lucrar com a desgraça alheia. Práticas desonestas para extrair o máximo de lucro dos mais pobres. Usar balanças enganosas para pesar as mercadorias. Vender o "refugo" do trigo, ou seja, o grão sujo e de má qualidade. Os pobres e necessitados não têm condições de pagar suas dívidas. Eles são levados à servidão ou escravidão por uma dívida pequena, como o valor de um par de sandálias.
