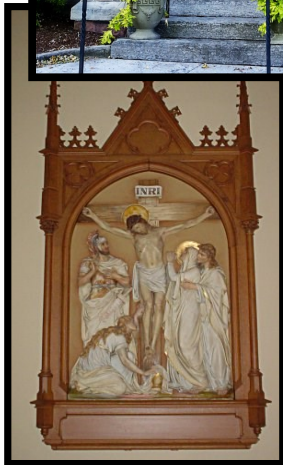

XXVI DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



EVANGELIO SEGÚN SAN MARCOS

En aquel tiempo, Juan le dijo a Jesús: *“Hemos visto a uno que expulsaba a los demonios en tu nombre, y como no es de los nuestros, se lo prohibimos”*. Pero Jesús le respondió: *“No se lo prohiban, porque no hay ninguno que haga milagros en mi nombre, que luego sea capaz de hablar mal de mí. Todo aquel que no está contra de nosotros, está a nuestro favor. Todo aquel que les dé a beber un vaso de agua por el hecho de que son de Cristo, les aseguro que no se quedará sin recompensa. Al que sea ocasión de pecado para esta gente sencilla que cree en mí, más le valdría que le pusieran al cuello una de esas enormes piedras de molino y lo arrojaran al mar. Si tu mano te es ocasión de pecado, córtala; pues más te vale entrar manco en la vida eterna, que ir con tus dos manos al lugar de castigo, al fuego que no se apaga. Y si tu pie te es ocasión de pecado, córtelo; pues más te vale entrar cojo en la vida eterna, que con tus dos pies ser arrojado al lugar de castigo. Y si tu ojo te es ocasión de pecado, sácatelo; pues más te vale entrar tuerto en el Reino de Dios, que ser arrojado con tus dos ojos al lugar de castigo, donde el gusano no muere y el fuego no se apaga”*.

En la primera lectura Dios habla a su siervo Moisés para que transmita al Pueblo sus palabras. En una ocasión reúne a setenta ancianos alrededor de la tienda. Al recibir también ellos el espíritu de Dios se ponen a profetizar. Otros dos ancianos, no presentes en aquél lugar, se ponen también a profetizar en el Pueblo. Un joven escandalizado acude a Moisés para pedirle que les prohíba profetizar. Mas él responde: Ojalá todo el Pueblo del Señor fuera profeta y recibiera el espíritu del Señor. Una respuesta semejante es la que da Jesús a Juan, que quiere impedir que un hombre expulse demonios en nombre de Cristo porque no es de los nuestros. El Señor responde: *“No se lo impidan, porque el que no está contra de nosotros está a nuestro favor”*. Todo aquél que hace el bien está haciendo la obra de Dios. No es por eso por lo que deben escandalizarse los discípulos, no es a quien predicar en nombre del Señor a quien hay que impedir que hable o realice milagros incluso por no pertenecer al grupo de los Apóstoles. Es por otras cosas por las que si hay que escandalizarse. En el Evangelio el Señor advierte con dureza a aquellos que escandalizan a uno de estos pequeños que creen. La palabra escándalo viene del griego que significa cualquier obstáculo situado en el camino y que es causa de tropiezo y caída para el caminante.



La carta del apóstol Santiago es sin duda el escrito del nuevo testamento donde mas duramente se condena la injusticia producida por el afán de poseer y tener cuanto mas mejor. *“Y vosotros ricos llorad a gritos sobre las misérias que os amenazan. Vuestra riqueza está podrida. El jornal de los obreiros que han segado vuestros campos, defraudado por vosotros, clama y los gritos de los segadores han llegado a los oídos del Señor de los ejércitos”*. Se puede ser rico y honesto. Se puede ser empresario y considerar a tus trabajadores como lo más preciado de tu empresa.

DOMINGO XXVI DO TEMPO COMUM



Evangelho segundo São Marcos 9. 38-43.47-48

Naquele tempo, João disse a Jesus: “Mestre, nós vimos um homem a expulsar os demónios em teu nome e procurámos impedir-lho, porque ele não anda conosco”. Jesus respondeu: “Não o proibais; porque ninguém pode fazer um milagre em meu nome e depois dizer mal de mim. Quem não é contra nós é por nós. Quem vos der a beber um copo de água, por serdes de Cristo, em verdade vos digo que não perderá a sua recompensa. Se alguém escandalizar algum destes pequeninos que crêem em mim, melhor seria para ele que lhe atassem aos pescoço uma dessas mós movidas por um jumento e o lançassem ao mar. Se a tua mão é para ti ocasião de escândalo, corta-a; porque é melhor entrar mutilado na vida do que ter as duas mãos e ir para a Geena, para esse fogo que não se apaga. E se o teu pé é para ti ocasião de escândalo, corta-o; porque é melhor entrar coxo na vida do que ter os dois pés e ser lançado na Geena. E se um dos teus olhos é para ti ocasião de escândalo, deita-o fora; porque é melhor entrar no reino de Deus só com um dos olhos do que ter os dois olhos e ser lançado na Geena, onde o verme não morre e o fogo nunca se apaga”.



No Evangelho deste domingo vemos Jesus dedicando-se à instrução dos discípulos, mostrando-lhes não só que é o Messias esperado, mas o que significa o seu seguimento. Ele não exclui ninguém do Reino dos Céus. No seguimento de Jesus os pequenos devem ser amados e respeitados. Jesus é muito duro com aqueles que escandalizam e levam ao pecado outras pessoas, quer dizer, aqueles que colocam obstáculos que impeça o caminho do discípulo. Os que causam o afastamento de alguém de seguir a Cristo, terá que carregar uma responsabilidade muito grave. A fidelidade a Jesus exige cortar o mal pela raiz, deixar tudo aquilo que nos afasta de Deus e dos irmãos.

CONDENAÇÃO À GANÂNCIA

Tiago 5:1-6

A carta de São Tiago é tão clara na condenação daqueles que acumulam riquezas explorando os outros. Roubar o salário de um trabalhador, diz São Tiago, equivale a matá-lo. A riqueza acumulada por meio da injustiça, é uma riqueza maldita. E as ameaças do apóstolo na segunda leitura deste domingo são terríveis. “Agora, vós, ó ricos, chorai e lamentai-vos, por causa das desgraças que vão cair sobre vós”.



O tema central das leituras deste domingo é o que está escrito na primeira leitura e na primeira parte do Evangelho. O Espírito actua em toda a gente, é livre, não está limitado a nenhuma fronteira.
